Co-Players of the Week

Andy Hunter, Minnesota SR, 1B, West St. Paul, Minn./Sibley
Hunter batted .500 (7-for-14) with two home runs, seven runs batted in and eight runs scored to lead the Gophers to a 3-1 series win over first-place Illinois. The senior opened the series by going three-for-four with two RBI and three runs and concluded the four-game set by sparking Minnesota to a doubleheader sweep on Sunday, batting four-for-seven with two long balls, five RBI and four runs.

Mitch Hilligoss, Purdue SO, SS, Windsor, Ill./Windsor
Hilligoss batted .474 (9-for-19) with seven runs batted in and five runs scored to lead Purdue to a 3-1 series victory over Iowa and vault the Boilermakers into second place in the League standings. After losing the series opener, the sophomore drove in three runs, including the game-winning tally, to produce an 8-7 triumph in game two. He added three more RBI and runs in two more victories, capping the final win with a two-run home run.

Pitcher of the Week

Clayton Richard, Michigan FR, LHP, Lafayette, Ind./McCutcheon
Richard collected three saves last week, allowing no runs and only one hit in five and one-third innings with five strikeouts and no walks. Against Notre Dame, the freshman entered the game with a one-run lead and two men on with two outs in the seventh and got a force play before pitching two more shutout innings. In Sunday's doubleheader finale against the Hoosiers he picked up two more saves, allowing no hits or runs in three innings of work.

2005 Big Ten Tournament Only One Week Away

Big Ten Race Goes Down to the Wire: With just one weekend of Big Ten action left, four teams remain alive in the Conference title chase as Illinois, Purdue, Minnesota and Iowa have a chance to earn the trophy and the right to host the 2005 Big Ten Tournament. The Illini (19-9) face the Hawkeyes (16-12) in the final series, as Illinois can clinch the title by splitting the four games. Iowa can still move into first place by sweeping the series depending on the results of other games. The Boilermakers (14-10) are currently in second place and travel to in-state rival Indiana while the Gophers (16-12) are tied for third and face a road test at Ohio State. Minnesota is aiming for a fourth straight title for the first time in program history, while the other three programs will look to end title droughts. Illinois' last crown came in 1998, Iowa's most recent Big Ten Championship was in 1974 while Purdue's sole Conference title was earned in 1909.

Big Ten Tourney Field: Six teams will earn invites to the 2005 Big Ten Tournament, which will be held May 25-28 at the site of the Conference Champion. With just one weekend left, Illinois, Purdue, Minnesota and Iowa have clinched berths while Michigan, Ohio State and Penn State will battle for the final two spots. The Gophers are the reigning Big Ten Tournament Champions and were joined at the 2004 event by Ohio State, Michigan, Michigan State, Purdue and Penn State. The Tournament winner is granted the Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Championship.
