#### A LOOK AT THE SCARLET KNIGHTS

Rutgers volleyball looks to continue its upward trend with nine returning letterwinners and bolstering the experience on the court with six newcomers. Head coach Caitlin Schwehofer enters her fourth season as the Scarlet Knights continue to grow in the nation's number-one volleyball conference.

Joining Schwehofer on media day will be a pair of outside hitters in rising sophomore Taylor Humphrey and redshirt sophomore Alissa Kinkela.

Humphrey, a native Bryon Center, Michigan, and animal science major, was selected for the U.S. Women's National Open team this past spring after averaging a team-second best 2.54 kills per set along with 1.80 digs per set and 15 aces. Among her Big Ten notable performances was swinging a season-best .419 hitting percentage against No. 5 Purdue with 16 kills on 31 attempts and a season-high 14 digs against Maryland. During the nonconference schedule, Humphrey was named to the College of Charleston Classic All-Tournament Team.

Kinkela, a native of Melbourne, Australia and a labor studies major, appeared in all 32 matches taking the court for 109 of RU's 110 sets. She led Rutgers with 301 kills averaging a team-best 2.76 per match and leading the Scarlet Knights in the category 14 ties. Her 21 kills against Michigan State marked the second-most by a Scarlet Knight in a Big Ten match since joining the league in 2014 and the most since 2017. She also had 18 kills against 2021 CAA Champion Towson and 17 kills against 2021 SoCon champion The Citadel along with a career-best .444 hitting percentage in a sweep of Iowa. During the nonconference portion of last year's schedule, Kinkela was named to two all-tournament teams at the College of Charleston Classic and the Rutgers Tournament.

In Schwehofer's first season, played in the spring of 2021 due to Covid-19, the Scarlet Knights tripled its conference win total en route to capturing numerous program firsts. Among the team's first were its first-ever All-Big Ten honoree and Big Ten series sweeps. The Scarlet Knights won their first-ever Big Ten home opener, earned victories over Indiana and Michigan State for the first time in history, captured two series sweeps against Maryland and Michigan State, picked up set victories against No. 4 Nebraska and No. 10 Purdue and pushed No. 19 Ohio State to five sets and match point. RU established new team, season and match records for aces and reset program Big Ten game bests in kills, attempts, attack percentage and assists, as well as individual conference superlatives in attack percentage, assists and digs.

Returning to fall ball for the 2021 season only three and a half months after the conclusion of the Big Ten-only 2020 season, Rutgers continued to make strides going 8-3 for its best nonconference record since 2012. During the season the Scarlet Knights battled eight Top 25 teams during Big Ten play, a conference that sent eight teams to the NCAA Tournament, including the year's national champion. Rutgers captured set wins over No. 8 Purdue and No. 15 Penn State and took Illinois to five sets in front of a national audience on BTN. Inna Balyko wrapped up her career fifth all-time in assists and ninth all-time in block assists, while Kamila Cieslik became the rally era leader in matches played (132) and Beka Kojadinovic concluded her career as the rally era leader in aces.

Last season, Rutgers incorporated eight newcomers into the mix continuing to make notable strides. The Scarlet Knights opened the year at 3-0 for the first time since 1998 and battled eight Top 25 teams during Big Ten play and eight teams that advanced to the 2022 NCAA Tournament. During the nonconference schedule, four Scarlet Knights were named to All-Tournament squads. Altogether Rutgers had 11 entries among the rally-era season leaders list including rising senior Kristina Grkovic who was third serving up 34 aces on the year. RU also had 11 entries among the rally-era career leaders list with returnees senior Madyson Chitty fourth in career digs per set and sixth in career digs, Grkovic ninth in career solo blocks and 10th in career blocks per set, rising fifth-year Alyssa Nayar eighth in career assists per set, Humphrey and Kinkela, meanwhile, finished fifth and sixth respectively in career kills per set. Humphrey also had another notable record book entry as she tied for most kills in a rally-era three set match with 18 kills against the College of Charleston.

## HEAD COACH CAITLIN SCHWEIHOFFER

**St. John's '07**  
**Overall Record: 95-167/11th Season**  
**Record at RU: 22-59/Fourth Season**

Caitlin Schwehofer was named the Rutgers head women's volleyball coach on January 15, 2020 and enters her fourth season at Rutgers.

In Schwehofer's first season "On The Banks" in the spring of 2021, the Rutgers Scarlet Knights established themselves as a program on the rise with numerous program and Big Ten firsts. Among the Scarlet Knights' spring 2021 accomplishments were the first-ever All-Big Ten honoree, first-ever home-opening Big Ten victory, first-ever Big Ten series sweep, set victories over more than one Top 10 program along with the team's first-ever wins over Indiana and Michigan State. RU established new team, season and match records for aces and reset program Big Ten game bests in kills, attempts, attack percentage and assists and individual conference superlatives in attack percentage, assists and digs.

The second season of the Schwehofer era saw the Scarlet Knights move a majority of its home games to Jersey Mike's Arena (formerly known as The RAC) playing members of the nation's top conference in the 8,000-seat arena. Rutgers captured set wins over #8 Purdue and #15 Penn State and took Illinois to five sets in front of a national audience on BTN.

The fall of 2022 saw RU 3-0 for the first time since 1998 with four Scarlet Knights named to All-Tournament squads. By the season's end, Rutgers had 11 entries on the rally-era season leaders list including Megan Vernon who wrapped up her career ranked second in the rally era in solo blocks in only two seasons as a Scarlet Knight and freshman Taylor Humphrey tying for the most kills in a rally-era three set match. RU also continued to re-write the rally-era career leaders section of the record book with 11 entries at the end of the season.

Prior to arriving at Rutgers, Schwehofer was at the helm of the Northeastern women's volleyball team taking over the reins of the Huskies program after five seasons at La Salle, where she earned 2018 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year honors.

Under Schwehofer's tutelage in 2019, Northeastern captured its best hitting percentage since 2008, earned a trio of all-conference honors and finished the season ranked among the top three in the Colonial Athletic Association in hitting percentage, kills, digs and assists.

During her tenure at La Salle, Schwehofer recruited and coached the Atlantic 10 Setter of the Year, as well as multiple all-conference and all-rookie selections and saw the team earn the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA)

Team Academic Award each season. She led the Explorers to its first-ever Atlantic 10 tournament appearance in 2018 as the squad concluded the regular season at 17-11 overall, the most wins for the program since the 1998 season. Additionally, six members of the team earned conference accolades including Setter of the Year as Schwehofer was honored as the league's coach of the year.

Schwehofer oversaw an eight-win improvement over the span of the 2015-17 seasons, which included beginning the 2015 season with five-straight wins for the best start in program history. The 2015 season also saw her named to the AVCA Thirty Under Thirty list as she implemented the third largest turnaround in program history.

Schwehofer was also actively engaged in fundraising efforts for the program at LaSalle, helping to oversee a 650% increase in funding, including \$40,000 for locker room renovations.

Before joining the collegiate head coaching ranks, Schwehofer spent a season as the top assistant at Lehigh as the Mountain Hawks captured a 20-9 overall record and 11-5 mark in the Patriot League. The 11 conference wins tied a school record, while the 20 victories on the season were the most by the program since 2002 and the sixth most in Lehigh history.

Prior to Lehigh, Schwehofer spent one season as an assistant at Bucknell and served as the head coach of Pope John Paul II School in Royersford, Pennsylvania, where as the program's first-ever coach, she led the team to two top 10 Pennsylvania state rankings and a pair of PIAA District I runner-up finishes.

A 2007 graduate of St. John's (NY), with a major in communication science, Schwehofer was the 2006 Big East Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year, captaining the Red Storm to a Big East Championship behind a 31-5 overall record and undefeated 14-0 mark in conference play. The Red Storm ranked as high as No. 24 in the national polls and advanced to the NCAA Second Round. In the classroom, Schwehofer completed her degree in three years with a 3.9 cumulative grade point average earning a trio of Academic All-Big East distinctions, while her play on the court earned her Second Team All-Big East and First Team Academic All-District honors in 2006. She was also a CoSIDA Academic All-District selection as a senior, inducted into the Chi Alpha Sigma Honor Society for student-athletes and co-founded STAR (Students Teaching Athletes Responsibility) at St. John's.

The Trooper, Pennsylvania native also earned Master's in educational leadership and higher education administration with an emphasis in change management from Lehigh in 2014.

Schwehofer is a member of the NCAA National Post-Graduate Scholarship and AVCA East Region All-America Selection Committees and is a former member of the AVCA Head Coaches and Top 25 Poll Committees.
