- After an exciting weekend, the Big Ten Conference is ready for another week of action, which
 features four contests on national platforms. Minnesota and Wisconsin kick things off on
 Tuesday night with a 9 p.m. ET outing on the Big Ten Network (and the FOX Sports App). No. 12
 Ohio State heads to Illinois on Thursday for a 7 p.m. ET tip on Peacock. Penn State and
 Northwestern will be on BTN at 8 p.m. ET Thursday. No. 5 lowa and Nebraska close out the
 television slate on Saturday at 2 p.m. ET on BTN. This week's remaining games will be streamed
 live on B1G+ (visit bigtenplus.com for more information).
- No. 18/13 Ohio State and No. 2 Iowa put on a thriller for NBC's first-ever Big Ten women's basketball game broadcast on Sunday. The Buckeyes upset the Hawkeyes in overtime, 100-92, in front of a program-record 18,660 fans inside the Schottenstein Center, the largest indoor regular season crowd for a women's basketball game this season. Ohio State earned its third win over a ranked opponent and handed lowa its first Big Ten loss of the season.
- Sunday's Ohio State-Iowa matchup on NBC and Peacock was the most-watched regular season women's college basketball game on any network since 2010. Viewership peaked at 3.9 million viewers and the broadcast averaged 1.93 million viewers.
- Cotie McMahon claimed the first Big Ten Player of the Week award of her career on Monday and was voted Jersey Mike's Naismith Women's College Player of the Week. McMahon was also chosen as one of five Ann Meyers Drysdale National Players of the Week by the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) and named Associated Press (AP) National Player of the Week on Tuesday. She led Ohio State to wins over NR/RV Maryland and No. 2 lowa behind 23.5 points, 10.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.5 blocks. The sophomore scored a career-high 33 points and added a season-high 12 rebounds for her first double-double of the season in an overtime upset of lowa. She chipped in 14 points, nine rebounds and three assists against the Terrapins.
- The Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) announced the Top 10 candidates for the 2024 Nancy Lieberman Award and Ann Meyers Drysdale Award. The Nancy Lieberman Award recognizes the top point guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball and features three Big Ten student-athletes on its top 10 list Iowa's Caitlin Clark, Maryland's Shyanne Sellers and Ohio State's Jacy Sheldon. The Ann Meyers Drysdale Award honors the top shooting guard, with Indiana's Sara Scalia representing the Big Ten as a top 10 candidate.
- With 45 points against Ohio State, Cailtin Clark is just 52 points shy of overtaking Kelsey Mitchell for the No. 1 spot on the Big Ten Conference's all-time scorers list.
- Illinois went a perfect 16-for-16 at the charity stripe against Maryland, which set a new program
 record for most makes while shooting 100% from the free throw line. The Fighting Illini are just
 the 14th team in Big Ten Conference history to have a perfect free-throw percentage in a league
 matchup (min. 16 attempts).
- Minnesota bested Michigan State, 69-50, to hold the Spartans to their lowest point total of the season and fewest against the Gophers since Feb. 2, 2009.
- lowa has either assisted in selling out or broken an attendance record in 29-of-32 venues this season.
- Indiana shot 65.2 percent from the three-point line, the fifth-best clip in a single game in school history, and connected on 15 triples, the second-most in a single game in program history, against Purdue.
- The Big Ten leads all Division I conferences with a remarkable eight schools among the top 40 in the latest NET rankings (including four in the top 20, second behind the Pac-12) No. 6 Iowa,

No. 11 Indiana, No. 13 Ohio State, No. 19 Michigan State, No. 27 Maryland, No. 28 Penn State, No. 29 Nebraska and No. 31 Minnesota. The NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) is the primary sorting tool used by the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee for determining NCAA Tournament teams.

- The Big Ten has three teams making an appearance in this week's Associated Press (AP) Top 25 poll. In the latest media survey, Iowa falls to No. 5 while Ohio State jumps six spots to No. 12 and Indiana gains two places to come in at No. 14.
- The Big Ten has four programs in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today Top 25 poll. Iowa is tied for fifth while Ohio State and Indiana both move up three spots to rank 12th and 13th, respectively. Michigan State is receiving votes.
- Offensive production continues to be the story for the Big Ten Conference as 10 different schools (Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Maryland, Michigan, Michigan State, Minnesota, Nebraska, Ohio State and Penn State) have scored 100 points in at least one game this season. Five Big Ten teams are averaging more than 80 points per game to ensure multiple national top 20 scoring offenses reside in the Big Ten, led by Iowa (3rd 90.9), Penn State (5th 86.9), Michigan State (8th 86.4), Ohio State (15th 82.6) and Maryland (18th 80.9).
- The Big Ten currently leads all Division I conferences in scoring (76.0 ppg), three-point percentage (.351), free throw percentage (.740), field goal percentage (.453) and assists (16.4 apg).
- With a 1.76 assist/turnover ratio, Michigan State sits at No. 1 in the NCAA's national statistical rankings. lowa (10th – 1.45) and Indiana (13th –1.43) are also included in the top 15. Individually, Chloe Moore-McNeil (IND) has a 2.80 ratio, which places her 15th, and DeeDee Hagemann (MSU) comes in 17th at 2.75.
- The Big Ten features some of the best shooting teams in the country with four programs among the top 15, including three in the top 10, in field goal percentage. Indiana ranks third at 51.5 percent, followed by Penn State (5th .507), lowa (7th .505) and Michigan State (15th .476). Penn State and Indiana are also efficient from beyond the arc. The Nittany Lions rank second in the nation with a 40.6 three-point percentage while the Hoosiers check in third at 40.3 percent.
- Big Ten teams have been passing the rock quite well this season as five programs rank in the top 20 in the country in assists, led by lowa (3rd 20.5), Michigan State (11th 19.5), Indiana (15th 18.9), Penn State (17th 18.6) and Northwestern (19th 18.5). A trio of Big Ten players rank among the top 25 nationally in assists Iowa's Caitlin Clark (2nd 7.7 apg), Northwestern's Caroline Lau (17th 6.0 apg) and Purdue's Jeanae Terry (22nd 5.7 apg).
- Individually, Caitlin Clark (IOWA) leads the country in points (634), points per game (31.7) and assists (154). Serah Williams (WIS) is averaging 3.20 blocks per game, which is good enough for fifth. Mackenzie Holmes (IND) is shooting 67.6 percent from the floor to rank third in field goal percentage, followed by Kendall Bostic (ILL) with a 63.8 clip to stand eighth and Hannah Stuelke (IOWA) at 61.8 percent

for 12th. Mara Braun (MINN) has the second-best free throw percentage (94.6) in the nation.

- The Big Ten has consistently ranked among the top three conferences in women's basketball attendance for the past three decades and that trend has continued into the 2023-24 season. Currently, 12 Big Ten schools rank among the top 50 in the nation in average attendance, including six in the top 15, with both figures leading all Division I conferences. Iowa is second nationally in attendance (14,998 fans per game), followed by Indiana (6th 8,828), Ohio State (10th 6,849), Maryland (11th 6,685) Purdue (12th 6,528) and Nebraska (15th 5,526).
- The Big Ten closed its non-conference slate with a combined 114-41 (.735) record. Among the 114 victories, five were over AP Top 25 opponents.
- The 2023-24 schedule marks the most coverage on nationally distributed platforms in Big Ten women's basketball history. Six Big Ten regular-season games will be televised on a broadcast platform, the most in conference history. NBC will televise its first-ever Big Ten women's basketball game on Jan. 21 when lowa visits Ohio State at 12 p.m. ET. Peacock carried its first Big Ten women's basketball broadcast on Jan. 2, a thriller between Michigan State and Iowa.
- No. 16/13 Ohio State grabbed a landmark non-conference 78-58 win at No. 20/22 Tennessee. It was just the second time in Tennessee's history that the Lady Vols have lost in Thompson-Boling Arena by at least 20 points. Ohio State is only the second Big Ten Conference program to defeat Tennessee in Knoxville, joining Indiana. It was the first time in conference history that the Big Ten has posted multiple wins over Tennessee in back-to-back years Ohio State and Indiana both claimed victories over the Lady Vols during the 2022-23 season and has won five of its last six matchups with Tennessee.
- No. 21/19 Indiana secured an impressive non-conference 71-57 victory over No. 19/21 Tennessee on Nov. 23. It was the second time in as many years that the Hoosiers have bested the Lady Vols and the largest margin of victory (14) in the four-game all-time series. Last year's Hoosier win was the first time a Big Ten Conference school defeated Tennessee in Thompson-Boling Arena. The matchup scored 1,118,000 viewers to rank as FOX's most-watched women's college basketball game ever.

AROUND THE LEAGUE

- Ohio State handed Maryland its first home loss of the season with an 84-76 victory. It was the Buckeyes' first win in College Park since Jan. 2, 2016.
- Mackenzie Holmes recorded 32 points on 15-of-17 shooting from the field against Minnesota. Her 15 made field goals tied for third all-time in a single game at Indiana.
- Penn State earned its 1,000th all-time victory with a 94-80 win over Rutgers, one of only 29 programs to achieve the feat.
- Shyanne Sellers became the 38th player in Maryland history to reach

- 1,000 career points after tallying 12 against Purdue.
- Purdue hosted lowa in front of 14,876 fans for its fourth sellout in program history and second in as many seasons, following a record attendance against Indiana last year.
- Rutgers' matchup with lowa produced a sellout crowd at Jersey Mike's Arena, the first sellout since 2006 and first under head coach Coquese Washington.
- In its win over Michigan, Indiana became the first team since Jan. 8, 1999 to start a game 15-for-15, according to StatsPass. The feat was last achieved when Portland went 15-of-15 in the first half against Pepperdine.
- Penn State head coach Carolyn Kieger picked up her 150th career win as her squad earned its largest Big Ten victory since the 2012-2013 season by defeating Northwestern, 95-55.
- lowa head coach Lisa Bluder recorded her 250th career Big Ten regular season victory as the Hawkeyes bested Michigan State, 76-73.
- Michigan earned its first win over a Top 25 opponent this season when it handed No. 17/13 Ohio State its first conference loss, 69-60, on Saturday in front of a season-high 8,078 fans inside the Crisler Center. It was the first victory for the Wolverines over the Buckeyes since Jan. 27, 2022.
- Caitlin Clark handed out 10 assists against Minnesota to become the Big Ten's and lowa's all-time assist leader, eclipsing Sam Prahalis (OSU, 2009-12) for the top spot in the conference record book. Clark is the first Division I player to record 3,300+ points, 900+ assists and 800+ rebounds in a career and the all-time leading scorer in the state of lowa in Division I college basketball history.
- Nebraska earned its first-ever home victory over Maryland, 87-81, on Sunday. It was just the second win for the Huskers in the 18-game alltime series with the Terrapins.
- 11,600 fans were on hand to watch Indiana defeat Illinois, 77-71, the largest crowd this season for the Hoosiers and fifth-highest attended game in school history.
- Purdue notched its largest Big Ten win since the 2016-17 season with an 89-50 triumph over Wisconsin. The Boilermakers extended their home winning streak to nine games, the longest stretch for the program since 12 straight between the 2005-06 and 2006-07 campaigns.
- With her 13th career triple-double, Caitlin Clark joined Sabrina Ionescu as the only players in college women's basketball history to record a triple-double in four consecutive seasons. She is the all-time leader in 30+ point performances in men's and women's college basketball over the last 25 seasons.
- Shay Ciezki had the hot hand as she scored a career-high 40 points, including eight three-pointers, in Penn State's win over Central Connecticut State. Ciezki's mark tied for the third-most points in a single game and was just the fourth 40-point performance in the Nittany Lions' record book. As a team, Penn State set the program record for made three-pointers in a single game with 15.
- Michigan State bested Coastal Carolina, 105-66, its fourth time topping the 100-point mark this season for the most in program history. With the victory, the Spartans claimed the Cherokee Invitational Championship title, their first tournament win since 2017.
- Sara Scalia connected on eight three-pointers against Bowling Green, which tied for second all-time in a single game in Indiana history. She is the first Hoosier to have such a performance from beyond the arc since Kris McGrade made eight triples in 1993 against Indiana State.
- Michigan State head coach Robyn Fralick earned her 200th career win as her team topped Central Michigan.
- Indiana shot a blistering 71.7 percent from the floor against Evansville, the highest single-game field goal percentage in a NCAA Division I women's college basketball game this season. It marked the program's highest single-game field goal percentage and the fourth-best clip in Big Ten history.
- Penn State defeated St. Francis (Pa.), 119-49, for the second-highest scoring output in program history and tied for the fourth-most points scored in a game in Big Ten history. The Nittany Lions tallied 67 points in the first half, which set a program best and tied for sixth in the Big Ten record books. PSU's 39 points in the second quarter tied for fourth all-time in the conference standings.
- Nebraska's Alexis Markowski chipped in 21 points against Southern to join the 1,000-point club, the 38th Husker to achieve the milestone.
- Caitlin Clark scored 35 points in Iowa's 67-58 win over in-state rival Iowa State, registering her 3,000th career point and becoming the first Hawkeye to achieve the feat.
- The Iowa-Iowa State rivalry game posted 588,000 viewers, up 227%

- versus last December's Wednesday game average (180,000).
- C. Vivian Stringer, former Rutgers University head coach, was named a Naismith Award honoree for her lifetime contribution to the game of basketball, the Atlanta Tipoff Club (ATOC) announced Dec. 7. Stringer was selected by the ATOC's Board of Directors and will be honored during the 2024 college basketball season. The second full-time head coach in Rutgers women's basketball history, Stringer had served at the helm of the Scarlet Knights from 1995 to 2022, the longest tenured coach at the time of her retirement. Stringer compiled a 1,055-426 (.712) record in 50 seasons as a head coach, becoming one of five NCAA Division I coaches (and the only Black coach) to amass 1,000 victories. She also is the only coach to lead three different schools (Cheyney, Iowa and Rutgers) to NCAA Final Four appearances (a combined four trips), including berths in the 1982 and 2007 national championship game. Stringer spent her final 27 seasons at Rutgers, winning 535 games with the Scarlet Knights. She has been inducted into the New Jersey Hall of Fame (2020), Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame (2009) and Women's Basketball Hall of Fame (2001).
- Kassondra Brown recorded her 1,000th career point in Rutgers' 98-67 victory over La Salle. She is the 39th Scarlet Knight in program history to reach the milestone.
- Jaz Shelley became the first Nebraska player in program history to post a pair of triple-doubles in her career with 19 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists in the Huskers' largest victory margin over a Division I team in school history with a 108-35 win over UNC Wilmington.
- lowa's Kate Martin became the first Hawkeye to ever amass 900+ points, 500+ rebounds, 400+ assists, 120+ steals and 60+ blocks in a career. Indiana head coach Teri Moren secured her 100th Big Ten victory as her team defeated Rutgers.
- Maryland won its 600th all-time home game (306 games at XFINITY Center, 294 at Cole Field House) against Northwestern.
- Purdue's Jeanae Terry recorded her 200th steal against Minnesota, the only active player in the nation with at least 600 assists, 800 rebounds and 200 steals.
- The matchup between Iowa and Wisconsin on Dec. 10 marked the first sellout for Wisconsin's program in 21 years with 14,252 fans in attendance, which ranks seventh all-time in the Kohl Center. Michigan tallied its sixth-best margin of victory in a Big Ten game in program history with a 36-point win over Illinois, 84-48. The Wolverines connected on 13 three-pointers, just one shy of a program record.
- Rebeka Mikulášiková became the 37th player in Ohio State history to score 1,000 career points after finishing with a season-high 18 points at Tennessee.
- Mara Braun is the third player in Minnesota history to play 50 minutes in a game and the first to commit zero turnovers while doing so in a 94-88 comeback win over Drake. Braun had made 37 consecutive free throws, a program record, to tie for the fifth-longest streak in Big Ten history.
- Nebraska dropped 58 second-half points on Georgia Tech, which tied for the 10th most in a second half in school history.
- College basketball on FS1 was led by Iowa topping Bowling Green on Saturday, Dec. 2 in a game that drew 221,000 viewers, up 27% compared to last year's Big Ten women's basketball weekend average on the network.
- Maryland's Brinae Alexander knocked down a school-record 11 consecutive field goals on her way to a career-high 29 points against Niagara. Maryland's 114-44 win was the largest margin of victory (70) in four years.
- Michigan connected on 14 three-pointers during its 103-59 win over SIUE, tying its school record. Illinois outrebounded Central Connecticut State, 48-21, in an 89-50 victory. The +27 rebounding margin is the highest since the 2018 season. Ohio State held Cornell to just two points in the second quarter of its matchup, the lowest total of a Buckeye opponent in the second quarter in program history.
- Purdue's 36-point margin of victory over Southern Indiana was the second largest of head coach Katie Geralds' tenure. Mackenzie Holmes became the second player in Indiana history to score 2,000 career points after dropping 20 against Princeton on Nov. 25.
- Head coach Lisa Bluder recorded her 500th win at the helm for Iowa when the Hawkeyes handled Florida Gulf Coast, 100-62, on Nov. 25. She currently ranks third in career wins among active Division I women's college basketball coaches.
- lowa's game against FGCU was a record-setting outing. With 20 three-pointers, the Hawkeyes set the second-best mark in Big Ten history and broke the school record for most made three-pointers in one game. The matchup at Hertz Arena in Estero, Fla. drew 4,287 fans, an all-time attendance record for the Gulf Coast Showcase. Gabbie Marshall became the first lowa women's basketball player to record 200 three-pointers and 200 steals in a career on Nov. 24 versus Purdue Fort

- lowa's Caitlin Clark scored 35 points against Drake on Nov. 19 for her 39th career game with 30-plus points, surpassing Kelsey Plum to become the NCAA leader.
- It was a record-setting night when Michigan State defeated Detroit Mercy, 105-44. The Spartans shot 70.9 percent from the field (39-for-55) to break the school record for field goal percentage in a game, dating back to 1986 against Bowling Green. It is the fifth-best single-game field goal percentage in Big Ten Conference history. The squad also tied the program record for assists with 34 helpers.
- The Thursday, Nov. 16 Kansas State at Iowa game tallied 415,000 viewers, up 267% from last November's lone Wednesday Big Ten women's basketball game. The game ranks as the second most watched women's college basketball game ever on FS1.
- Illinois recorded its fourth-highest attendance in program history as 11,563 fans packed the State Farm Center. The Fighting Illini took down Saint Peter's, 103-33, for the third-largest margin of victory (70) in program history.
- Makenna Marisa had a 34-point outing versus Kansas to tie for second all-time in career 30-point games (8) at Penn State.
- Caitlin Clark became the Hawkeyes' all-time leading scorer on Nov. 12, passing Megan Gustafson's previous record of 2,804 points.
- Mara Braun became the third fastest player in Minnesota history to reach 500 career points (31 games) when she had 25 against Chicago State.
- lowa's game against FGCU was a record-setting outing. With 20 three-pointers, the Hawkeyes set the second-best mark in Big Ten history and broke the school record for most made three-pointers in one game. The matchup at Hertz Arena in Estero, Fla. drew 4,287 fans, an all-time attendance record for the Gulf Coast Showcase. Gabbie Marshall became the first Iowa women's basketball player to record 200 three-pointers and 200 steals in a career on Nov. 24 versus Purdue Fort Wayne.
- Iowa's Caitlin Clark scored 35 points against Drake on Nov. 19 for her 39th career game with 30-plus points, surpassing Kelsey Plum to become the NCAA leader.
- It was a record-setting night when Michigan State defeated Detroit Mercy, 105-44. The Spartans shot 70.9 percent from the field (39-for-55) to break the school record for field goal percentage in a game, dating back to 1986 against Bowling Green. It is the fifth-best single-game field goal percentage in Big Ten Conference history. The squad also tied the program record for assists with 34 helpers.
- The Thursday, Nov. 16 Kansas State at Iowa game tallied 415,000 viewers, up 267% from last November's lone Wednesday Big Ten women's basketball game. The game ranks as the second most watched women's college basketball game ever on FS1.
- Illinois recorded its fourth-highest attendance in program history as 11,563 fans packed the State Farm Center. The Fighting Illini took down Saint Peter's, 103-33, for the third-largest margin of victory (70) in program history.
- Makenna Marisa had a 34-point outing versus Kansas to tie for second all-time in career 30-point games (8) at Penn State.
- Caitlin Clark became the Hawkeyes' all-time leading scorer on Nov. 12, passing Megan Gustafson's previous record of 2,804 points.
- Mara Braun became the third fastest player in Minnesota history to reach 500 career points (31 games) when she had 25 against Chicago State.
- ESPN2 drew 548,000 viewers during its Nov. 9 broadcast of No. 3/3 Iowa defeating No. 8/5 Virginia Tech, a 208% increase compared to last November's weekday women's college basketball average.
- Indiana head coach Teri Moren secured her 400th career win in the 96-43 season-opening triumph over Eastern Illinois on Nov. 9. The Hoosiers have won 11 straight season openers, including all 10 under Moren.
- Michigan State head coach Robyn Fralick and Minnesota head coach Dawn Plitzuweit both started their Big Ten tenures with a victory. Fralick coached the Spartans to an 87-62 win against Oakland, the most points scored in a MSU head coach's first game. Plitzuweit led the Golden Gophers past LIU, 92-57. The 35-point margin of victory is the most in a coaching debut at Minnesota.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2023 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 51 honorees during the 2022-23 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 25 of the last 29 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 114 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 675,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's new media agreements with BTN, CBS, FOX and NBC/Peacock, more than 2,300 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis. The Big Ten is the only conference to distribute games on three over-the-air broadcast networks.

BTN reaches more than 50 million homes and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams more than 1,700 additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
