GAME NOTES

NEBRASKA

- Secured its third 20-win season in the last four years.
- Advance to a second game at the Big Ten Tournament for the fourth time in the past five years, having appeared in the Big Ten Championship Game last year.
- The 84 points is the most ever scored by Nebraska against Rutgers. Previous high was 70 in 2024 (NEB lost, 71-70); 13 3FGM by the Huskers was the most ever made by Nebraska against Rutgers.
- Alexis Markowski: notched her school-record 52nd career double-double; became first player in Nebraska history with combined career milestones of 1,800 points and 1,200 rebounds.

RUTGERS

- Tonight's game was the first of the season on a neutral court for Rutgers.
- Matched Nebraska in fourth-quarter scoring (23-23).
- Fell to 1-14 this season when shooting less than 40 percent from the floor (finished at a 35.6 percent clip tonight).
- Destiny Adams scored a game-high 25 points, recorded her 15th double-double of the season and finished 13-for-13 from the free throw line.
- Adams has been the team's high scorer 14 times this season.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Nebraska completed a season sweep of Rutgers, having posted a 69-62 win in Piscataway on Jan. 12.
- Rutgers still holds an 8-7 edge in the all-time series against Nebraska.
