GAME NOTES

MICHIGAN NOTES

- Michigan rallied from a 17-point deficit in the third quarter to win by 13.
- Michigan claimed its first lead of the second half, 44-43, on Cameron Williams' layup at 8:40 of the fourth quarter. The Wolverines held the Hoosiers to eighth points in the third.
- Laila Phelia netted a career-high 30 points, surpassing 20+plus points for the 11th time this season.
- The Wolverines held an opponent to less than 60 points for the 13th time in 2023-24.
- Michigan became the sixth Big Ten team to reach 20 wins this season.
- The Wolverines will make their first Big Ten Semifinal appearance since 2020.

INDIANA NOTES

- No. 12/12 Indiana entered the contest having won 10 of its previous 12 games.
- IU went to free throw line three times.
- Indiana's starting five accounted for 54 points. IU's 56 points was its lowest output of the season.
- Indiana lost for the first time this season when leading at the half, previously going 21-0.
- The Hoosiers were making their first appearance as a No. 3 seed.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Michigan completed the third upset of the Big Ten Quarterfinals as lower seeds won three of four games on Friday.
- Meeting for the first time since 2014, the Big Ten Tournament series between Michigan and Indiana is now tied at 4-4.
