WISCONSIN TAKES ON NORTHWESTERN IN BIG TEN TOURNEY QUARTERFINALS

- Wisconsin advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2024 Big Ten Tournament with a 87-56 win over Maryland.
- The Badgers will play in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals for the 7th time in the last 8 years.
- UW is now 27-22 (.551) overall in the Big Ten Tournament.
- With a record of 20-12 this season, the Badgers have now reached 20 wins for the 16th time in the last 18 seasons.
- Head coach **Greg Gard** improved his overall record to 184-105 (.637), including a mark of 6-7 in the Big Ten Tournament.
- Wisconsin is ranked **#22** in the **NET** rankings (through games March 13), owning 4 Quad 1 wins and 13 Quad 1+2 wins.
 - The Badgers are **1 of 12 teams in the country with 13 or more Quad 1+2 wins** this season.
- Wisconsin improved to 15-8 all-time against Maryland, including a mark of 10-6 since the Terrapins joined the Big Ten in 2015.
 - UW improved to 2-0 against the Terps in the Big Ten Tournament.
 - Greg Gard is now 10-5 against Maryland.
- The Badgers' 31-point win over Maryland was the team's largest margin of victory in a Big Ten Tournament, surpassing the team's 76-48 win over Northwestern in 2017. It also tied the 3rd-largest by any team in Big Ten Tournament history.
- The Badgers scored 87 points against the Terps, the team's most in a Big Ten Tournament game, surpassing the previous high of 84 against Maryland in 2018.
- Wisconsin is 7-3 when scoring 80 or more points this season.
 - UW is averaging 74.8 ppg, the team's highest mark since scoring 77.9 ppg in 1993-94.
- Wisconsin held Maryland to 56 points and just 42.9% shooting. The Badgers are 16-0 when holding teams to 70 or fewer points this season.
- UW connected on 16 3-pointers vs. the Terrapins, the third-highest total in school history and the most in a Badgers postseason game. The 16 triples is also the second-most in Big Ten Tournament history.
- Wisconsin went 16-for-25 (64.0%) from 3-point range, which is the team's best mark since going 16-for-25 against Louisville on Dec. 19, 2020.
- The Badgers' 64.0% shooting from long range is also the third-highest effort in Big Ten Tournament history (min. 8 attempts).
- The Badgers are 13-2 when shooting 40% or better from 3-point range.
- UW shot 51.7% from the field overall, marking the team's 11th game shooting 50.0% or better.
- The Badgers are 10-1 when shooting 50% or better this season.
- The Badgers are 17-1 when shooting better than their opponent.
- Wisconsin was 9-11 at the foul line and is now shooting 76.0% (476-626) on the season, which would be the 5th-highest mark in school history.
- During the second half against Maryland, the Badgers went on a 23-0 run, the team's longest run since at least the 2011-12 season.
- The Badgers dished out a season-high 25 assists on 31 baskets in game one, the team's most in a Big Ten Tournament game.
 - The 25 assists is the team's most since having 28 against Savannah State on Dec. 13, 2018.
- Wisconsin scored 37 points off the bench, the most since scoring 39 in the season opener against Arkansas State.
- UW out-rebounded Maryland, 42-25, matching the team's most against a Big Ten opponent this season. The Badgers also had 42 at Nebraska on Feb. 1, 2024.
 - The Badgers are 18-3 when out-rebounding opponents this season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Sophomore **A.J. Storr** registered 16 points (2-4 3FGs) and 4 rebounds.
 - Storr has reached double figures in each of his last 27 games and 30 out of 32 games this season.
- Making his 100th career start, **Chucky Hepburn** matched his career high with 8 assists, adding 10 points in 21 minutes.
 - Hepburn's 8 assists rank as the 3rd-highest Big Ten Tournament mark in school history and 1 shy of the UW record.

■ Hepburn now has 300 career assists, passing Devin Harris (295 from 2002-04) and Bronson Koenig (296 from 2014-17) for 13th place on the school's all-time list.

- Junior **Steven Crowl** made his 100th career start and finished with 17 points in 18 minutes.
- Crowl reached double-digit points for the 5th time in the last 7 games. On the season he has reached that threshold 18 times and the 50 in his career.
- In 3 career Big Ten Tournament games, Crowl is averaging 11.3 ppg, shooting 60.9% (14-23) from the field.
- Freshman **John Blackwell** scored in double figures for the 4th time in the last 5 games, matching his career high with 18 points. He also added 5 rebounds.
- Over the last 3 games, Blackwell is averaging 17.7 ppg, shooting 8-for-12 (66.7%) from 3-point range.
- Blackwell is now shooting 50.0% from 3-point range on the season, going 29-for-58. The school record (min. 60 3FGAs) is 49.0% by Tracy Webster in 1992.
- Sophomore **Connor Essegian** scored 9 points off the UW bench, going 2-for-3 from 3-point range. That his most points since scoring 15 points against Rutgers on Feb. 10. He has 2 total points in the 7 previous games.

SERIES VS. NORTHWESTERN

Friday's game marks the 191st meeting between Wisconsin and Northwestern in a series that dates back to 1910. UW leads the all-time series between the schools, 123-67.

- The Badgers have won 23 of the last 30, including a 71-63 win over the Wildcats earlier this season.
- Wisconsin is 2-0 against Northwestern in the Big Ten Tournament, owning a 51-41 win in 2000 and a 76-48 win in 2017.
- Under head coach Greg Gard, Wisconsin owns a 9-5 record against the Wildcats.
- Northwestern has reached 70 points just once in its last 47 meetings with Wisconsin (UW's 82-76 win at NU in 2022). That stretch of defensive efforts dates back to 1997.
- **Max Klesmit** tallied 24 points in this season's earlier meeting with NU, his second-highest scoring total in a Badger uniform.
- **Tyler Wahl** has scored in double figures in 5 of his last 6 games with NU, averaging 10.8 ppg and 4.5 rpg over in those meetings.
- **Chucky Hepburn** is averaging 11.8 ppg in 3 career meetings with NU. He has 11 assists and just 2 turnovers in those contests.
- Wisconsin has 2 Illinois natives on its roster: sophomores **AJ Storr** (Rockford) and **Chris Hodges** (Schaumburg).

- Wisconsin used a 13-1 run late in the first half to grab a 7-point halftime lead and would never trail again in a 71-63 win at the Kohl Center.
- UW held the Wildcats without a field goal for the final 4:16, outscoring them 10-2 to close the game.
- **Max Klesmit** scored a game-high 24 points (5-7 3FGs) as the Badgers hit 7-of-14 3FGs on the day.
- Three days after Northwestern shot 61.4% at Penn State, the Badgers held the Wildcats to a 42.6% clip from the field. UW shot 50.0%.
- Wisconsin went 20-for-26 (76.9%) from the free throw line and out-rebounded NU, 31-24.
- **A.J. Storr** tallied 14 points, **Tyler Wahl** added 11 points (7-11 FTs). **Chucky Hepburn** finished with 4 points, 5 rebounds, 3 assists (1 TO) and 3 steals. **Steven Crowl** totaled just 6 points, but added 8 rebounds (3 OREB) 3 assists and a block.
