#3 Michigan advances to the TIAA Big Ten Men's Basketball Tournament

GAME NOTES

MARYLAND

- Ranked No. 11 in the Associated Press and No. 11 in the USA Today Coaches polls.
- Derik Queen's 31 points mark the most ever by a Terrapin in a Big Ten Tournament game.
- Each of Maryland's last four losses have been by a total of nine points with two of them coming at the buzzer.

MICHIGAN

- Ranked 22nd in the Associated Press and 21st in the USA Today Coaches polls.
- Danny Wolf recorded his 15th double-double this season with 21 points and 14 rebounds. He's the first Michigan player with 15 double-doubles in a single season since Robert Traylor had 20 in 1997-98. Five of his double-doubles were against AP Top 25 opponents, the most by any Michigan player in a campaign in the last 29 seasons.
- Michigan's 18-0 run in the second half marked the longest unanswered run allowed by Maryland this season.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Michigan will make its sixth title game appearance overall and the program's first since 2019.
- This is the second time in Big Ten Tournament history that both semifinals were decided by three points or less. In 2003, Ohio State beat Michigan State 55-54 and Illinois beat Indiana 73-72 to advance to the championship game.
- Michigan was +29 in rebounding today (47-18), the highest rebound margin for any team in a Big Ten Tournament game in the last 20 seasons.
