BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Three Big Ten teams were included in both the AP and USA Today Coaches Polls this week. Purdue remained at the No. 1 spot in both polls, while Illinois moved up to Nos. 9 and 8, respectively, with Wisconsin sitting at No. 21 in both rankings. Michigan State and Ohio State received votes in both polls, while Northwestern earned mention in the media poll and Nebraska and Indiana in the coaches poll.
- The Big Ten closed its nonconference slate with a combined 117-37 record. The Big 12 (144-34), SEC (132-47), Atlantic 10 (131-60), and ACC (119-46) collected more wins, but the Big Ten's .760-win percentage falls behind only the Big 12 (.809). Among the Big Ten's 117 victories are 9 wins over AP Top 25 opponents.
- Maryland's Jahmir Young was named Big Ten Player of the Week, presented by Air National Guard, for the weeks of Dec. 18-Jan. 1. Young averaged 30.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists, as the Terps scored wins over Nichols and UCLA. The fifth-year guard paired 23 points and 11 rebounds against Nicholls, marking his first double-double of the season. He followed that with a career-high 37 points on 13-19 shooting at UCLA, including a personal 9-0 run to extend Maryland's lead from two points to eight with 1:12 to play. His 37 points are the fourth-most all-time for a Maryland player in a true road game and the most for the Terps since Diamond Stone scored 39 points against Penn State in 2015.
- Indiana's Mackenzie Mgbako was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week for the same period, after averaging 13.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 2.3 assists, as Indiana closed nonconference play with three consecutive wins. Mgbako tallied at least 12 points and five rebounds in all three games, while shooting 40 percent from the field and 90 percent from the free throw line.
- MILESTONE WATCH... Iowa head coach Fran McCaffrey stands just three wins from topping Tom Davis for most victories in program history. Davis collected 271 wins during his 13 seasons in Iowa City. The Hawkeyes' first conference win of the season will also break a record with Davis for most Big Ten wins in program history... Michigan State head coach Tom Izzo enters Sunday's game with 696 wins. Izzo is on the verge of becoming the 10th active coach in Div. I to record 700 career victories... Ohio State head coach Chris Holtmann will carry 249 career wins into Saturday's showdown at Indiana. His 135 victories in Columbus are fifth most in program history.
- Ten Big Ten teams rank in the top-85 in Tuesday's NET rankings, including four in the top 25. Purdue's No. 3 ranking is tops in the league, while Illinois and Wisconsin sit at Nos. 7 and 14, respectively, followed by No. 23 Michigan State, No. 36 Ohio State, No. 58 Nebraska, No. 68 Iowa, No. 80 Northwestern, No. 81 Minnesota, and No. 84 Michigan. The Big 12 and ACC lead the nation with 11 top-85 entrants, while the Big East and SEC have nine each, three more than the Pac 12.
- The Big Ten leads the nation with 1 Quad 1 wins, while its 32 combined Quad 1 and 2 victories through games on Jan. 4 rank second to the SEC's 35. Of the 23 teams across the country to face at least five Quad 1 opponents, five (Iowa, Michigan, Michigan State, Purdue, and Rutgers) reside in the Big Ten. No other conference has more than three. The Big Ten also joins the Pac-12 as the only leagues with four teams to have faced at least eight opponents currently listed in Quads 1 and 2.
- The Big Ten ranks among the nation's best conferences on both sides of the hardwood. Offensively, 10 teams average north of 75.0 points per game, led by Iowa's Big Ten-best 86.7 points, which ranks 11th in the country, six spots north of Purdue (85.4 points). Six teams also rank in the top-50 in the country, led by Purdue's 49.6 field goal percentage, good for 23rd. Minnesota shoots 49.5 percent from the floor, 25th nationally, followed by Indiana (49.2 percent), Michigan State (48.4), Illinois (48.3), and Michigan (48.0) sitting in 31st, 38th, 41st, and 47th, respectively. Much of that offensive efficiency stems from taking care of the ball, as five team list in the top-25 in assists/turnover ratio. The Hawkeyes lead the league and rank fifth in the country at 1.92, while Northwestern's 1.80 ratio is good for ninth. Michigan State (1.71) checks in at 13th, followed by Minnesota (1.60) and Purdue (1.57) in 19th and 24th.
- Defensively, the Big Ten boasts 10 teams that hold their opponents to below 67.0 points per game, led by Rutgers, who surrenders just 62.5 points per outing, good for 15th nationally. Maryland ranks 26th, allowing just 63.6 points, followed by Michigan State (64.3 points) in 36th. Four Big Ten teams also rank in the nation's top 15 in field goal percentage defense. Illinois tops the conference, holding its opponents to 37.8 percent shooting, eighth in the country. Michigan State and Nebraska are tied at 37.9 percent, while Rutgers allows a 38.1 percentage. The Scarlet Knights also rank 10th in the country with 5.8 blocked shots per contest, while Penn State forces a league-best 16.5 turnovers per game, 14th in the country.

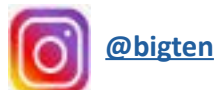

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

- Big Ten players also rank in the top-10 in several individual statistical categories. Purdue's Zach Edey ranks fourth in the country with 23.1 points per game and seventh in double-doubles (8), while his 146 free throw attempts and 112 free throw makes rank first and second in the NCAA. Minnesota's Elijah Hawkins leads the nation with 7.7 assists per contest, while Purdue's Braden Smith (6.7) stands eighth. Defensively, Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi's 3.31 blocked shots per game are good for third. A trio of Big Ten players also rank among the top six in assists/turnover ratio, as Michigan State's Tre Holloman (5.88), Ohio State's Bruce Thornton (4.29), and Iowa's Dasonite Bowen (4.20) sit third, fifth, and sixth, respectively.
- Seven Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-60 in today's Kenpom rankings, including five in the top-30. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by Illinois (#8), Wisconsin (#13), Michigan State (#17), Ohio State (#29), Nebraska (#49), Iowa (#55), and Northwestern (#66). The Big 12 leads the nation with 10 teams in the top-60, two more than the SEC, while the Big Ten, Big East, and ACC have seven each.
- Six Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-50 of the ESPN Basketball Power Index (BPI) listing. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by No. 9 Illinois, No. 18 Wisconsin, No. 19 Michigan State, No. 34 Ohio State, and No. 49 Iowa. All 14 Big Ten teams also rank in the outlet's top-50 Remaining Strength of Schedule listing.
- More than two million fans have watched Big Ten basketball this season, including nearly 1.4 million fans in our 14 home venues. Seven Big Ten teams rank in the top-20 in total attendance, including three in the top five. Nebraska leads the way with 155,176 fans through 11 games, third in the nation. Michigan State (147,970) and Indiana (142,985) rank fourth and fifth, respectively. Illinois (130,748) checks in at seventh, with Wisconsin (119,317), Maryland (111,487), and Purdue (104,132) in 14th, 18th, and 19th, respectively. In total, 13 Big Ten schools rank in the top 50.
- For the sixth consecutive year, each Big Ten Conference member institution will compete in a 20-game conference schedule. The Big Ten Conference season begins Friday, Dec. 1, when Maryland visits Indiana and Northwestern hosts Purdue, the first of 12 conference games played between Dec. 1-10. Following a break in conference play, Big Ten action will resume on Jan. 2. During the conference season, schools will play seven teams twice -- once at home and once on the road and six teams once, with three of those games being at home and the other three away.
- The 27th annual Big Ten Tournament will be played at Target Center in Minneapolis between March 13-17, 2024, marking the first time the tournament has been played in Minneapolis. All 14 teams will advance to the tournament, with two 1st round games slated for Wednesday, March 13th. The top four teams will receive 1st and 2nd round byes and advance to the quarterfinals on Friday, March 15th.
- A Big Ten media panel has chosen 2023 Consensus National Player of the Year Zach Edey as 2023-24 Big Ten Men's Basketball Player of the Year. The league's reigning Player of the Year, Edey became the first Boilermaker since Glenn Robinson in 1994 to win National Player of the Year accolades and the fifth Big Ten Player in the last 14 years to be named National Player of the Year joining Evan Turner (2010), Trey Burke (2013), Frank Kaminsky (2015) and Luka Garza (2021) as National Players of the Year.
- The media panel also selected the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Edey joined Illinois' Terrence Shannon Jr., Maryland's Jahmir Young, and Northwestern's Boo Buie as unanimous selections. Also named to the team were Maryland's Julian Reese, Minnesota's Dawson Garcia, Michigan State's A.J. Hoggard and Tyson Walker, Nebraska's Keisei Tominaga, and Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi. All ten members of the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team received All-Big Ten honors following the 2022-23 campaign. Buie and Shannon joined Edey with First Team accolades, while Omoruyi, Walker, and Young were named to the Second Team. Hoggard earned a spot on the Third Team, with Garcia, Reese, and Tominaga receiving Honorable Mention.

AROUND THE BIG TEN

Illinois: Marcus Domask tallied 32 points, five rebounds, and six assists in the Illini's 96-66 win over Northwestern on Tuesday. He is the fourth Big Ten player to record 30 points this season and the first Illini to post a 30/5/5 game since Ayo Dosunmu on Dec. 30, 2020 at Penn State.

Indiana: After missing seven games due to injury, sixth-year guard Xavier Johnson returned to the line-up against Nebraska on Wednesday. Johnson, who averages 9.0 points, 2.1 rebounds, and 2.4 assists per game, posted three assists, two rebounds and one steal in 15 minutes in the loss.

Iowa: The Hawkeyes are one the nation's top offensive teams, averaging 86.7 points per game on the season, including 97.9 points inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa leads the Big Ten and ranks 11th nationally. The team has scored at least 84 points nine times and surpassed the century mark four times.

Maryland: Fifth-year guard Jahmir Young is the only active player in the nation with at least 2,000 points, 600 rebounds, and 400 assists, as he has 2,232 points, 674 rebounds and 415 assists. His 48 career 20-plus point games are also the most among active Big Ten players.

Michigan: The Wolverines are averaging 82.3 points - fourth in the Big Ten (43rd nationally). U-M has four games of 90-plus points and surpassed 100 points once. Michigan's 82.3 per game average is the best for the Maize and Blue in 31 years. The last time U-M closed a season averaging above 80 points was during the 1992-93 (81.94) season -- Juwan Howard and the Fab Five's freshman season.

Michigan State: Michigan State scored 92 points, its second-most points this season. It was the first time MSU scored at least 90 points in regulation against a Big Ten team since a 91-76 win over Nebraska on March 5, 2019. The 31-point margin of victory was also the Spartans' first win by at least 30 points over a Big Ten opponent since an 87-57 win at Minnesota on Feb. 13, 2018.

Minnesota: Junior guard Elijah Hawkins leads the nation with 108 total assists and 7.7 assists per game. The xxx transfer has handed out at least nine assists in six of his last games, including a program-record 17 dimes against IUPUI. He has also committed just 16 turnovers during the eight-game stretch. As a team, the Gophers rank fifth in the country with 19.9 assists per game while its 1.60 assist/turnover ratio ranks 19th.

Nebraska: The Huskers' 86-70 win over Indiana snapped a seven-game losing streak to the Hoosiers dating back to 1999. The 16-point margin was Nebraska's largest against the Hoosiers since its first win in the series in 1920. With

the win, the Huskers improved to 12-2 on the season, and matched the program's best 14-game mark since the 1990-91 team opened with a 13-1 mark.

Northwestern: Junior Brooks Barnhizer is averaging 13.3 points per game, a team-best 7.8 rebounds per game (7th in the B1G) and 2.1 steals per game, which leads the team and ranks second in the B1G in his first season starting for the Wildcats. He is the only high-major player in the country posting at least 13.0 points, 7.0 rebound and 2.0 steals. Since 1992-93 only Purdue's Glenn Robinson (1992-93) and Iowa's Ryan Bowen (1997-98) have posted those numbers for an entire season.

Ohio State: Ohio State is off to its best start in five seasons at 12-2. A win Saturday would be the best start for the Buckeyes under head coach Chris Holtmann and the best since the team won its first 15 games of the 2013-14 season. A victory would also be the 250th in Coach Holtmann's career.

Penn State: The Nittany Lions have forced their opponents into 16.5 turnovers per game, a mark that leads the Big Ten and ranks 14th in the nation. Guard Ace Baldwin Jr. has been a big part of the defensive effort, as the senior paces the Big Ten and ranks 16th in the country with 2.5 steals per game. Penn State also ranks 11th in the nation with a +4.8 turnovers margin and scores an average of 17.4 points off its opponent's miscues.

Purdue: A win over Illinois would give Purdue a 43-7 mark over its last 50 games, the best 50-game stretch in school history (tied with 2009-10 and 2010-11 seasons). Both Braden Smith and Fletcher Loyer will be making their 50th career start on Friday, coinciding with the run.

Rutgers: After averaging just 7.1 points as a freshman, guard Derek Simpson is averaging 10.0 points per game this year, including 13.3 points in the last four games, with seven games in double figures. In Wednesday's 76-72 loss at Ohio State, Simpson matched a career-high with 23 points with a career-best nine field goals made. The 23 points mark his highest offensive output against a Big Ten opponent.

Wisconsin: The Badgers lead the Big Ten and rank 31st in the country with a 76.0 percent (212-279) free throw percentage, a success rate that would rank fifth in program history. The Badgers averages 21.5 free throw attempts per game. Compared to last season, the Badgers are attempting 7.2 more FTs per game this season (14.3 FTAs per game in 2022-23). Wisconsin has also made nearly as many free throws (212) as its opponents have attempted (223).

TIE BREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING

1. Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
2. A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runner-up the No. 2 seed, etc.).
3. Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
4. In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

Ties Involving Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
2. Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Ties Involving more than Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
 - a. When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. If winning percentage among the group for any tied teams is equal, move to step b with those specific tied teams only (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step b and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).

Note: Teams can be separated from the top, middle or bottom.
 - b. If a team or teams are separated from the group based on step a, seeding for remaining teams among the group is not determined by head-to-head record vs. the remaining teams, but rather by taking all remaining teams to next tiebreaker.
2. If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Postseason Awards

All-Big Ten awards, as determined by the coaches and media, will be announced on March 12, 2024. Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
