GAME NOTES

PURDUE

- Purdue came in ranked 20th in the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches polls.
- The Boilermakers were making their first appearance in the second round of the BTT in this, their 27th trip to the tournament.
- Has won nine of its last 11 games in Gainbridge Fieldhouse, dating to the 2020-21 campaign.
- Trey Kaufman-Renn produced a game-high 30 points along with seven rebounds in 29 minutes of court time.
- Kaufman-Renn: 30 points is tied for third-most in a BTT game by a Boilermaker.

USC

- Advanced to tonight's second round with a double overtime win against Rutgers on Wednesday evening.
- The Trojans had four players in double-figures scoring, paced by Desmond Claude who finished with 18 points in 21 minutes.
- Rashaun Agee surpassed 1,000 career points, becoming the seventh member of the team to hit that milestone.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Tonight's game featured nine lead changes and 13 ties.
- Purdue now owns a 5-4 edge against USC in the all-time series. The Boilermakers swept the season series, having previously won, 90-72, in West Lafayette on Feb. 7.
