BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- **MILESTONE WATCH...** Michigan State head coach Tom Izzo will enter Tuesday's home game against Michigan with 699 career wins. A Spartan victory would make him the 10th active coach in Div. I with 700 career wins. Izzo is also scheduled to tie Bobby Knight's conference record 504 games coached when Michigan State hosts Maryland on Saturday.
- Purdue, Wisconsin, and Illinois continue to hold firm in both the AP and USA Today Coaches Polls. The Boilermakers remained at No. 2 in both polls. Wisconsin climbed six spots in the AP and four in the coaches poll to enter this week's action at No. 6, while the Illini slid down to No. 14 in both lists.
- Northwestern's Boo Buie claimed his fourth career Big Ten Player of the Week, presented by Air National Guard, honor for the week of Jan. 22-27. Buie's second award of the season came after averaging 24.0 points, 6.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game, as Northwestern recorded a pair of victories over No. 10 Illinois and Ohio State. The graduate student scored a game-high 29 points, including the game-tying shot that forced overtime and eight points in overtime, to go with seven assists and three steals to lead the Wildcats to a 96-91 win over the Illini. He then led Northwestern to an 83-58 win over Ohio State with a game-high 19 points, five rebounds, five assists and a steal.
- Iowa freshman Owen Freeman earned his seventh Big Ten Freshman of the Week accolade, becoming the eighth player in conference history to collect seven such honors. The only player to earn more was Jared Sullinger (OSU, 2010-11), who earned the award 12 times. Freeman averaged 14.5 points on 55.0 percent shooting and nine rebounds, as the Hawkeyes split a pair of games last week. The rookie tallied 14 points and nine boards in a 69-67 loss to Maryland, the rebounded for 15 points, nine rebounds, and three blocked shots in Iowa's 88-78 win at Michigan.
- For the second time this season, the U.S. Basketball Writers Association has named Buie one of its Oscar Robertson National Players of the Week. The Northwestern guard also earned the honor on Dec. 4. Other players to receive the accolade this week are Denver's Tommy Bruner (Summit League), North Carolina's RJ Davis (ACC), Oregon State's Jordan Pope (Pac-12), and Western Carolina's Vonterius Woolbright (Southern Conference).
- Buie was also named as one of 10 finalists for the 2024 Bob Cousy Award on Monday, the Naismith Hall of Fame announced. Named after Class of 1971 Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic and Holy Cross guard Bob Cousy, the annual honor, now in its 21st year, recognizes the top point guard in Division I men's college basketball. Previous Big Ten winners include Ayo Dosunmu (ILL), Trey Burke (MICH), Greivis Vasquez (MD), and Dee Brown (ILL).
- On Tuesday, the Naismith Hall of Fame announced Michigan State's Tyson Walker as one of the 10 finalists for the 2024 Jerry West Award, recognizing the nation's top shooting guards. Three Big Ten players have previously received the award named after Class of 1980 Hall of Famer and 1959 NCAA Final Four Most Valuable Player, Johnny Davis (WIS), Carsen Edwards (PU), and D'Angelo Russel (OSU).
- Seven Big Ten teams rank in the top-60 in Friday's NET rankings, including four in the top 25. Purdue's No. 2 ranking is tops in the league, while Wisconsin and Illinois sit at Nos. 11 and 14, respectively, followed by No. 25 Michigan State, No. 56 Iowa, No. 59 Nebraska, and No. 60 Northwestern. The Big 12 leads the nation with 10 top-60 entrants, one more than the SEC, while the Big East has eight and ACC six.
- The Big Ten has faced 95 Quad 1 opponents, most of any power conference in the country, while its 148 Quad 1 and 2 opposition, are good for second to the ACC's 151. The Big Ten's 31 Quad 1 wins are second to the Big 12 (36) and one more than the Big East, while its 60 combined Quad 1 and 2 wins sit behind the ACC (63), SEC (61), and Big 12 (61).
- Eight Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-60 in today's Kenpom rankings, including four in the top-20. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by Illinois (#10), Wisconsin (#11), Michigan State (#18), Iowa (#44), Northwestern (#47), Nebraska (#51), and Maryland (#52). The Big 12 leads the nation with 10 teams in the top-60, two more than the Big Ten, Big East, and SEC while the ACC and Pac 12 have six each.
- Nine Eight Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-70 of the ESPN Basketball Power Index (BPI) listing. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by No. 12 Illinois, No. 13 Wisconsin, No. 18 Michigan State, No. 42 Iowa, No. 43 Northwestern, No. 58 Maryland, No. 62 Ohio State, and No. 66 Nebraska. All 14 Big Ten teams also rank in the outlet's top-65 Remaining Strength of Schedule listing.
- The Big Ten ranks among the nation's best conferences on both sides of the hardwood. Offensively, 10 teams average north of 75.0 points per game, led by Iowa's Big Ten-best 85.3 points, which ranks 10th in the country, five spots better than Purdue (84.9 points). Seven teams also rank in the top-65 in the country in field goal percentage, led by Purdue at 49.1 percent. Iowa (48.0), Indiana (47.8 percent), Minnesota (47.8), Wisconsin (47.7), Northwestern (47.4), and Michigan State (47.1) also rank in the nation's top 60. Much of that offensive efficiency stems from taking care of the ball, as five team list in the top-35 in assists/turnover ratio. Iowa leads the nation with a 1.87 ratio, while

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Northwestern (1.83), Michigan State (1.71), Purdue (1.58), and Minnesota (1.48) list among the nation's leaders.

- Defensively, the Big Ten boasts 10 teams that hold their opponents at or below 70.0 points per game, led by Maryland, who surrenders just 63.4 points per outing, good for 12th nationally, followed by Michigan State, allowing just 66.0 points, Rutgers at 66.6, and Wisconsin at 66.9. Six Big Ten teams also rank in the nation's top 45 in field goal percentage defense. Michigan State leads the way, holding its opponents to 39.9 percent shooting, a tick above Rutgers and Nebraska, both at 40. Maryland also ranks 15th in the country with 5.4 blocked shots per contest, just ahead of Rutgers' 5.3 blocks per game, 16th in the country, while Penn State forces a league-best 15.65 turnovers per game, 19th in Div. I.
- Big Ten players also rank in the top-10 in several individual statistical categories. Purdue's Zach Edey ranks second in the country with 23.0 points per game, fourth in rebounds per game (11.4), and third in double-doubles (14), while his 201 free throw attempts and 158 free throws made lead the NCAA. Minnesota's Elijah Hawkins leads the nation with 7.7 assists per contest, while Purdue's Braden Smith's 7.0 are good for sixth. Smith's 148 dimes rank third in the country, one spot above Hawkins with 146. Michigan State's Tre Holloman also leads the nation with a 5.00 assist/turnover ratio, three spots north of Ohio State's Bruce Thornton (4.35). Defensively, Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi's 3.11 blocked shots per game rank third in the country, just ahead of Ohio State's Felix Okpara whose 2.53 blocked shots are good for eighth, while Penn State's Ace Baldwin Jr.'s 2.75 steals per game rank seventh.
- Nearly 3.2 million fans have watched Big Ten basketball this season, including nearly 1.95 million fans in our 14 home venues. Seven Big Ten teams rank in the top-20 in total attendance. Nebraska leads the Big Ten and ranks third in the country with 198,667 fans through 14 games, just north of Indiana, whose 194,013 ranks sixth in the country. Illinois (192,107) and Wisconsin (183,785) list seventh and ninth, respectively. In total, 12 Big Ten schools rank in the top-50 in total home attendance.
- On Jan. 10, the Los Angeles Athletic Club announced the John R. Wooden Award® presented by Principal® Midseason Top 25 Watch List. Purdue's Zach Edey and Michigan State's Tyson Walker were listed among those considered strong candidates for the honor which will be announced following the NCAA Tournament in April.
- The Big Ten closed its nonconference slate with a combined 117-37 record. The Big 12 (144-34), SEC (132-47), Atlantic 10 (131-60), and ACC (119-46) collected more wins, but the Big Ten's .760-win percentage falls behind only the Big 12 (.809). Among the Big Ten's 117 victories are 9 wins over AP Top 25 opponents.
- The 27th annual Big Ten Tournament will be played at Target Center in Minneapolis between March 13-17, 2024, marking the first time the tournament has been played in Minneapolis. All 14 teams will advance to the tournament, with two 1st round games slated for Wednesday, March 13th. The top four teams will receive 1st and 2nd round byes and advance to the quarterfinals on Friday, March 15th.
- A Big Ten media panel has chosen 2023 Consensus National Player of the Year Zach Edey as 2023-24 Big Ten Men's Basketball Player of the Year. The league's reigning Player of the Year, Edey became the first Boilermaker since Glenn Robinson in 1994 to win National Player of the Year accolades and the fifth Big Ten Player in the last 14 years to be named National Player of the Year joining Evan Turner (2010), Trey Burke (2013), Frank Kaminsky (2015) and Luka Garza (2021) as National Players of the Year.
- The media panel also selected the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Edey joined Illinois' Terrence Shannon Jr., Maryland's Jahmir Young, and Northwestern's Boo Buie as unanimous selections. Also named to the team were Maryland's Julian Reese, Minnesota's Dawson Garcia, Michigan State's A.J. Hoggard and Tyson Walker, Nebraska's Keisei Tominaga, and Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi. All ten members of the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team received All-Big Ten honors following the 2022-23 campaign. Buie and Shannon joined Edey with First Team accolades, while Omoruyi, Walker, and Young were named to the Second Team. Hoggard earned a spot on the Third Team, with Garcia, Reese, and Tominaga receiving Honorable Mention.

AROUND THE BIG TEN

Illinois: Coleman Hawkins followed up his six-steal performance at Michigan (1/18) with five more swipes vs. Rutgers (1/21), becoming the first Illini player since Trent Frazier in 2018-19 to record two games with at least five steals in a single season. His combined 11 steals are the most by an Illini over a two-game stretch in 38 years, since Bruce Douglas combined for 12 steals with seven at Michigan (1/18/86) and five at Michigan State (1/12/86).

Indiana: Indiana has used five different starting lineup combinations this season with eight Hoosiers earning a starting spot. Sixth-year senior guard Xavier Johnson returned to the starting five against Illinois last week, while fifth-year senior forward Anthony Walker made his debut in the starting lineup for IU.

Iowa: Owen Freeman has been one of the best freshmen in the Big Ten this season. The Illinois native leads conference freshman in scoring (224), rebounds (123), blocks (34) and is tied for first in steals (20), while ranking second in field goal percentage (.643). His three double-doubles are the most by a freshman in the conference and his 34 blocks are tied for the third-most by a freshman in the NCAA this season.

Maryland: The Terps' 73-51 win over Nebraska on Saturday, the program's largest margin of victory in a home Big Ten game since March 3, 2016, where Maryland defeated Illinois 81-55. Nebraska's 51 points is the fewest Maryland has allowed this season. The Terps held the visitors to just 39 points over the game's final 35 minutes.

Michigan: The Wolverines enter tonight's action looking to snap a five-game losing streak to their in-state rivals. U-M's last win at the Breslin Center was when the unranked Wolverines topped the fourth-ranked Spartans, 82-72, on Jan. 13, 2018. The Maize and Blue were led by Moritz Wagner's 27 points, while Zavier Simpson had 16 and five assists.

Michigan State: Senior A.J. Hoggard ranks 10th on the Spartans' all-time assist list with 525. With 15 points, he will become the 56th member of the MSU 1,000-point club. When he hits the mark, he will be just the seventh player in program history to reach 1,000 career points and 500 career assists.

Minnesota: On Saturday, the Gophers overcame a 22-2 first half run and a 16-point second half deficit to score an 83-74 victory at Penn State. Minnesota outscored the Nittany Lions 52-29 in the second half to snap its four-game losing streak and earn its first win in Happy Valley since a 95-84 overtime victory on Jan. 15, 2018.

Nebraska: With the visit by No. 6 Wisconsin on Thursday, the Huskers will have an opportunity to knock off a pair

of top-10 teams for the first time since 2013-14. NU has multiple top-10 wins five times in school history (2013-14, 1993-94, 1991-92, 1990-91 and 1957-58). Head coach Fred Hoiberg, whose grandfather Jery Bush was the coach of the 1957-58 team, has 10 career wins against top-10 teams and 27 wins over ranked opponents in his collegiate coaching career.

Northwestern: In Saturday's 83-58 win over Ohio State, the Wildcats' defense was on full display. Northwestern held the Buckeyes to just 14 made field goals, while the 25-point margin of victory was the second largest in the 173-game series. The Wildcats held OSU without a field goal for the final 4:12 of the first half and 5:26 of the second half.

Ohio State: Sophomore guard Bowen Hardman has been a bright spot over the last two games. The Cincinnati, Ohio native, who has played in just 15 games in his career, had a career-high 11 points on 3-of-7 from long range at Nebraska and knocked-down his first three-point attempt at Northwestern on Saturday. He is also the lone player with a positive plus/minus in each of the last two games, holding a +2 at Nebraska and a +12 at Northwestern.

Penn State: Senior point guard Baldwin Jr. has proven to be one of the most dynamic players in the conference. He is the first Big Ten player to have a game with at least 25 points (vs. VCU & Michigan), a game with at least 13 assists (at Purdue) and a game with at least eight steals (vs. Northwestern) in a single season since Michigan State's Mateen Cleaves during the 1997-98 season.

Purdue: On Sunday, Zach Edey became the sixth Purdue player to reach 2,000 career points. He now needs just three blocked shots to become the third player in NCAA history with 2,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, 200 blocks and to shoot 60.0 percent from the field. Edey is averaging just 23.5 minutes for his career.

Rutgers: Senior center Cliff Omoruyi has 59 rejections this season, which stands third in the nation and first in the Big Ten in both total and per game (3.11 blocks per game). Omoruyi has had multiple blocks in 15 of the 19 games this season, has eight games of at least four blocks, and two games of at least seven blocks. With one more block, he will become the first Scarlet Knight to record at least 60 blocks in consecutive seasons since Hamady Ndiaye (2008-09 and 2009-10).

Wisconsin: In Friday's 81-66 win over Michigan State last week, the Badgers surpassed 70 points for the 13th time in the last 14 games. On the season, UW is averaging 76.0 ppg, which is the team's highest since averaging 86.3 in the 1970-71 season.

TIE BREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING

1. Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
2. A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runner-up the No. 2 seed, etc.).
3. Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
4. In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

Ties Involving Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
2. Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Ties Involving more than Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
 - a. When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. If winning percentage among the group for any tied teams is equal, move to step b with those specific tied teams only (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step b and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).

Note: Teams can be separated from the top, middle or bottom.
 - b. If a team or teams are separated from the group based on step a, seeding for remaining teams among the group is not determined by head-to-head record vs. the remaining teams, but rather by taking all remaining teams to next tiebreaker.
2. If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Weekly Awards

The Big Ten will name a Player of the Week and Freshman of the Week each Monday of the season. The weekly award winner will be announced on BigTen.org, the weekly release, and on social media. Nominations for the awards are made each week by the men's basketball communications contacts and selected by a vote of the Big Ten Communications staff.

Postseason Awards

All-Big Ten awards, as determined by the coaches and media, will be announced on March 12, 2024. The awards list includes First, Second, and Third All-Big Ten Teams and Honorable Mention, All-Freshman and All-Defensive Team, Coach of the Year, Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year, Sixth Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year, and the Howard Moore Assistant Coach of the Year.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
