BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Seven Big Ten volleyball programs were among this week's AVCA/TARAFLEX Top 25, announced on Monday: #1 Nebraska, #6 Wisconsin, #12 Penn State, #13 Minnesota, #14 Purdue, #16 USC and #24 UCLA. Oregon and Indiana received votes.
- Seven Big Ten programs remain undefeated through the first two weeks of play. The Big Ten leads all Division I conferences with seven, followed by the ACC (6), Big 12 (5), SEC (2) and Big East (2). Thirty-three teams boast an unblemished record.
- Indiana head coach Steve Aird became the fourth coach in program history to record 100 wins. Aird and the Hoosiers are 5-0 for the first time in his tenure and the first time since 2017. The Hoosiers have won 15-straight sets after dropping the first two games of the season. It's the longest streak by the program since winning 18 consecutive sets during the 2010 campaign.
- Iowa is off to its best start (6-0) since 2009. A win over SEMO on Thursday will mark the best start in school history. Through two weekends, setter Claire Ammeraal has been the tournament MVP at the Rebel Challenge and Kwik Star Klassic. Ammeraal has a triple-double, two double-doubles, leads the team in assists (174) and has 56 digs, 36 kills and 13 blocks.
- Maryland's Duru Gökçen was named UMBC Tournament MVP, totaling 20 kills and 21 blocks across the Terps' 3-0 weekend.
- Penn State's match on Sept. 1 vs. TCU totaled 731,000 viewers on FOX. The Nittany Lions hosted Kentucky on Friday for a top 5 matchup that amassed 554,000 viewers, also on FOX.
- Purdue's Ryan McAleer tallied 30 digs in a 3-2 victory over No. 15 Kansas. It was the most digs by a Boilermaker since 2021, and she became the 12th Boilermaker to tally 30 digs in a single match.
- USC won the 2025 Trojan Invitational to move to 5-0 to start the season for the first time under head coach Brad Keller and the Women of Troy are off to their best start since 2015. The Trojans beat No. 13 Creighton (3-0), UC Santa Barbara (3-2) and San Diego (3-2), and Abigail Mullen was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player, while teammates Reese Messer and London Wijay were named to the All-Tournament Team.
- Six Big Ten teams are among the top 25 nationally in hitting percentage. Indiana is third nationally with a .347 hitting percentage, followed by Minnesota (8th - .320), Michigan (9th - .319), Rutgers (12th - .307), Nebraska (15th - .302) and Wisconsin (21st - .296).
- Michigan State leads the nation in opponent hitting percentage, holding opponents to just a .076 hitting percentage through five matches. The Spartans and first-year head coach Kristen Kelsay are enjoying a 5-0 start to the 2025 season for the first time since 2022.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 18 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 105 universities in the nation according to the 2025 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including 11 in the top 40.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 2,000 Academic All-Americans, including 94 honorees during the 2024-25 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct more than \$17 billion in funded research.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 25 of the last 30 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span. The Big Ten set a record in 2024-25, winning 14 national championships.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 128 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

Big Ten institutions support more than 14,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

Nearly 2,000 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 600 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2024 Summer Olympics in Paris, France, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 98 total medals and 27 gold medals during the 17-day competition, surpassing the previous mark of 51 medals at the 2020 Summer Games in Tokyo, Japan. All 18 Big Ten member schools were represented at the 2024 Summer Games, competing for 64 nations in 17 sports.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 9.4 million alumni and nearly 823,000 students.

Big Ten men's and women's basketball combined for 4.9 million fans in their home arenas throughout the 2024-25 season and paced the nation in total attendance. All seven of the Big Ten ice hockey teams also ranked in the top 20 nationally in average attendance.

In 2024-25, the four most viewed college football games of the season featured Big Ten teams, as did seven of the top 10, and 12 of the top 20. Three broadcast television partners – CBS, FOX and NBC – had at least one Big Ten matchup with more than 9.5 million viewers. Twenty-one Big Ten football games had an audience of more than five million viewers.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, NBC, Peacock, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is carried by all major video distributors across the United States and Canada and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+, the network's subscription streaming services, provides access to more than 2,700 additional events each season.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Twenty years after adding instant replay in 2004, announced a state-of-the-art replay center, featuring 18 dedicated replay bays and six dedicated medical observation stations.

Championed new legislation for football permitting coach-to-player helmet communication and the use of sideline video by student-athletes, and coaches, both of which were introduced in the fall of 2024.

COMMUNITY & IMPACT

The Big Ten Conference is dedicated to making a lasting impact on the communities where its major events are held. In recent years, the conference has hosted sports clinics, renovated recreation centers and given elementary-aged children the chance to experience major Big Ten events.

Around the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference focuses on creating meaningful improvements, aiming to leave each location better than it was found.

Moving forward, the Big Ten will continue to collaborate with the College Football Playoff Foundation, local sports organizations and school district foundations to enhance spaces for teachers and children and provide educational opportunities for youth.
