BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- With just over a month left in the regular season, the Big Ten standings remain jumbled. While Purdue sits atop the standings at 10-2, while Illinois and Wisconsin remain within striking distance at 8-3. Michigan finds itself at the bottom of the standings at 2-9, with Rutgers and Ohio State at 3-7 and 3-8, respectively. The other eight teams in the league sit between 6-5 and 5-6.
- MILESTONE WATCH...** Congratulations to Michigan State head coach Tom Izzo who tied Bobby Knight's mark of 504 Big Ten Conference games coached on Saturday. Izzo could break the mark on Tuesday, when the Spartans visit Minnesota.
- Five teams earned mention in this week's AP and USA Today Coaches Polls, announced on Monday. Purdue held steady at No. 2, while Illinois moved up to No. 10 in the AP and 12 in the coaches poll. Wisconsin slipped to No. 11 in the AP list, while the coaches placed the Badgers at No. 9. Michigan State collected votes in both polls, while the coaches also recognized Northwestern.
- Purdue's Zach Edey was named Big Ten Player of the Week, presented by Air National Guard, for the week of Jan. 28-Feb. 4. The honor is the third of the season and 10th of his career, tying Ohio State's Evan Turner (2008-10) for the most Player of the Week honors in a career. The Boilermakers' big man averaged 24.0 points, 14.0 rebounds, 2.0 blocks, and 1.5 assists in leading Purdue with wins over Northwestern and No. 6 Wisconsin. Edey shot 11-14 from the floor and paired 30 points and 15 rebounds, while playing 41 minutes of a 105-96 overtime win over Northwestern. He added 18 points, 13 rebounds, and three blocked shots to lead the Boilermakers to a 75-69 win at Wisconsin in a battle for the top spot in the Big Ten standings.
- Minnesota's Cam Christie was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week after scoring 15 points, including 10 in the second half, as the Gophers erased a nine-point deficit to top Northwestern 75-66 in overtime. Christie hit a three-pointer with 44 seconds left in regulation to give Minnesota its first lead since the 9:10 mark of the first half. win at Michigan.
- Purdue's Zach Edey has been named to the John R. Wooden Award® presented by Principal® Late Season Top 20 Watch List, the Los Angeles Athletic Club announced on Tuesday. Edey, who also won the award after the 2022-23 season, is looking to become the award's first repeat winner since Ralph Sampson in 1982 and 1983.
- On Wednesday, the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame named Ohio State's Jamison Battle to the 2024 Julius Erving Top 10 list. Named for the Class of 1993 Hall of Famer and 16-year professional basketball player, the award, in its 10th year, recognizes the top small forwards in Division I. Battle would join Michigan State's Denzel Valentine (2016) as the Big Ten's only recipients of the honor.
- Purdue's Zach Edey and Minnesota's Dawson Garcia have been named to the 2024 Naismith Hall of Fame Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Top 10 List, recognizing the top center in Division I. Edey, who won the award in 2023, joined Iowa's Luke Garza (2020, 2021), Wisconsin's Ethan Happ (2019), and Wisconsin's Frank Kaminsky (2015) as previous Big Ten award recipients.
- Eight Big Ten teams rank in the top-70 in Friday's NET rankings, including four in the top 25. Purdue's No. 2 ranking is tops in the league, while Wisconsin and Illinois sit at Nos. 13 and 14, respectively, followed by No. 22 Michigan State, No. 52 Nebraska, No. 59 Northwestern, No. 60 Iowa, and No. 67 Ohio State. The Big 12 leads the nation with 11 top-70 entrants, two more than the Big East and SEC, while the Big Ten has eight, one more than the ACC.
- The Big Ten has faced 105 Quad 1 opponents and a combined 174 Quad 1 and 2 opponents, most of any power conference in the country. The Big Ten's 33 Quad 1 wins are third, behind the Big 12 (42) and the Big East (34), while its 76 combined Quad 1 and 2 wins are tops in the nation, five clear of the ACC and eight better than the Big 12.
- Eight Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-60 in today's Kenpom rankings, including four in the top-20. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by Illinois (#10), Wisconsin (#12), Michigan State (#17), Nebraska (#46), Northwestern (#50), Iowa (#51), and Maryland (#53). The Big 12 leads the nation with 10 teams in the top-60, one more than the Big East, while the Big Ten and SEC have eight each.
- According to KenPom, the Big Ten currently owns a 108.3 efficiency rating, highest in the country among power conferences (ACC, Big East, Big 10, Big 12, Pac-12, SEC) and seventh highest overall. It is the highest among the power conferences since at least 1999. In that time, only one other conference, the Big East reached a 108 rating (2018).
- In Big Ten play, teams are protecting their home floors to the tune of a 68.4 win percentage (52-24), fourth best home winning percentage among all conferences. The Big Ten's 52 home conference victories are the most of any league in the nation.
- Nine Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-65 of the ESPN Basketball Power Index (BPI) listing. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by No. 13 Illinois, No. 17 Wisconsin, No. 18 Michigan State, No. 44 Northwestern, No. 45 Iowa, No. 52 Nebraska, No. 61 Maryland, and No. 65 Ohio State. Twelve Big Ten teams also rank in the outlet's top-65 Remaining

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Strength of Schedule listing.

- The Big Ten ranks among the nation's best conferences on both sides of the hardwood. Offensively, the league is tied for second among all conferences in scoring (76.0 ppg), second in total assists (4,580), fifth in total points (23,562), and fifth in field goal percentage (47.75). Eleven teams average north of 75.0 points per game, led by Purdue's Big Ten-best 85.3 points, which ranks eighth in the country, eight spots better than Iowa (84.2 points). Seven teams also rank in the top-60 in the country in field goal percentage, led by Purdue at 49.4 percent. Minnesota (47.7), Indiana (47.7), Iowa (47.6), Northwestern (47.5 percent), Michigan State (47.4), and Wisconsin (47.1) also rank in the nation's top 55. Much of that offensive efficiency stems from taking care of the ball, as five team list in the top-40 in assists/turnover ratio. Iowa ranks third with a 1.87 ratio, while Northwestern (1.78), Michigan State (1.73), Purdue (1.59), and Minnesota (1.49) list among the nation's leaders.
- Defensively, the Big Ten boasts 10 teams that hold their opponents below 71 points per game, led by Maryland, who surrenders just 63.4 points per outing, good for 12th nationally, followed by Michigan State, allowing just 65.3 points, Rutgers at 66.0, and Wisconsin at 67.8. Six Big Ten teams also rank in the nation's top 60 in field goal percentage defense. Michigan State leads the way, holding its opponents to 39.6 percent shooting, a tick above Rutgers (40.2 percent), Nebraska (40.4), Maryland (40.6), and Illinois (41.0). Maryland also ranks 14th in the country, with 5.4 blocked shots per contest, just ahead of Rutgers' 5.1 blocks per game, 20th in the country, while Penn State forces a league-best 15.73 turnovers per game, 15th in Div. I.
- Big Ten players also rank in the top-10 in several individual statistical categories. Purdue's Zach Edey ranks third in the country with 23.1 points per game, fourth in rebounds per game (11.7), and third in double-doubles (16), while his 239 free throw attempts lead the nation and 170 free throws made rank second. Minnesota's Elijah Hawkins leads the nation with 7.8 assists per contest, while Purdue's Braden Smith's 7.3 are good for fourth. Smith's 167 dimes lead the country, four spots above Hawkins with 156. Ohio State's Bruce Thornton leads the country with a 4.62 assist/turnover ratio. (NOTE: Michigan State's Tre Holloman's ratio is 4.2, but he is three assists shy of qualifying for the NCAA statistics.) Defensively, Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi's 3.0 blocked shots per game rank fourth in the country, just ahead of Ohio State's Felix Okpara whose 2.48 blocked shots are good for eighth, while Penn State's Ace Baldwin Jr.'s 2.82 steals per game rank sixth.
- More than 3.5 million fans have watched Big Ten basketball this season, including more than 2.1 million fans in our 14 home venues. Seven Big Ten teams rank in the top-20 in total attendance. Indiana leads the Big Ten and ranks third in the country with 228,457 fans through 14 games. Nebraska (213,985), Illinois (207,651), and Michigan State (207,158) also rank in the top 10, sitting at fifth, sixth, and seventh, respectively. In total, 11 Big Ten schools rank in the top-50 in total home attendance.
- The Big Ten closed its nonconference slate with a combined 117-37 record. The Big 12 (144-34), SEC (132-47), Atlantic 10 (131-60), and ACC (119-46) collected more wins, but the Big Ten's .760-win percentage falls behind only the Big 12 (.809). Among the B1G's 117 victories are 9 wins over AP Top 25 opponents.
- A Big Ten media panel has chosen 2023 Consensus National Player of the Year Zach Edey as 2023-24 Big Ten Men's Basketball Player of the Year. The league's reigning Player of the Year, Edey became the first Boilermaker since Glenn Robinson in 1994 to win National Player of the Year accolades and the fifth Big Ten Player in the last 14 years to be named National Player of the Year joining Evan Turner (2010), Trey Burke (2013), Frank Kaminsky (2015) and Luka Garza (2021) as National Players of the Year.
- The media panel also selected the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Edey joined Illinois' Terrence Shannon Jr., Maryland's Jahmir Young, and Northwestern's Boo Buie as unanimous selections. Also named to the team were Maryland's Julian Reese, Minnesota's Dawson Garcia, Michigan State's A.J. Hoggard and Tyson Walker, Nebraska's Keisei Tominaga, and Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi. All ten members of the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team received All-Big Ten honors following the 2022-23 campaign. Buie and Shannon joined Edey with First Team accolades, while Omoruyi, Walker, and Young were named to the Second Team. Hoggard earned a spot on the Third Team, with Garcia, Reese, and Tominaga receiving Honorable Mention.

AROUND THE BIG TEN

Illinois: The Illini knocked down nine three-pointers in their win over Nebraska, the team's 17th consecutive game with at least six triples. The streak ranks as the third-longest active streak in the nation among Power Conference teams. Coleman Hawkins led the club, shooting 4-7 from deep, marking his 10th game this season with multiple three-pointers.

Indiana: In nine conference games, sophomore Kel-el Ware is averaging a team-high 15.8 points on 60.2% (56-of-93) shooting from the floor and 53.8% (7-of-13) from the 3-point line. He is also averaging 10.7 rebounds and 1.7 blocks per night. He is one of three players (Zach Edey; Purdue; Julian Reese; Maryland) to average a double-double in Big Ten play.

Iowa: Senior Tony Perkins has scored 20+ points in five consecutive games – a first by a Hawkeye since Keegan Murray in the 2021-22 season. Perkins is the first Iowa guard to accomplish the feat since Fred Brown in 1971; he is averaging 22 points, four assists, 3.6 assists and 2.2 steals, while committing just six turnovers in the five-game stretch. Perkins is also currently the only player in the Big Ten (and one of six nationally) with at least 340 points, 90 assists, 90 rebounds, and 40 steals and the only player among the six with fewer than 35 turnovers.

Maryland: After posting his third 30-point game of the season, and the fifth of his career, at Michigan State, Jahmir Young joined an elite group of Maryland legends. Young has three 30-point road games in his Maryland career which is tied for the second most alongside Len Bias and Greivis Vasquez. Walt Williams has the most in program history with five that came as part of a seven-game stretch of scoring 30-or-more points.

Michigan: Terrance Williams II leads the Wolverines and is tied for eighth in the Big Ten with 43 made three pointers, more than his previous career total of 38 and more than double his previous single season best of 20 in 2021-22. Nearly 50 percent of Williams' offense comes from beyond the arc -- 109 of his 209 shot attempts have come from long range. He is shooting 39.4 percent.

Michigan State: Tyson Walker is one of 5 players in Division I averaging at least 18.9 ppg, 2.5 rpg, 3.0 apg and 1.9 spg. The graduate student has scored in double figures in his last 33 games dating back to last season. The scoring run is tied with Kalin Lucas for the longest such run under head coach Tom Izzo.

Minnesota: All five starters scored in double figures in Saturday's overtime win over Northwestern, marking the eighth time this season that has happened and second-straight game. Minnesota has also had four score in double digits this year. The Gophers are 12-0 when four or more players score double digits.

Nebraska: The Huskers enter Wednesday's game with a 16-7 record, NU's best record since also going 16-7 in 1994-95. The last time the Huskers had a better record after 23 games was a 17-6 mark in 1991-92. A win on Wednesday would mark the first time since the mid-1960's (1963-64 to 1965-66) that Nebraska has increased its win total for three straight years.

Northwestern: The Wildcats will look to rebound from back to back overtime losses. This is just the second time in program history and the first since 1983-84 that the program has played consecutive overtime games and the first time both games were on the road. The setbacks also make this the first time in program history a Northwestern team has gone 21 games without consecutive defeats.

Ohio State: Sophomore big man Felix Okpara has swatted at least one shot in all 21 games he's played this season and dating back to last season, he has blocked a shot in each of his last 28 games. He joins Ken Johnson and Greg Oden as one of just three Buckeyes since 2000 to have a streak of at least 28 games with a blocked shot. Of the players who have played in 15 or more games this season, he is one of two that have had at least one block in every game they have played.

Penn State: The Nittany Lions scored its first back to back road conference victories of the season last week, topping Rutgers, 61-46, and Indiana, 85-71. The win in Bloomington marked the program's first triumph at Indiana since Feb. 12, 2014 and fourth road win all-time in the series.

Purdue: Sunday's win at Wisconsin was the program's first road game over a top-6 ranked opponent since March 5, 1994, a 95-94 win over No. 3-ranked Michigan. It was Purdue's first road win over a top-10 ranked opponent since Feb. 17, 2010, a 60-57 win over No. 9-ranked Ohio State. The Boilermakers have now won seven consecutive games over AP top-10 ranked teams, tying the longest such streak in Big Ten history (Ohio State – 2010-12; Michigan State – 2000; Ohio State 1960-61).

Rutgers: The Scarlet Knights overcame a 15-point second half deficit and closed the game on an 18-2 run to claim a 69-59 win at Michigan on Saturday. The win was Rutgers' first ever at the Crisler Arena. There are now three Big Ten arenas in which Rutgers has not won, the Breslin Center (Michigan State), Value City Arena (Ohio State), and the State Farm Center (Illinois).

Wisconsin: The Badgers entered this week ranked ninth in the country in offensive efficiency according to KenPom.com. In fact, UW's 120.7 adjusted offensive efficiency (points per 100 possessions) is on track to go down as the school's third-highest mark since KenPom began tracking back in 1999.

BIGTEN.ORG

The Big Ten Conference's official website - BigTen.org - is the source for complete conference basketball information. The site is updated daily with statistics, standings, notes and other important information.

Big Ten Release

The Big Ten's men's basketball release will be available every Tuesday during the nonconference portion of the season, then on Tuesday and Friday during conference play. It will be available on BigTen.org and through the Big Ten Men's Basketball email distribution list.

Accredited media may register for the Big Ten men's basketball email list by contacting the Big Ten Communications staff or visiting BigTen.org/Media.

Weekly Awards

The Big Ten will name a Player of the Week and Freshman of the Week each Monday of the season. The weekly award winner will be announced on BigTen.org, the weekly release, and on social media. Nominations for the awards are made each week by the men's basketball communications contacts and selected by a vote of the Big Ten Communications staff.

Postseason Awards

All-Big Ten awards, as determined by the coaches and media, will be announced on March 12, 2024. The awards list includes First, Second, and Third All-Big Ten Teams and Honorable Mention, All-Freshman and All-Defensive Team, Coach of the Year, Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year, Sixth Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year, and the Howard Moore Assistant Coach of the Year.

TIE BREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING

1. Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
2. A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runner-up the No. 2 seed, etc.).
3. Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
4. In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

Ties Involving Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
2. Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Ties Involving more than Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
 - a. When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. If winning percentage among the group for any tied teams is equal, move to step b with those specific tied teams only (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step b and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).

Note: Teams can be separated from the top, middle or bottom.
 - b. If a team or teams are separated from the group based on step a, seeding for remaining teams among the group is not determined by head-to-head record vs. the remaining teams, but rather by taking all remaining teams to next tiebreaker.
2. If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for volleyball, men's basketball, ice hockey and wrestling.



Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
