GAME NOTES

PENN STATE NOTES

- Penn State was making its first Big Ten Quarterfinal appearance since 2014. PSU defeated Wisconsin on Thursday to advance to the quarters.
- The Lady Lions saw their three-game win streak snapped.
- Leilan Kapinus (19 points) led PSU in scoring for the fifth time this season.
- Kapinus, who ranks second in the Big Ten in steals, added two and has 64 on the season.

IOWA NOTES

- Third-ranked Iowa scored 10 seconds into the game and never trailed.
- Caitlin Clark finished with 24 points, surpassing 3,700 for her career (she's now at 3,709).
- Six different Hawkeyes scored three-point baskets, including Clark who broke Steph Curry's NCAA single season record of 162. Clark now has 164.
- Iowa made 15 3-point field goals, tying the tournament record set by Nebraska in 2022.
- Iowa's 44 3-point attempts broke the old record of 32, set by Illinois in 2017.
- The Hawkeyes finished with 30 points off turnovers.
- Iowa surpassed 90 points for the 22nd time this season.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- The Penn State-Iowa series is now tied at 29-29 all-time. Iowa has won the last 10 games in the series dating to 2018.
- Tonight's game was the fourth meeting between the schools at the Big Ten Tournament and the first since 2010. That series is tied at 2-2.
- Penn State is now 29-28 all-time in the Big Ten Tournament and Iowa is 36-25.
