BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- After a four-day hiatus for the Christmas holiday, the Big Ten teams resume their schedules tonight, as Maryland hosting Coppin State. Nine teams will see action on Dec. 29, with Dec. 30 marking the final day of nonconference contests. There will be no games on Dec. 31-Jan. 1, with conference play set to resume on Tuesday, Jan. 2.
- Three Big Ten teams were included in both the AP and USA Today Coaches Polls this week. Purdue remained at the No. 1 spot in both polls, while Illinois moved up to No. 11 and 9, respectively, with Wisconsin sitting at No. 23 in both rankings. Michigan State and Ohio State received votes in both polls, while Northwestern earned mention in the media poll and Nebraska and Indiana in the coaches poll.
- With 12 conference games in the books, the Big Ten has returned to nonconference action through the end of the 2023 calendar year. Four teams, Indiana, Northwestern, Illinois, and Wisconsin are a combined 5-0 on the young season, while Iowa and Michigan State both stand at 0-2. The league's final nonconference contests are scheduled for Saturday, Dec. 30, with a return to Big Ten action slated for Tuesday, Jan. 2.
- The Big Ten improved to 105-36 in nonconference action after the short week. B1G teams have gone a combined 105-36 in non-conference action this season. Their 105 wins ranked 5th most among all conferences behind the Big 12 (130-33), SEC (119-47), Atlantic 10 (118-59), and ACC (115-45). However, their .745-win percentage lists behind only the Big 12 (.798). Among the B1G's 105 victories are 9 wins over AP Top 25 opponents, which was tied for the most of any conference in the nation.
- In last week's 69-60 win at UCLA, Maryland's Jahmir Young netted a career-best 37 points on 13-of-17 from the floor, including 4-of-6 from 3-point range, along with 7-of-9 at the free-throw line, adding seven rebounds, three assists and a steal in 37 minutes. He is one of just 10 players to score at least 37 points in a game this season. Young's 37 points were the third most by a Terrapin in any game this century and the second highest total by an opponent at Pauley Pavilion since 1993.
- MILESTONE WATCH... Maryland head coach Kevin Willard became the fifth active coach in the Big Ten to reach the 300-win plateau with last week's victory at UCLA. Willard joins his father, Ralph, who amassed 336 wins as a coach at Western Kentucky, Pitt, and Holy Cross. Willard joined Virginia's Tony Bennett as the only active coaches with 300 wins whose fathers also have 300 victories... Iowa head coach Fran McCaffrey stands just four wins from topping Tom Davis for most victories in program history. Davis collected 271 wins during his 13 seasons in Iowa City. The Hawkeyes' first conference win of the season will also break a record with Davis for most Big Ten wins in program history... Michigan State head coach Steve Izzo enters Saturday's game against Indiana State with 695 wins. Izzo is on the verge of becoming the 10th active coach in Div. I to record 700 career victories.
- Nine Big Ten teams rank in the top-75 in Thursday's NET rankings. Purdue's No. 4 ranking is tops in the league, while Illinois and Wisconsin sit at Nos. 10 and 14, respectively, followed by No. 28 Ohio State, No. 36 Michigan State, No. 57 Nebraska, No. 63 Iowa, No. 68 Michigan, and No. 71 Northwestern. The Big 12 boasts a nation-leading 10 top-75 entrants, while the ACC, Big Ten, and SEC have nine each, one more than the Big East.
- The Big Ten leads the nation with 17 Quad 1 wins and is tied for second with 27 Quad 1 and 2 wins through games on Dec. 27. Purdue, Wisconsin, Michigan, and Michigan State are four of just 16 to have faced at least five Quad 1 opponents, while the Boilermakers, Badgers, and Spartans are three of 12 in the country to play at least seven teams in Quads 1 and 2. Only the Big Ten, SEC and SWAC have multiple teams to face at least five quad 1 opponents.
- The Big Ten boasts some of the top defensive teams in the country. Four teams also list in the top 20 in field goal defense, led by Illinois, who holds opponents to .374 shooting, good for eighth in the nation. Michigan State (.379) ranks 14th, followed by Rutgers (.380) in 16th, and Nebraska (.379) in 18th. Five clubs also rank in the top 40 in scoring defense, led by Rutgers, who allows 61.7 points per game, 13th in the country. Northwestern (63.1) ranks 23rd, followed by Michigan State (63.7), Ohio State (64.1), and Maryland (64.2) in 33rd, 36th, and 38th, respectively. In total, nine teams give up 67.0 or fewer points per game.
- Offensively, the Big Ten also ranks among the best in the nation. The conference ranks fourth in points per game (77.0) and field goal percentage (.462), while its 2,499 assists rank third. Three Big Ten teams, Purdue (87.3 ppg), Iowa (86.6), and Michigan (83.8) rank 10th, 12th, and 31st in scoring offense, while Purdue (.497), Minnesota (.495), and Michigan (.492) sit in 17th, 22nd, and 27th, respectively, in field goal percentage.

BIG LIFE. BIG STAGE. BIG TEN.

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

- Big Ten players also rank in the top-10 in several individual statistical categories. Purdue's Zach Edey ranks third in the country with 24.0 points, while Illinois' Terrence Shannon Jr.'s 21.7 points are good for 10th. Edey also ranks 10th in rebounds (10.4) and seventh in double-doubles (7). Minnesota's Elijah Hawkins (7.6) and Purdue's Braden Smith (6.7) stand second and 10th in assists per game. Defensively, Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi's 3.45 blocked shots per game are good for second, while Penn State's Ace Baldwin Jr.'s 2.67 steals per game are good for 10th.
- Nine Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-60 in the Kenpom rankings. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by Illinois (#9), Wisconsin (#14), Michigan State (#21), Ohio State (#27), Michigan (#47), Nebraska (#54), Northwestern (#56), and Iowa (#57). The conference's nine teams are two behind the Big 12 for the most teams in the top 60. The ACC, Big East, and SEC have seven entrants each.
- Six Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-50 of the ESPN Basketball Power Index (BPI) listing. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by No. 12 Illinois, No. 18 Wisconsin, No. 22 Michigan State, No. 32 Ohio State, and No. 46 Northwestern. All 14 Big Ten teams also rank in the outlet's top-50 Remaining Strength of Schedule listing.
- More than 1.71 million fans have watched Big Ten basketball this season, including more than 1.15 million fans in our 14 home venues. Eight Big Ten teams rank in the top-26 in total attendance, including three in the top five. Nebraska leads the league with 126,743 fans through nine games, third in the country. Indiana (126,296) and Michigan State (118,376) rank fourth and fifth, respectively. Wisconsin (103,592) and Illinois (100,085) check in at 14th and 15th, with Purdue (89,256) and Maryland (86,282) landing at 22nd and 23rd, while Ohio State (78,933) sits at 26th. In total, 12 Big Ten schools rank in the top 50.
- For the sixth consecutive year, each Big Ten Conference member institution will compete in a 20-game conference schedule. The Big Ten Conference season begins Friday, Dec. 1, when Maryland visits Indiana and Northwestern hosts Purdue, the first of 12 conference games played between Dec. 1-10. Following a break in conference play, Big Ten action will resume on Jan. 2. During the conference season, schools will play seven teams twice -- once at home and once on the road and six teams once, with three of those games being at home and the other three away.
- The 27th annual Big Ten Tournament will be played at Target Center in Minneapolis between March 13-17, 2024, marking the first time the tournament has been played in Minneapolis. All 14 teams will advance to the tournament, with two 1st round games slated for Wednesday, March 13th. The top four teams will receive 1st and 2nd round byes and advance to the quarterfinals on Friday, March 15th.
- A Big Ten media panel has chosen 2023 Consensus National Player of the Year Zach Edey as 2023-24 Big Ten Men's Basketball Player of the Year. The league's reigning Player of the Year, Edey became the first Boilermaker since Glenn Robinson in 1994 to win National Player of the Year accolades and the fifth Big Ten Player in the last 14 years to be named National Player of the Year joining Evan Turner (2010), Trey Burke (2013), Frank Kaminsky (2015) and Luka Garza (2021) as National Players of the Year.
- The media panel also selected the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Edey joined Illinois' Terrence Shannon Jr., Maryland's Jahmir Young, and Northwestern's Boo Buie as unanimous selections. Also named to the team were Maryland's Julian Reese, Minnesota's Dawson Garcia, Michigan State's A.J. Hoggard and Tyson Walker, Nebraska's Keisei Tominaga, and Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi. All ten members of the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team received All-Big Ten honors following the 2022-23 campaign. Buie and Shannon joined Edey with First Team accolades, while Omoruyi, Walker, and Young were named to the Second Team. Hoggard earned a spot on the Third Team, with Garcia, Reese, and Tominaga receiving Honorable Mention.

AROUND THE BIG TEN

Illinois: Over its last two games, the Illini have held their opponents to 21.4 percent (9-42), including holding Missouri to 6-27 in the Bragging Rights game. Illinois leads the Big Ten and ranks 33rd in the country with a 28.3 three-point field goal percentage defense.

Indiana: The Hoosiers outscore their opponents 38.5-27.3 per game in the paint and shoot 54.4 percent (267-of-491) inside the three-point arc. The Hoosiers have also scored north of 50 points in the paint twice this season.

Iowa: In Iowa's 103-81 win over UMBC, the Hawkeyes notched 33 assists, a season-high, the second-most assists in program history, and eighth-most in the nation this season. Freshman Brock Harding led the team with a career-high 12 dimes, most by an Iowa freshman since Jordan Bohannon's 13 in 2017.

Maryland: The Terps will carry an 18-game home win streak into tonight's home game against Coppin State. Maryland won its final 11 games at XFINITY Center last season and is 7-0 on its home floor this season. The Terps home win streak is the fourth-longest nationally, and tied with Marquette for the longest run among "power" conferences.

Michigan: Graduate student Olivia Nkamhoua has started 70 consecutive games when he has been active, dating back to his years at Tennessee. This season, the Finland international ranks second on the team with 17.2 points, while his 7.6 rebounds lead the Wolverines.

Michigan State: The Spartans' 99-55 win marked the program's largest margin of victory since a 44-point win over Western Michigan (90-46) on Nov. 21, 2021. Their 48-12 halftime lead was the team's largest since a 63-25 advantage over Cleveland State on Dec. 29, 2017.

Minnesota: The Gophers average a Big Ten-best 19.9 assists per game, sixth in the country. Much of that production comes from junior Elijah Hawkins, whose 91 total assists and 7.6 assists per game are good for second in the nation.

Nebraska: A win over South Carolina State on Friday will cap one of the most successful non-conference slates in school history. NU has finished non-conference play with one loss only four times (10-1, 2018-19; 10-1, 2003-04; 12-1, 1991-92; 11-1, 1977-78) since World War II.

Northwestern: The Wildcats held ASU to 46 points, one game after holding DePaul to 46 points. It is the first time that NU has limited back-to-back opponents to 46 points or fewer since doing so against Brown and North Florida on Nov. 21 and 25, 2006. It is the fewest points scored by a Pac-12/Pacific Coast team against Northwestern since Washington was held to 45 points on Dec. 20, 1960.

Ohio State: The 36 points Ohio State allowed in its 78-36 win over New Orleans were the fewest since allowing 31 in a 71-31 victory over Louisiana Monroe on Dec. 27, 2013. That was also the last time an opponent failed to have a double-figure scorer.

Penn State: The Nittany Lions have forced their opponents into 16.33 turnovers per game, a mark that leads the Big Ten and ranks 17th in the nation. Penn State's +5.3 turnover margin ranks second in the Big Ten and 10th in the country. The team's defensive intensity has led to 17.2 points off turnovers per game.

Purdue: The Boilermakers have won 34 straight non-conference, regular-season games, the longest streak for any program in the country in almost 10 years and the fifth-longest streak in the last 30 years. Purdue is attempting to become the third team in the last 50 years (Syracuse -- 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12; Duke -- 1991-92, 1992-93, 1993-94) to have three straight unbeaten regular seasons against non-conference opponents.

Rutgers: Rutgers enters the matchup against Stonehill with a 6-0 record in home non-conference games. The Scarlet Knights are 33-2 in the past five seasons at home against non-conference foes and have won 49 of their past 53 home non-conference games. Under head coach Steve Pikiell since 2016-17, Rutgers is 57-6 in home non-conference games.

Wisconsin: The Badgers held Chicago State to a 20-for-63 (32%) clip from the field. That's the lowest shooting percentage the Badgers have allowed all season and the lowest since Wisconsin held Dayton to a 14-for-59 (23.7%) performance from the field on Nov. 23, 2022).

TIE BREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING

1. Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
2. A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runner-up the No. 2 seed, etc.).
3. Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
4. In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

Ties Involving Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
2. Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Ties Involving more than Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
 - a. When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. If winning percentage among the group for any tied teams is equal, move to step b with those specific tied teams only (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step b and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).

Note: Teams can be separated from the top, middle or bottom.
 - b. If a team or teams are separated from the group based on step a, seeding for remaining teams among the group is not determined by head-to-head record vs. the remaining teams, but rather by taking all remaining teams to next tiebreaker.
2. If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
