GAME NOTES

MICHIGAN NOTES

- Michigan shot 47.8 percent (11-for-23) from 3-point land.
- The Wolverines converted 91.7 percent (11-for-12) from the free throw line.
- Laila Hansen posted a team-high 21 points and seven assists in 37 minutes of action.
- Michigan was making its sixth Big Ten Semifinal appearance.
- The Wolverines closed the tournament with two wins for only the second time in program history.

IOWA NOTES

- Iowa advances to the Big Ten Tournament Championship Game for the fourth-straight year.
- The Hawkeyes will be attempting a three-peat on Sunday.
- Iowa scored 54 points from the paint and shot 61.3 percent (38-for-62) from the field.
- The Hawkeyes set a tournament game record with 30 assists.
- Caitlin Clark recorded a double-double *in the first half* and finished with 28 points and 15 assists. Her assist total was the third-most for a Big Ten Tournament game.
- Clark became the Big Ten Tournament's all-time leading scorer (currently at 293 points in 12 games).
- Clark now owns the Iowa season record for assists (282) and surpassed the Big Ten record for career free throws (now at 778).
- Clark's career points total stands at 3,737.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Iowa improved to 4-0 versus Michigan all-time at the Big Ten Tournament. It was the first meeting between the schools since a second round contest in 2016.
- This afternoon's contest was the 75th meeting between MICH-IOWA with the Hawkeyes now leading the series, 55-20.
- No. 5 Nebraska and No. 2 Iowa will play in Sunday's championship game. Tip-off is 11 a.m. CT on CBS/Paramount+.
