BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- The Big Ten currently boasts a 59-10 overall record through Monday's contests, with teams going a combined 56-3 on their home courts. The Big Ten's .855 win percentage and 59 total wins lead all Div. I conferences.
- Ten Big Ten teams were recognized in this week's AP and USA Today Coaches Polls, announced on Monday. The AP Top 25 included No. 6 Purdue, No. 16 Indiana, No. 19 Wisconsin, No. 24 Rutgers, and No. 25 Illinois, while the coaches listed the Boilermakers at No. 6, the Hoosiers at No. 18, the Illini at No. 20, and the Badgers at 24. Maryland, Michigan, Michigan State, Ohio State, Penn State, and Oregon also received votes in one or both polls.
- This week's schedule included a pair of games against ranked opponents. On Tuesday, Purdue will look for a second consecutive top 15 win, as it visits Marquette at 9 p.m. on FS1. On Wednesday, Illinois will try to hand Alabama a second consecutive loss to a Big Ten team, as the meet in Birmingham at 9 p.m. on the SEC Network.
- Friday night was big for the Big Ten, as a pair of teams scored wins over top 10 opponents. Wisconsin topped No. 9 Arizona 103-88 at the Kohl Center behind a career high 41 points by John Tonje. The graduate student finished two points shy of the program scoring mark but broke the single-game record with 21 made free throws (21-for-22). Tonje's 41 points were the most scored by a player in a win over an AP Top-10 opponent since 2016 when Kentucky's Malik Monk scored 47 in a win over No. 7 North Carolina. Purdue also earned an 87-78 win over then-No. 2 Alabama, the highest-ranked, non-conference opponent that Purdue has ever beaten in Mackey Arena. Trey Kaufman-Renn scored a career-high 26 points, while Fletcher Loyer and Braden Smith added 17 points each. Friday's action marked the second consecutive year the Big Ten has posted a pair of wins over top 10 opponents on the same day. On Dec. 16, 2023, Purdue beat then-No. 1 Arizona 82-84, while Michigan State topped then-No. 6 Baylor 88-64.
- Eleven of the Big Ten's 18 teams rank in the top 40 of the Kenpom Ratings through Monday's games, with all 18 listing in the top 84. Purdue leads the way at No. 12, followed by UCLA (#23), Illinois (#25), Ohio State (#26), Michigan (#27), Oregon (#30), Indiana (#31), Penn State (#32), Maryland (#37), Michigan State (#38), and Wisconsin (#40). No other conference has more than nine teams in the top 40 (SEC) or more than 16 teams in the top 100 (SEC and Big 12).
- On Monday, the Big Ten announced its Player and Freshman of the Week honors. Wisconsin's John Tonje was named Big Ten Player of the Week, while Rutgers' Dylan Harper claimed Freshman of the Week honors. Tonje led the Badgers to a 103-88 win over then-No. 9 Arizona with a career-high 41 points. Tonje finished the game 8-for-14 shooting from the floor, including 4-for-6 from three-point range, 21-for-22 from the free throw line. Tonje's efforts were also recognized by the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA), who named him one of its Oscar Robertson National Players of the Week on Tuesday.
- Harper averaged 22.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists, and 1.0 blocks per game, as the Scarlet Knights topped Saint Peters, 75-65, and Monmouth, 98-81. Harper becomes the first Scarlet Knight named Freshman of the Week since his brother Ron Harper Jr. won the award six seasons ago on March 4, 2019. Harper became the second Scarlet Knight in Rutgers history to score 20-plus points in the first three games of his freshman year, the first player to do it since Phil Sellers in 1972, and the first Rutgers freshman to score at least 20 points in three consecutive games since Corey Sanders in Feb. 2016.
- Three Big Ten teams have been recognized for their success in men's and women's basketball and football. Illinois, Ohio State, and Oregon are mentioned in the Associated Press (AP) polls for all three sports. The Illini are ranked No. 25 and 22 in men's and women's basketball and No. 24 in football. The Buckeyes sit at No. 2 in the football poll and No. 12 in the women's basketball poll, while the Ducks enter this week's action ranked No. 1 on the field and No. 23 in the women's poll. Both Ohio State and Oregon are receiving votes in the men's basketball poll. Oregon is also the only school in the country whose men's and women's basketball and football teams are undefeated. The three Duck programs own a combined 19-0 mark.
- The 2025 Big Ten Men's Basketball Tournament will return to Gainbridge Fieldhouse on March 12-16. This will mark the 14th time the tournament has been held in Indianapolis. The tournament will be the first to feature a 15-team field and begin with three games on Wednesday, March 12. Peacock will televise the opening three games of the 2025 Big Ten Men's Basketball Tournament, with second-round and quarterfinal games on Thursday and Friday slated for Big Ten Network. For the 28th consecutive year, CBS Sports will broadcast the semifinals and championship game on CBS, with those games also streaming live on Paramount+.

2025 BIG TEN MEN'S BASKETBALL TIEBREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING

Tiebreaker Procedures for Tournament Seeding

1. Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 15 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
2. A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runnerup the No. 2 seed, etc.).
3. Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular-season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
4. In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tiebreaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

A. Ties Involving Two Teams:

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
2. Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET rankings that are released on the last Friday of the regular season will be utilized.

B. Ties Involving more than Two Teams:

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
 - a. When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage head-to-head among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. Ties shall be considered separated when a team(s) emerges from the top, middle or bottom of the group and is awarded a seed(s).
 - b. Once a seed is awarded, all remaining tied teams shall restart the tiebreak process at the first criteria (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step a (head-to-head) and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).
2. If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET rankings that are released on the last Friday of the regular season will be utilized.

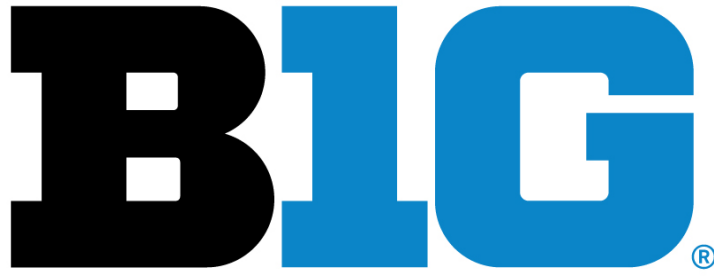

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 18 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 90 universities in the nation according to the 2024 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including 10 in the top 40.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 80 honorees during the 2023-24 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$17 billion in funded research.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 26 of the last 30 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 119 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

Big Ten institutions support more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

Nearly 2,000 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 600 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2024 Summer Olympics in Paris, France, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 98 total medals and 27 gold medals during the 17-day competition, surpassing the previous mark of 51 medals at the 2020 Summer Games in Tokyo, Japan. All 18 Big Ten member schools were represented at the 2024 Summer Games, competing for 64 nations in 17 sports.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 9.4 million alumni and nearly 823,000 students.

Big Ten men's and women's basketball combined for 4.3 million fans in their home arenas throughout the 2023-24 season and paced the nation in total attendance. Volleyball Day in Nebraska attracted 92,003 fans, the largest attendance in women's sports history. All seven of the Big Ten ice hockey teams also ranked in the top 15 nationally in average attendance.

In 2023-24, Big Ten women's basketball programs set ratings records on seven different networks – BTN, FOX, FS1, NBC, Peacock, ESPN and CBS.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Twenty years after adding instant replay in 2004, announced a state-of-the-art replay center, featuring 18 dedicated replay bays and six dedicated medical observation stations.

Championed new legislation for football permitting coach-to-player helmet communication and the use of sideline video by student-athletes, and coaches, both of which were introduced in the fall of 2024.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, NBC, Peacock, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN reaches nearly 50 million homes and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams more than 2,000 additional events each season.

COMMUNITY & IMPACT

The Big Ten Conference is dedicated to making a lasting impact on the communities where its major events are held. In recent years, the conference has hosted sports clinics, renovated recreation centers and given elementary-aged children the chance to experience major Big Ten events.

Around the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference focuses on creating meaningful improvements, aiming to leave each location better than it was found.

Moving forward, the Big Ten will continue to collaborate with the College Football Playoff Foundation, local sports organizations and school district foundations to enhance spaces for teachers and children and provide educational opportunities for youth.
