GAME NOTES

OHIO STATE NOTES

- Ohio State is 34-18 (.654) all-time at the Big Ten Tournament.
- The Buckeyes are 6-1 under Interim Head Coach Jake Diebler.
- OSU placed four scorers in double figures to earn its 20th win of the season.
- The Buckeyes never trailed in the game (two ties).
- Outpaced Iowa in bench points (37-16), second-chance points (14-9) and rebounds (42-36).
- Minnesota native Jamison Battle scored all 23 of his team high points in the second half.

IOWA NOTES

- For the 20th time in 2023-24, Iowa had four players reach double-digits in scoring.
- Payton Sandfort tallied a team-best 19 points, the 11th time this season he's held that honor.
- Payton Sandfort raised his Big Ten-leading three-point field goals total to 87.
- The Hawkeyes dipped to below .500 (22-23) all-time at the Big Ten Tournament.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- After 170 meetings, the all-time series between Ohio State and Iowa is tied at 85-85.
- Ohio State owns a 3-1 edge versus Iowa in the Big Ten Tournament. The teams met in last year's second round with OSU producing a four-point win.
- Tonight's game marked the first upset of the Big Ten Tournament.
