BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Purdue, Illinois, and Wisconsin continue to represent the Big Ten in this week's top-25 polls. The Boilermakers fell one spot to No. 2 in both polls, while Wisconsin moved up to No. 11 in the AP rankings and No. 8 in the Coaches Poll. Illinois enters this week's action at No. 14 in both listings. Nebraska was the only other Big Ten team to earn weekly recognition, as the Huskers received votes in the Coaches Poll.
- Maryland guard Jahmir Young was named Big Ten Player of the Week, presented by Air National Guard, for the week of Jan. 8-14, the guard's second honor in three weeks. Young averaged 20.0 points, 6.5 assists, 3.5 rebounds, and 1.5 steals, as the Terrapins scored a pair of wins. Young scored a game-high 28 points, including 16 in the second half, and recorded eight assists, two rebounds, a steal, and a blocked shot to lead Maryland to a 76-67 win at then-No. 10 Illinois. Young also recorded 10 of his 12 points in the second half a 64-57 win over Michigan, posting a +19 after the halftime break.
- Iowa freshman big man Owen Freeman collected his sixth Big Ten Freshman of the Week honor. Freeman paired a career-high 22 points and 10 rebounds in a victory over Nebraska. The double-double was the freshman's second in three games. The three double-doubles are the most by a Hawkeye freshman since Luka Garza in 2017-18.
- On Wednesday, Jan. 10, the Los Angeles Athletic Club announced the John R. Wooden Award® presented by Principal® Midseason Top 25 Watch List. Purdue's Zach Edey and Michigan State's Tyson Walker were listed among those considered strong candidates for the honor which will be announced following the NCAA Tournament in April.
- MILESTONE WATCH... Michigan State head coach Tom Izzo enters Sunday's game with 698 wins. Izzo is on the verge of becoming the 10th active coach in Div. I to record 700 career victories. Thursday's home contest against Minnesota marked Izzo's 500th career Big Ten game, making him just the second coach in conference history to reach the mark, joining the late Bobby Knight (504)... Ohio State head coach Chris Holtmann will carry 249 career wins into Saturday's home game against Penn State. His 135 victories in Columbus are fifth most in program history.
- Seven Big Ten teams rank in the top-60 in Friday's NET rankings, including four in the top 25. Purdue's No. 2 ranking is tops in the league, while Illinois and Wisconsin sit at Nos. 13 and 16, respectively, followed by No. 22 Michigan State, No. 48 Iowa, No. 49 Ohio State, and No. 58 Nebraska. The Big 12 leads the nation with nine top-60 entrants, one more than the Big East and two more than the Big Ten and SEC.
- The Big Ten's 25 Quad 1 wins are tied with the Big East for the most in the country, three north of the Big 12 and four clear of the ACC. The Big Ten's 45 combined Quad 1 and 2 victories rank second behind the SEC's 47 (16 Q1, 31 Q2). The Big East owns 44 combined Quad 1 and 2 wins (25 Q1, 19 Q2), one more than the AC (21 Q1, 22 Q2).
- The Big Ten ranks among the nation's best conferences on both sides of the hardwood. Offensively, 10 teams average north of 75.0 points per game, led by Iowa's Big Ten-best 87.1 points, which ranks fifth in the country, eight spots north of Purdue (85.1 points). Eight teams also rank in the top-75 in the country in field goal percentage, led by Purdue at 49.3 percent. Iowa (48.1 percent), Minnesota (48.0), Michigan State (47.6), and Indiana (47.6) also rank in the nation's top 50. Much of that offensive efficiency stems from taking care of the ball, as six team list in the top-40 in assists/turnover ratio. Iowa leads the nation with a 1.98 ratio, while Michigan State (1.74) and Northwestern (1.74) sit ninth and 10th, respectively.
- Defensively, the Big Ten boasts nine teams that hold their opponents to below 70 points per game, led by Maryland, who surrenders just 64.0 points per outing, good for 24th nationally, followed by Rutgers, allowing just 65.4 points, and Michigan State at 65.6 points. Four Big Ten teams also rank in the nation's top 35 in field goal percentage defense. Rutgers and Michigan State top the conference, holding their opponents to 39.1 and 39.2 percent shooting, 16th and 18th in the country, respectively. Illinois ranks 25th at 39.5 percent. The Scarlet Knights also rank 10th in the country with 5.7 blocked shots per contest, while Penn State forces a league-best 16.39 turnovers per game, 12th in the country.
- Big Ten players also rank in the top-10 in several individual statistical categories. Purdue's Zach Edey ranks third in the country with 22.9 points per game, fifth in rebounds per game (11.1), and third in double-doubles (11), while his 180 free throw attempts and 136 free throw makes rank first and third in the NCAA. Minnesota's Elijah Hawkins leads the nation with 7.8 assists per contest, while Purdue's Braden Smith (7.1) stands sixth. Two Big Ten players, Michigan State's Tre Holloman and Ohio State's Bruce Thornton sit first and second in the nation with 5.90 and 4.56 assist/turnover ratios. Defensively, Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi's 3.41 blocked shots per game are good for third, while Penn State's Ace Baldwin

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Jr.'s 2.94 steals per game rank third.

- Nine Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-70 in today's Kenpom rankings, including four in the top-20. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by Illinois (#11), Wisconsin (#12), Michigan State (#18), Iowa (#42), Ohio State (#44), Nebraska (#51), Northwestern (#59), and Maryland (#68). The Big 12 leads the nation with 11 teams in the top-70, two more than the Big Ten and Big East, while the SEC and ACC have eight each.
- Nine Eight Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-75 of the ESPN Basketball Power Index (BPI) listing. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by No. 11 Illinois, No. 15 Wisconsin, No. 18 Michigan State, No. 45 Ohio State, No. 40 Iowa, No. 52 Northwestern, No. 62 Nebraska, and No. 74 Maryland. All 14 Big Ten teams also rank in the outlet's top-65 Remaining Strength of Schedule listing.
- More than 2.5 million fans have watched Big Ten basketball this season, including more than 1.6 million fans in our 14 home venues. Seven Big Ten teams rank in the top-25 in total attendance. Indiana leads the Big Ten with 194,013 fans through 12 home games, just north of Michigan State (177,564 fans) and Nebraska (169,282) in fourth and fifth. Illinois (161,019), Wisconsin (151,443), and Purdue (133,884) also rank in the top 20. In total, 13 Big Ten schools rank in the top-50 in total home attendance.
- The Big Ten closed its nonconference slate with a combined 117-37 record. The Big 12 (144-34), SEC (132-47), Atlantic 10 (131-60), and ACC (119-46) collected more wins, but the Big Ten's .760-win percentage falls behind only the Big 12 (.809). Among the Big Ten's 117 victories are 9 wins over AP Top 25 opponents.
- For the sixth consecutive year, each Big Ten Conference member institution will compete in a 20-game conference schedule. The Big Ten Conference season begins Friday, Dec. 1, when Maryland visits Indiana and Northwestern hosts Purdue, the first of 12 conference games played between Dec. 1-10. Following a break in conference play, Big Ten action will resume on Jan. 2. During the conference season, schools will play seven teams twice -- once at home and once on the road and six teams once, with three of those games being at home and the other three away.
- The 27th annual Big Ten Tournament will be played at Target Center in Minneapolis between March 13-17, 2024, marking the first time the tournament has been played in Minneapolis. All 14 teams will advance to the tournament, with two 1st round games slated for Wednesday, March 13th. The top four teams will receive 1st and 2nd round byes and advance to the quarterfinals on Friday, March 15th.
- A Big Ten media panel has chosen 2023 Consensus National Player of the Year Zach Edey as 2023-24 Big Ten Men's Basketball Player of the Year. The league's reigning Player of the Year, Edey became the first Boilermaker since Glenn Robinson in 1994 to win National Player of the Year accolades and the fifth Big Ten Player in the last 14 years to be named National Player of the Year joining Evan Turner (2010), Trey Burke (2013), Frank Kaminsky (2015) and Luka Garza (2021) as National Players of the Year.
- The media panel also selected the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Edey joined Illinois' Terrence Shannon Jr., Maryland's Jahmir Young, and Northwestern's Boo Buie as unanimous selections. Also named to the team were Maryland's Julian Reese, Minnesota's Dawson Garcia, Michigan State's A.J. Hoggard and Tyson Walker, Nebraska's Keisei Tominaga, and Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi. All ten members of the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team received All-Big Ten honors following the 2022-23 campaign. Buie and Shannon joined Edey with First Team accolades, while Omoruyi, Walker, and Young were named to the Second Team. Hoggard earned a spot on the Third Team, with Garcia, Reese, and Tominaga receiving Honorable Mention.

AROUND THE BIG TEN

Illinois: Coleman Hawkins scored a season-high 21 points and added 10 rebounds, four assists, one block and a career-high six steals in Thursday's win over Michigan. He is the only Big Ten player since at least the 2010-11 season to have at least 21 points, 10 rebounds, four assists and six steals in one game.

Indiana: When Indiana visits Wisconsin on Friday, the Hoosiers will attempt to secure the program's first victory in the Kohl Center since a 69-59 result on Jan. 25, 1998, the second men's game ever played in the arena. Indiana has not beaten a ranked Wisconsin team on the road in 12 tries.

Iowa: Iowa is one the nation's top offensive teams, averaging 87.1 points in 17 games. The Hawkeyes are leading the Big Ten and rank fifth nationally. The team has scored at least 84 points in 12 games, averaging 94.9 points in wins and 72.7 points in losses.

Maryland: Jahmir Young is the only active player in the nation with 2,000+ points, 600+ rebounds and 400 assists as he has 2,328 points, 691 rebounds and 435 assists. With 907 points in his second season at Maryland, he is also closing in on being the sixth NCAA player since 2006 to post 1,000 points at two different institutions.

Michigan: In his last eight games, Terrance Williams II has more than half (23) of his season total for three-pointers (40). In fact, in seven of those eight games he has drained three-plus, including a career-best five (5-for-5) against Ohio State (Jan. 15). The 40 triples doubled his prior single season best of 20 set as a sophomore (2021-22; 31 games). In fact, his 40 long range buckets more than his career total of 38 recorded over his first three seasons (84 games).

Michigan State: Guards Tyson Walker and A.J. Hoggard have proven to be one of the best backcourts, not only in the Big Ten, but nationally. In their first season together (2021-22), the duo combined to average 15.2 points, 9.1 assists, 3.6 rebounds and 1.9 steals per game over 36 games. Through 18 games this year, they are averaging 31.2 points, 8.0 assists, 6.2 rebounds and 2.9 steals.

Minnesota: Dawson Garcia scored 36 points at Ohio State and 30 points against Iowa, becoming the first Gopher to earn 30-point games against a league opponent since Marcus Carr in 2020-21 when he accomplished the feat at Nebraska (41 points) and Iowa (30 points). Garcia is one of five players in the Big Ten to record multiple 30-point games in conference play this season.

Nebraska: The Huskers had won 17 consecutive games when scoring over 80 points before Wednesday's 87-82 overtime loss to Rutgers. The team is now 19-2 over the last three years when reaching 80 points, with both losses coming in overtime.

Northwestern: Senior Ty Berry is one of two players in the Big Ten with 35+ three-point field goals and 25 or more (26) steals, joining Michigan State's Tyson Walker. He is the first Wildcat to post those numbers in the first 16 games of a season since John Shurna in 2010-11.

Ohio State: Sophomore big man Felix Okpara has swatted at least one shot in all 16 games he's played this season and dating back to last season, he has blocked a shot in each of his last 23 games. He is one of just three Buckeyes since 2000 to have a streak of at least 23 games with a blocked shot. He joins Ken Johnson (the Big Ten's all-time shot-block leader) and Greg Oden.

Penn State: The Nittany Lions' win over No. 11/8 Wisconsin marked the sixth consecutive season Penn State has defeated a ranked team at the Bryce Jordan Center. The win marks the highest-ranked opponent (per AP Poll) that Penn State has defeated since the Nittany Lions took down No. 4/4 Maryland (76-69) on Dec. 10, 2019 in Happy Valley.

Purdue: Purdue is now 16-2 or better through 18 games the second straight season (17-1 last year) and for the third time in the last seven years (2017-18 also started 16-2). It's the only three times Purdue has been 16-2 or better under Painter.

Rutgers: Derek Simpson posted 14 points, eight rebounds and eight assists in Rutgers' win over Nebraska. He is one of just two Rutgers' players since 2010 with at least 12 points, eight rebounds and eight assists. The other is Corey Sanders, in a 2016 triple overtime game against Illinois (39 points, 12 assists, eight rebounds). Only two other players in the nation have reached that line this season, and it has occurred just twice, including Simpson's performance, in a Big Ten game since 2017.

Wisconsin: Last season, the Badgers ranked 140th in the country in adjusted offensive efficiency per KenPom.com. This year, UW is ranked sixth. UW's 120.0 adjusted offensive efficiency is on pace to match the school's third-highest mark since KenPom began tracking in 1999. The Badgers reached at least the Sweet 16 in the NCAA Tournament in the other three seasons (2014-15, 2010-11, 2013-14).

TIE BREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING

- Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
- A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runner-up the No. 2 seed, etc.).
- Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
- In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

Ties Involving Two Teams

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
- Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
- Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
- Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Ties Involving more than Two Teams

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
 - When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. If winning percentage among the group for any tied teams is equal, move to step b with those specific tied teams only (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step b and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).

Note: Teams can be separated from the top, middle or bottom.
 - If a team or teams are separated from the group based on step a, seeding for remaining teams among the group is not determined by head-to-head record vs. the remaining teams, but rather by taking all remaining teams to next tiebreaker.
- If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - When comparing records against a single team or group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
- Won-loss percentage of Division I opponents.
- Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

All-Big Ten awards, as determined by the coaches and media, will be announced on March 12, 2024. Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
