About The 2023 Minnesota Golden Gophers

- The University of Minnesota announced on Dec. 12, 2022 that Keegan Cook had been named head volleyball coach. Cook is the eighth full-time head coach and ninth individual to lead the Gophers, which first competed in 1972. He is just the third full-time head coach to lead the program since 1996, following Hugh McCutcheon (2012-22, 277-74 record) and Mike Hebert (1996-2010, 381-137 record). Laura Bush served as interim head coach in 2011.
- Minnesota (22-9, 15-5 Big Ten) finished tied for third in the B1G last season and won 15-or-more conference games for the eighth straight season. The 'U' fell to Ohio State in the Sweet 16 after defeating SE Louisiana and UNI in the first two rounds.
- The 'U' won eight matches against top 25 teams, including sweeps vs. then No. 6 Wisconsin and No. 5 Nebraska. The Gophers also beat No. 8 Ohio State (away) in addition to No. 13 Florida, No. 18 Oregon and No. 12 Purdue at the Pav.
- The Gophers return seven athletes who started matches last year in the 2022 run to the NCAA Regional Semifinal. First Team All-American and Big Ten Player of the Year Taylor Landfair and First Team All-Big Ten selection Melani Shaffmaster return to pace Minnesota. Landfair was the only Big Ten player to be named AVCA First Team All-America in 2022.
- Middle blocker Arica Davis (1.23 bps) and Freshman All-Big Ten selection Mckenna Wucherer (2.73 kps) could see increased roles in their second seasons at Minnesota in 2023. Wucherer was the No. 1 overall recruit in the class of 2022.
- Three transfers joined the mix this summer as Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year Kylie Murr (5th Year Libero, Ohio State), Phoebe Awoleye (Senior Middle, Loyola Marymount) and Lydia Grote (Senior Outside/Opposite, California) come to campus. Awoleye was First Team All-WCC in 2022 while Grote led California in kills and points.
- In 2022, the 'Ú' finished No. 10 in the final AVCA Poll, its eighth straight top-10 finish nationally, one of three programs in the country to accomplish this feat during that time period.
- The Gophers have had eight straight Sweet 16 or better finishes dating back to 2015.
- All eight of Minnesota's 2023 non-conference opponents made the 2022 NCAA Tournament. Five made the Sweet 16 or better, including 2022 national champion Texas, who visits Minneapolis on Tuesday, Aug. 29.
