BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- **MILESTONE WATCH...** Michigan State head coach Tom Izzo will enter Friday's game at Wisconsin with 699 career wins. A Spartan victory would make him the 10th active coach in Div. I with 700 career wins... Congratulations to Coach Izzo, who recently coached his 500th career Big Ten contest, becoming the second coach to reach the plateau. Izzo is scheduled to tie Bobby Knight's conference record 504 games when Michigan State hosts Maryland next Saturday... Congratulations to Wisconsin head coach Greg Gard, who earned his 100th career Big Ten victory on Tuesday, as the Badgers topped Minnesota.
- Purdue, Illinois, and Wisconsin remain solidly entrenched in this week's AP and USA Today Coaches Polls. The Boilermakers stay steady in the No. 2 spot on both polls. Illinois climbed four places to No. 10 in the AP and three places to No. 11 in the Coaches list. The Badgers moved down two spots to No. 13 in the AP and to No. 10 in the Coaches Poll.
- Purdue big man Zach Edey was named Big Ten Player of the Week, presented by Air National Guard, for the week of Jan. 15-21. The senior claimed his third honor of the season and ninth of his career, one shy of tying the conference record, currently held by Evan Turner (2008-10). Edey averaged 31.5 points on 55.3 percent shooting, 16.0 rebounds, and 2.5 blocked shots, as No. 2 Purdue scored a pair of wins. In an 87-66 victory at Indiana, the center tallied 33 points and 14 rebounds, then added 30 points and 18 boards, as Purdue topped Iowa 84-70.
- Wisconsin freshman John Blackwell claimed his third Big Ten Freshman of the Week honor after averaging 13.0 points and 3.0 rebounds, as No. 13/10 Wisconsin split a pair of games. Blackwell scored 14 points, including 7-8 from the free throw line, in an 87-83 loss at Penn State, before notching 12 points and four rebounds as the Badgers scored a 91-79 win over Indiana.
- For the second time this season, Edey has also been one of five Oscar Robertson National Players of the Week by the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA). This is the fifth time this season a Big Ten player has earned the honor and the second of the year for Edey. This week's other honorees include High Point's Kezza Giffa (Big South), Dayton's DaRon Holmes II (Atlantic 10), Tennessee's Dalton Knecht (SEC), and Houston's Jamal Shead (Big 12).
- Six Big Ten teams rank in the top-60 in Friday's NET rankings, including four in the top 25. Purdue's No. 2 ranking is tops in the league, while Wisconsin and Illinois sit at Nos. 12 and 13, respectively, followed by No. 23 Michigan State, No. 47 Nebraska, and No. 57 Ohio State. The Big 12 leads the nation with 11 top-60 entrants, three more than the Big East and SEC, while the Big Ten and ACC have six each.
- The Big Ten has faced 89 Quad 1 opponents, most of any power conference in the country, while its 138 Quad 1 and 2 opposition, re good for third. The Big Ten's 29 Quad 1 wins are tied with the Big 12 and Big East for most in the country, six clear of the ACC and SEC, while its 56 combined Quad 1 and 2 wins are third in the country behind the SEC (60) and ACC (59).
- Eight Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-60 in today's Kenpom rankings, including four in the top-16. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by Illinois (#10), Wisconsin (#11), Michigan State (#16), Nebraska (#45), Iowa (#49), Ohio State (#50), and Northwestern (#56). The Big 12 leads the nation with 11 teams in the top-60, three more than the Big Ten, Big East, and SEC while the ACC and Pac 12 have five each.
- Nine Eight Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-60 of the ESPN Basketball Power Index (BPI) listing. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by No. 11 Illinois, No. 15 Wisconsin, No. 17 Michigan State, No. 49 Iowa, No. 50 Ohio State, No. 54 Northwestern, and No. 57 Nebraska. All 14 Big Ten teams also rank in the outlet's top-65 Remaining Strength of Schedule listing.
- The Big Ten ranks among the nation's best conferences on both sides of the hardwood. Offensively, 10 teams average north of 75.0 points per game, led by Purdue's Big Ten-best 85.8 points, which ranks ninth in the country, three spots north of Iowa (85.1 points). Seven teams also rank in the top-60 in the country in field goal percentage, led by Purdue at 49.1 percent. Indiana (47.9 percent), Iowa (47.8) Wisconsin (47.5), Minnesota (47.5), and Michigan State (47.4) also rank in the nation's top 60. Much of that offensive efficiency stems from taking care of the ball, as six team list in the top-40 in assists/turnover ratio. Iowa leads the nation with a 1.90 ratio, while Northwestern (1.81), Michigan State (1.74), and Purdue (1.64) rank in the top 15.
- Defensively, the Big Ten boasts 10 teams that hold their opponents at or below 70 points per game, led by Maryland, who surrenders just 64.0 points per outing, good for 20th nationally, followed by Michigan State, allowing just 65.2 points, and Rutgers at 66.5 points. Six Big Ten teams also rank in the nation's top 50 in field goal percentage defense. Michigan State leads the way, holding its opponents to 39.4 percent shooting, a tick above Rutgers at 39.8 and Illinois and Maryland at 40.2. The Scarlet Knights also rank 12th in the country with 5.6 blocked shots per contest, just ahead of

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Maryland's 5.4 blocks per game, 16th in the country, while Penn State forces a league-best 15.84 turnovers per game, 16th in tDiv. I.

- Big Ten players also rank in the top-10 in several individual statistical categories. Purdue's Zach Edey ranks third in the country with 22.9 points per game, fourth in rebounds per game (11.4), and third in double-doubles (13), while his 201 free throw attempts and 154 field goals rank first and fourth in the NCAA. Minnesota's Elijah Hawkins leads the nation with 7.8 assists per contest, while Purdue's Braden Smith's 146 total assists are tops in Division I. Hawkins' 141 assists rank second and Smith's 7.3 assists per contest are fourth. Two Big Ten players, Michigan State's Tre Holloman and Ohio State's Bruce Thornton sit first and second in the nation with 5.45 and 4.72 assist/turnover ratios. Defensively, Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi's 3.38 blocked shots per game rank second in the country, just ahead of Ohio State's Felix Okpara whose 2.61 blocked shots are good for eighth, while Penn State's Ace Baldwin Jr.'s 2.84 steals per game rank sixth.
- Nearly 3.0 million fans have watched Big Ten basketball this season, including more than 1.86 million fans in our 14 home venues. Seven Big Ten teams rank in the top-20 in total attendance. Nebraska leads the Big Ten and ranks third in the country with 198,667 fans through 14 games, just north of Indiana, whose 194,013 ranks second in the country. Michigan State (177,564 fans) and Illinois (176,563) list eighth and 10th, respectively. In total, 10 Big Ten schools rank in the top-41 in total home attendance.
- On Wednesday, Jan. 10, the Los Angeles Athletic Club announced the John R. Wooden Award® presented by Principal® Midseason Top 25 Watch List. Purdue's Zach Edey and Michigan State's Tyson Walker were listed among those considered strong candidates for the honor which will be announced following the NCAA Tournament in April.
- The Big Ten closed its nonconference slate with a combined 117-37 record. The Big 12 (144-34), SEC (132-47), Atlantic 10 (131-60), and ACC (119-46) collected more wins, but the Big Ten's .760-win percentage falls behind only the Big 12 (.809). Among the B1G's 117 victories are 9 wins over AP Top 25 opponents.
- For the sixth consecutive year, each Big Ten Conference member institution will compete in a 20-game conference schedule. The Big Ten Conference season begins Friday, Dec. 1, when Maryland visits Indiana and Northwestern hosts Purdue, the first of 12 conference games played between Dec. 1-10. Following a break in conference play, Big Ten action will resume on Jan. 2. During the conference season, schools will play seven teams twice -- once at home and once on the road and six teams once, with three of those games being at home and the other three away.
- The 27th annual Big Ten Tournament will be played at Target Center in Minneapolis between March 13-17, 2024, marking the first time the tournament has been played in Minneapolis. All 14 teams will advance to the tournament, with two 1st round games slated for Wednesday, March 13th. The top four teams will receive 1st and 2nd round byes and advance to the quarterfinals on Friday, March 15th.
- A Big Ten media panel has chosen 2023 Consensus National Player of the Year Zach Edey as 2023-24 Big Ten Men's Basketball Player of the Year. The league's reigning Player of the Year, Edey became the first Boilermaker since Glenn Robinson in 1994 to win National Player of the Year accolades and the fifth Big Ten Player in the last 14 years to be named National Player of the Year joining Evan Turner (2010), Trey Burke (2013), Frank Kaminsky (2015) and Luka Garza (2021) as National Players of the Year.
- The media panel also selected the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Edey joined Illinois' Terrence Shannon Jr., Maryland's Jahmir Young, and Northwestern's Boo Buie as unanimous selections. Also named to the team were Maryland's Julian Reese, Minnesota's Dawson Garcia, Michigan State's A.J. Hoggard and Tyson Walker, Nebraska's Keisei Tominaga, and Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi. All ten members of the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team received All-Big Ten honors following the 2022-23 campaign. Buie and Shannon joined Edey with First Team accolades, while Omoruyi, Walker, and Young were named to the Second Team. Hoggard earned a spot on the Third Team, with Garcia, Reese, and Tominaga receiving Honorable Mention.

AROUND THE BIG TEN

Illinois: Quincy Guerrier paired 15 points and 11 rebounds in the Illini's loss at Northwestern, marking his third consecutive double-double. On the season, Guerrier owns eight double-doubles, including six in his last eight games, tied for third in the Big Ten.

Indiana: Freshman Mackenzie Mgbako has made a team-high 26 three-pointers this season, including 18 over his past eight games. During the month-long stretch he is shooting 18-of-38 (47.4%) from behind the arc and is averaging 12.6 points, 3.5 rebounds, and 1.8 assists per game.

Iowa: Senior Tony Perkins recorded his second consecutive 20-point game on Wednesday against Maryland and fifth of the season. He is the only player in the Big Ten (and one of 20 nationally) with at least 250 points, 75 assists, 75 rebounds, and 30 steals.

Maryland: Jahmir Young's bucket with 1.7 seconds to play at Iowa gave the Terps their first win decided by one possession this season after suffering a nation-leading five losses by three points or less. The win on a last-second field goal marks the first time that has happened for Maryland since Darryl Morsell hit a deep 3-pointer at Minnesota with one second remaining on Feb 26, 2020.

Michigan: Graduate student Jaelin Llewellyn scored a season-best 16 points at #2 Purdue (Jan. 23), knocking down three long range buckets. That effort marked the first time Llewellyn has hit double figures since Nov. 20, 2022 (10; Ohio) -- a span of one year, two months and three days. In 93 collegiate games, the two-time All-Ivy League performer has 59 double figure games.

Michigan State: Graduate student Malik Hall ranks fourth on the team with 11.1 points per game, but since going scoreless at Northwestern, Hall has four straight in double figures for the first time this season, avg. 14.3 ppg on 52.4% shooting (22-of-42) in that span, including his first double-double of the season against Minnesota, when he paired 16 points and a season-high 12 rebounds.

Minnesota: Junior Dawson Garcia ranks seventh in the Big Ten in scoring this season, averaging 17.3 ppg. Of the six individuals ahead of him, five are guards. Garcia has had two 30-point games in Big Ten play and has scored double-digit points in seven of eight Big Ten games. The only game in which he has not scored double-digits was against Nebraska (Dec. 6), where he left the game due to an ankle injury.

Nebraska: Rienk Mast has been one of the Big Ten's best transfers, averaging 13.7 points, 8.5 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game, as he paces the Huskers in both

rebouncing and assists. He is one of only four power conference players - and one of just 11 players nationally - averaging at least 10 points, eight rebounds and three assists per contest.

Northwestern: Wednesday's win over AP No. 10 Illinois marked the first time the Wildcats have ever beaten the two top-10 teams in the same season. Northwestern was 1-22 all-time against a top-10 ranked Illinois team entering Wednesday, with its last victory in 1956.

Ohio State: The Buckeyes have taken care of the basketball recently. They had a streak of double-digit turnovers in six consecutive games but his since had single-digit turnovers in four consecutive games. That includes their two lowest turnover games of four (at Michigan) and six (vs. Penn State). Sophomore guard Bruce Thornton is leading the way with just 15 turnovers on the season and a 4.39 assist/turnover ratio, fourth best in the country.

Penn State: Five-foot-eleven Kanye Clary's 18.8 points per game is the highest scoring output by any power conference player under six-foot tall this season. Clary is on track to be one of only two Big Ten players under 6'0 to average more than 18 points per game in a season since 1992-93. Only Purdue's 5'11 Carsen Edwards has accomplished the feat, scoring 24.3 points in 2018-19 and 18.5 points in 2017-18.

Purdue: Since losing to Nebraska on Jan. 9, Purdue has won four straight games, coming by an average margin of 21.0 points per game. During that span, Purdue is averaging 91.3 points per game and shooting 45.6 percent from three-point range. During that span, Purdue is averaging 1.32 points per possession.

Rutgers: The Scarlet Knights will host Purdue this weekend after back-to-back home wins. Both victories were keyed by collecting more than 50 rebounds (52 versus Indiana and a program Big Ten game record 56 against Nebraska). On the season, RU averages 39.2 rebounds per game, but in home games this year, Rutgers hauls in 42.8 rebounds per game.

Wisconsin: Sophomore AJ Storr leads the Badgers with 15.3 points per game and has led the team in scoring six times this season. The transfer has scored in double figures in 17 of 19 games, including 14 consecutive outings, longest such stretch by a Badgersince All-American and Big Ten Player of the Year Johnny Davis scored in double figures in 19 straight games during the 2021-22 season.

TIE BREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING

- Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
- A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runner-up the No. 2 seed, etc.).
- Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
- In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

Ties Involving Two Teams

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
- Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
- Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
- Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Ties Involving more than Two Teams

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
 - When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. If winning percentage among the group for any tied teams is equal, move to step b with those specific tied teams only (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step b and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).

Note: Teams can be separated from the top, middle or bottom.
 - If a team or teams are separated from the group based on step a, seeding for remaining teams among the group is not determined by head-to-head record vs. the remaining teams, but rather by taking all remaining teams to next tiebreaker.
- If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - When comparing records against a single team or group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
- Won-loss percentage of Division I opponents.
- Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Nominations for the awards are made each week by the men's basketball communications contacts and selected by a vote of the Big Ten Communications staff.

Postseason Awards

All-Big Ten awards, as determined by the coaches and media, will be announced on March 12, 2024. The awards list includes First, Second, and Third All-Big Ten Teams and Honorable Mention, All-Freshman and All-Defensive Team, Coach of the Year, Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year, Sixth Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year, and the Howard Moore Assistant Coach of the Year.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
