GAME NOTES

INDIANA TEAM NOTES

- Fifth-seeded Indiana moved by Rutgers in the first meeting between the programs in nearly two calendar years (last meeting March 6, 2020)
- The victory secured a seventh consecutive 20-win season for Indiana under Head Coach Teri Moren, marking the longest streak in program history. Coach Moren has guided the Hoosiers to 20-plus wins in all but one season during her time with the program
- With today's win, Indiana snapped a three-game losing streak, which was the longest skid for the program since the 2019-2020 season
- The lead changed hands just three times in the game, with Indiana surrendering the advantage for just 38 seconds in total
- With 17 points, Grace Berger extended her team-leading double-digit scoring streak to 12 games
- Berger has now dished out at least three assists in 26 of 28 games after compiling six assists against Rutgers in today's contest
- Nicole Cardaño-Hillary grabbed five steals against the Scarlet Knights, marking her 18th multi-steal game of the season

RUTGERS TEAM NOTES

- Rutgers fell to Indiana despite winning the rebounding margin 35-30. The Scarlet Knights held a 15-5 advantage in offensive rebounding.
- Rutgers has either split or out-rebounded opponents in 25 of its 31 games this season
- Graduate-student Osh Brown finished with 12 points and 10 rebounds for her 12th double-double this season
