GAME NOTES

IOWA

- The Hawkeyes have won nine of their last 11 games.
- Iowa improved to 39-25 all-time in the Big Ten Tournament and is 16-2 in its last 18 games at the event.
- Finished with a 41-19 advantage in rebounds.
- Iowa used 13 players in the game and employed an all-freshman lineup in the fourth quarter.
- Lucy Olsen eclipsed 2,000 career points with a 3-pointer in the second quarter.
- Jan Jensen tied Lisa Bluder for the second-most wins by a first-year Iowa coach.

WISCONSIN

- Serah Williams registered her 15th game this season with 20-or-more points; she also reached double figures for the 28th time in 2024-25.
- Defensively, Williams compiled five blocked shots and three steals.
- Wisconsin was facing its 11th opponent this season who was either nationally-ranked or received votes in the polls.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Second meeting in four days between the schools — Iowa recorded a 15-point win on Sunday in Iowa City.
- Iowa leads the all-time series versus Wisconsin, 61-20, having won 31-straight in the series dating to 2007.
