The 40th Big Ten Conference Women's Golf Championships will take place April 22-24 in Pittsburgh, Pa., at the Fox Chapel Golf Club. The tournament will consist of 54 holes, with single rounds played daily. Coverage of this year's tournament will be provided by Big Ten Network and the FOX Sports app (exact dates/times TBD).

Michigan State is the defending champion, claiming its ninth Big Ten title in 2021, carding a score of 853 (-11) to forge a five-stroke victory over a trio of challengers (Maryland, Michigan and Nebraska) in a tournament played at the TPC River's Bend in Maineville, Ohio.

MICHIGAN WINS BIG TEN WOMEN'S GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS

PITTSBURGH, Pa. $\hat{a} \in M$ in Michigan won the 2021-22 Big Ten Women $\hat{a} \in M$ Golf Championship at Fox Chapel Golf Club in Pittsburgh, Pa., after firing a team score of 857 (+5; 285, 281, 291). The Wolverines, who won their first Big Ten title, earned the conference $\hat{a} \in M$ automatic berth to the NCAA Championships.

Michigan State took second place (+9; 861), while Northwestern and Ohio State tied for third with matching scores of 864 (+12).

Michiganâ€[™]s Monet Chun captured medalist honors after finishing the event with a score of 205 (-8; 70, 66, 69). Chunâ€[™]s 205 marks the lowest winning 54-hole score in the history of the Big Ten Championships. The Richmond Hills, Ontario, native becomes the fifth Wolverine golfer to earn a medal at the Big Ten Championships.

Ohio State $\hat{a}\in TM$ s Faith Choi fired a final-round 67 (-4), moving six spots up the leaderboard and taking second place with a total of 209 (-4; 71, 71, 67).

Northwesternâ€TMs Jennifer Cai finished in third (211; 71, 68, 72), Nebraskaâ€TMs Kirsten Baete took fourth (212; 71, 73, 68), and Marylandâ€TMs Maria Vittoria Corbi rounded out the top five with a score of 214 (+1; 69, 71, 74).

Michigan's Ashley Lau earned the Mary Fossum Award, honoring the conference's player with the lowest stroke average relative to par this season (+0.10).

Big Ten Network will debut coverage of the Big Ten Women's Golf Championships on Saturday, May 14 at noon ET. The NCAA Women's Golf Championships selection show will air on the Golf Channel on Wednesday, April 27, beginning at 4 p.m. ET.

Maryland and Ohio State finished the day tied for fifth (+9; 577).

Michiganâ \in^{TM} s Monet Chun moved into first place (-6; 136) after firing a 66 (-5) in the second round. Illinoisâ \in^{TM} Crystal Wang holds second place after carding a 66 (-5) and jumping 14 spots up the leaderboard, while Northwesternâ \in^{TM} s Jennifer Cai rounds out the top three with a two-round total of 139 (-3).



The Spartans fired a team score of 282 (-2) on Friday and hold a three-stroke advantage over Michigan and Purdue (+1; 285) heading into Saturdayâ€TMs second round. Illinois and Maryland finished the day tied for fourth place with matching team scores of 288 (+4), while Northwestern and Ohio State share sixth place with a total of 289 (+5).

Michigan Stateâ€TMs Leila Raines and Nebraskaâ€TMs Michaela Vavrova share the individual lead after posting an opening-round 68 (-3). Marylandâ€TMs Maria Vittoria Corbi and Purdueâ€TMs Danielle DuToit share third (-2; 69), while four golfers share fifth place following a first-round score of 70 (-1): Illinoisâ€TM Isabel Sy, Marylandâ€TMs Patricie Mackova, and Michiganâ€TMs Monet Chun and Sophia Trombetta.
