GAME NOTES

WISCONSIN NOTES

- Wisconsin advanced to the Big Ten Quarterfinals with an 87-56 win over Maryland on Thursday.
- The Badgers have qualified for the Big Ten semifinals for the first time since 2019.
- Wisconsin is a combined 26-for-47 (.533) in three-point attempts during the 2024 Big Ten Tournament.
- Wisconsin is 17-0 this season when holding teams to 70 or fewer points.
- The Badgers used a 14-0 run to erase an early nine-point deficit.
- AJ Storr finished with a career-high 30 points.

NORTHWESTERN NOTES

- Northwestern's No. 4 seed was the highest in the program's history.
- Boo Buie's 29 points were the third-most by a Wildcat in a Big Ten Tournament game. He surpassed 20 points for the 17th time this year.
- Buie's seven three-pointers set a program mark and tied for the second-most in a tournament game.
- Brooks Barnhizer matched a career-high with 14 rebounds.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- No. 5 seeds have defeated No. 4 seeds in four-straight Big Ten Tournaments.
- Wisconsin and Northwestern were meeting for the 191st time. UW leads, 124-67 — having won eight of the last 10 games — in a series that dates to 1910.
- Wisconsin is 3-0 versus Northwestern at the Big Ten Tournament.
