BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Purdue, Illinois, and Wisconsin continue to represent the Big Ten in this week's top-25 polls. The Boilermakers remain at No. 1 for the fourth consecutive week, while Illinois falls to No. 10 in both polls and the Badgers move up to 15. Michigan State and Northwestern also garnered attention in both the AP and USA Today Coaches Polls, while the media also recognized Ohio State.
- The Big Ten closed its nonconference slate with a combined 117-37 record. The Big 12 (144-34), SEC (132-47), Atlantic 10 (131-60), and ACC (119-46) collected more wins, but the Big Ten's .760-win percentage falls behind only the Big 12 (.809). Among the B1G's 117 victories are 9 wins over AP Top 25 opponents.
- Illinois' Marcus Domask was named Big Ten Player of the Week, presented by Air National Guard, for the week of Jan. 1-7. Domask averaged 29.0 points, 5.5 assists and 4.0 rebounds while shooting 59.4% from the field, 66.7% from 3-point range, and 90% from the free-throw line, as the Illini split a pair of games. Overall, Domask accounted for 49% of Illinois' offense during the week, combining for 58 points while assisting on an additional 27. The graduate student shot 11-15 from the floor and 9-10 from the free throw line for 32 points in a victory over Northwestern, then scored a game-high 26 points while playing all 40 minutes in a loss at No. 1 Purdue.
- Iowa's Owen Freeman was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week for the same period, collecting his fifth honor of the season. Freeman averaged 14.5 points, 8.5 rebounds, and 2.5 blocks as the Hawkeyes went 1-1 on the week. The freshman shot 7-9 and paired 14 points, a game-high 13 rebounds, and three blocks in a loss at No. 21 Wisconsin before posting 15 points on 5-7 shooting en route to 15 points, four rebounds and two blocks in a win over Rutgers. For the week Freeman shot 75 percent (12-16) from the floor and 83.3 percent (5-6) from the free throw line.
- MILESTONE WATCH... Congratulations to Iowa head coach Fran McCaffery who earned his 127th Big Ten win on Saturday, breaking a tie with Tom Davis for most in program history. McCaffery remains one win from tying Davis on the program's all-time wins list... Michigan State head coach Tom Izzo enters Sunday's game with 696 wins. Izzo is on the verge of becoming the 10th active coach in Div. I to record 700 career victories... Ohio State head coach Chris Holtmann will carry 249 career wins into Wednesday's home game against Wisconsin. His 135 victories in Columbus are fifth most in program history.
- Eight Big Ten teams rank in the top-75 in Tuesday's NET rankings, including four in the top 30. Purdue's No. 2 ranking is tops in the league, while Illinois and Wisconsin sit at Nos. 9 and 13 respectively, followed by No. 28 Michigan State, No. 44 Ohio State, No. 58 Nebraska, No. 68 Iowa, and No. 71 Northwestern. The ACC leads the nation with 11 top-75 entrants, one more than the Big 12 while the Big East and SEC have nine each, three more than the Pac 12.
- The Big Ten ranks second in the nation with 21 Quad 1 wins, just two behind the Big East. The Big Ten also owns a combined 36 Quad 1 and 2 victories, tied with the ACC for third in the country behind the SEC's 40 and the Big East's 37.
- The Big Ten ranks among the nation's best conferences on both sides of the hardwood. Offensively, 11 teams average north of 75.0 points per game, led by Iowa's Big Ten-best 86.7 points, which ranks ninth in the country, six spots north of Purdue (85.2 points). Six teams also rank in the top-50 in the country in field goal percentage, led by Purdue's 49.3, good for 22nd. Indiana and Minnesota shoot 48.9 percent from the floor, 29th and 31st nationally, followed by Indiana (49.2 percent), Michigan State (48.4), Michigan (48.1), and Illinois (47.9). Much of that offensive efficiency stems from taking care of the ball, as five team list in the top-25 in assists/turnover ratio. Northwestern leads the league and ranks fourth in the country with a 1.9 ratio, while Iowa's 1.86 is good for eight. Michigan State (1.67) checks in at 13th, followed by Minnesota (1.61) and Purdue (1.57) in 18th and 21st.
- Defensively, the Big Ten boasts 10 teams that hold their opponents to below 68.0 points per game, led by Maryland, who surrenders just 63.7 points per outing, good for 27th nationally, followed by Rutgers, who ranks 31st, allowing just 64.2 point. Four Big Ten teams also rank in the nation's top 30 in field goal percentage defense. Illinois tops the conference, holding its opponents to 38.2 percent shooting, 10th in the country. Rutgers ranks 16th at 38.8 percent, while Michigan State and Nebraska hold opponents to 39.0 percent. The Scarlet Knights also rank 10th in the country with 5.9 blocked shots per contest, while Penn State forces a league-best 16.67 turnovers per game, 14th in the country.
- Big Ten players also rank in the top-10 in several individual statistical categories. Purdue's Zach Edey ranks fourth in the country with 22.3 points per game, eighth in rebounds (10.6), and sixth in double-doubles (9), while his 149 free throw attempts and 112 free throw makes rank first and fifth in the NCAA. Minnesota's Elijah Hawkins ranks second in the

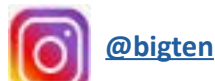

nation with 7.8 assists per contest, while Purdue's Braden Smith (6.7) stands eighth. Two Big Ten players, Michigan State's Tre Holloman and Ohio State's Bruce Thornton sit second and fourth in the nation with 5.33 and 4.64 assist/turnover ratios. Defensively, Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi's 3.36 blocked shots per game are good for third.

- Seven Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-60 in today's Kenpom rankings, including five in the top-36. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by Illinois (#7), Wisconsin (#12), Michigan State (#20), Ohio State (#36), Nebraska (#529), Iowa (#53), and Northwestern (#56). The Big 12 leads the nation with 10 teams in the top-60, two more than the Big Ten and SEC, while the Big East and ACC have seven each.
- Six Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-50 of the ESPN Basketball Power Index (BPI) listing. Purdue leads the way at No. 2, followed by No. 9 Illinois, No. 16 Wisconsin, No. 19 Michigan State, No. 36 Ohio State, and No. 49 Iowa. All 14 Big Ten teams also rank in the outlet's top-51 Remaining Strength of Schedule listing.
- More than 2.2 million fans have watched Big Ten basketball this season, including nearly 1.5 million fans in our 14 home venues. Seven Big Ten teams rank in the top-20 in total attendance, including three in the top five. Indiana tops the Big Ten and ranks second in the nation with 159,569 fans through 10 home contests. Nebraska (155,176) and Michigan State (147,490) rank fourth and fifth, with Wisconsin (134,372) and Illinois (130,748) in 10th and 11th, respectively. Purdue (119,008) sits in 17th with Maryland (111,487) in 20th. In total, 13 Big Ten schools rank in the top 55.
- For the sixth consecutive year, each Big Ten Conference member institution will compete in a 20-game conference schedule. The Big Ten Conference season begins Friday, Dec. 1, when Maryland visits Indiana and Northwestern hosts Purdue, the first of 12 conference games played between Dec. 1-10. Following a break in conference play, Big Ten action will resume on Jan. 2. During the conference season, schools will play seven teams twice -- once at home and once on the road and six teams once, with three of those games being at home and the other three away.
- The 27th annual Big Ten Tournament will be played at Target Center in Minneapolis between March 13-17, 2024, marking the first time the tournament has been played in Minneapolis. All 14 teams will advance to the tournament, with two 1st round games slated for Wednesday, March 13th. The top four teams will receive 1st and 2nd round byes and advance to the quarterfinals on Friday, March 15th.
- A Big Ten media panel has chosen 2023 Consensus National Player of the Year Zach Edey as 2023-24 Big Ten Men's Basketball Player of the Year. The league's reigning Player of the Year, Edey became the first Boilermaker since Glenn Robinson in 1994 to win National Player of the Year accolades and the fifth Big Ten Player in the last 14 years to be named National Player of the Year joining Evan Turner (2010), Trey Burke (2013), Frank Kaminsky (2015) and Luka Garza (2021) as National Players of the Year.
- The media panel also selected the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Edey joined Illinois' Terrence Shannon Jr., Maryland's Jahmir Young, and Northwestern's Boo Buie as unanimous selections. Also named to the team were Maryland's Julian Reese, Minnesota's Dawson Garcia, Michigan State's A.J. Hoggard and Tyson Walker, Nebraska's Keisei Tominaga, and Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi. All ten members of the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team received All-Big Ten honors following the 2022-23 campaign. Buie and Shannon joined Edey with First Team accolades, while Omoruyi, Walker, and Young were named to the Second Team. Hoggard earned a spot on the Third Team, with Garcia, Reese, and Tominaga receiving Honorable Mention.

AROUND THE BIG TEN

Illinois: The Illini have outrebounded their opponents in 11 of 14 games this season. Illinois leads the Big Ten and ranks fourth in the NCAA in total rebounds per game (44.00) and fifth in defensive rebounds per game (30.79), while its rebounding margin (+10.6) ranks 12th nationally. The team also ranks 39th in offensive rebounds per game (13.21), second in the conference.

Indiana: After scoring in double figures just seven times as a freshman, sophomore Malik Reneau has already done so 14 times this season, including 11 games with at least 14 points. Reneau currently leads the Hoosiers with 16.5 points, while shooting 59.1% from the floor, 47.8% from the 3-point line, and 68.3% from the free throw line.

Iowa: The Hawkeyes have been hot at Carver-Hawkeye Arena so far this season. Iowa is 7-1 on its home court and averages 96.4 points per game on 49.3 percent shooting and committing just 8.25 turnovers per game.

Maryland: Fifth-year guard Jahmir Young was one of the top scorers nationally in December. The fifth-year senior ranked seventh nationally with a 24.2 point per game average (the third-best average among Big Ten players) despite missing one game. Young now has 831 points in his second season at Maryland. He is closing in on being the sixth NCAA player since 2006 to post 1,000 points at two different institutions.

Michigan: Four Wolverines score at least 10.0 points per game - Dug McDaniel (17.8), Olivier Nkamhoua (16.8), Terrance Williams II (10.3) and Nimari Burnett (10.4). Overall, Michigan has had at least three Wolverines finish double figure scorers in all 14 games. Four Wolverines have in double-digits six times, five three times and six once. All five Wolverine starters have reached double figures in three games.

Michigan State: Graduate student Tyson Walker leads the Spartans with 20.6 points per game, third in the Big Ten and 15th in the nation. The last MSU player to average at least 20.0 points per game was Shawn Respert, who averaged 25.6 ppg in 1994-95)

Minnesota: The Gophers' 65-62 win over Maryland Gophers snapped a 10-game losing streak versus the Terps, winning for the first time since an 89-75 victory at Maryland on Feb. 22, 2017. It was the Gophers' first home win versus the Terps since defeating Maryland 68-63 on Feb. 18, 2016. The victory also improved Minnesota to 3-1 in Big Ten play for the first time since the 2016-17 season.

Nebraska: Tuesday's game against Purdue will mark Nebraska's 17th game against the nation's No. 1 team in

program history and first since Feb. 13, 2013. It is also the first time that the Huskers have hosted a No. 1 team since Feb. 24, 2002, when Keith Langford's 3-pointer with 33 seconds left lifted Kansas to an 88-87 win over the Huskers, and the sixth time in program history the Huskers have hosted the No. 1 team.

Northwestern: All five Wildcats scored in double figures in their 88-74 win over Michigan State, marking the first time since Nov. 13, 2017 that has happened. Northwestern's 88 points also are the most the team has scored against the Spartans since claiming a 105-89 win on Jan. 8, 1976.

Ohio State: The Buckeyes pulled-down 22 offensive rebounds against Indiana as part of their season-high tying 49 rebounds. The last time Ohio State had 22 offensive rebounds in a game was Nov. 25, 2016, when it had 27 against Marshall. The last time it happened against a Big Ten team was on March 5, 2003, when the Buckeyes had 22 against Northwestern.

Penn State: The Nittany Lions have posted major comebacks in both of its Big Ten victories this season. Penn State overcame an 18-point second half deficit to top Ohio State 83-80 on Dec. 9, outscoring the Buckeyes 46-25 over the final 15:30. On Sunday, Penn State trailed Michigan by 14 points late in the first half before outscoring the Wolverines 29-12 in the first 10 minutes of the second half of the 79-73 win.

Purdue: During its seven-game win streak, the Boilermakers are averaging just 10.6 turnovers per game (13.1 in first eight games of season), while shooting 50.0 percent from the field with an offensive efficiency of 130.6 -- the best mark in America during that span.

Rutgers: Clifford Omoruyi leads the Big Ten and ranks third in the nation with 47 total blocks and 3.31 blocked shots per game. The senior has had multiple blocks in 11 of the 14 games this season, has six games of at least four blocks, and two games of at least seven blocks

Wisconsin: The Badgers' 88-72 win over Nebraska marked the third straight game and the 4th time this season, the Badgers have scored at least 80 points. The last time UW scored more than 80 points in three straight was a stretch of four consecutive from Dec. 13-Dec. 30, 2017. Wisconsin has scored at least 80 in back-to-back Big Ten games for the first time since the 2014-15 season when UW scored topped Penn State and Northwestern in consecutive wins.

TIE BREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING

1. Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
2. A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runner-up the No. 2 seed, etc.).
3. Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
4. In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

Ties Involving Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
2. Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Ties Involving more than Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
 - a. When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. If winning percentage among the group for any tied teams is equal, move to step b with those specific tied teams only (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step b and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).

Note: Teams can be separated from the top, middle or bottom.
 - b. If a team or teams are separated from the group based on step a, seeding for remaining teams among the group is not determined by head-to-head record vs. the remaining teams, but rather by taking all remaining teams to next tiebreaker.
2. If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Nominations for the awards are made each week by the men's basketball communications contacts and selected by a vote of the Big Ten Communications staff.

Postseason Awards

All-Big Ten awards, as determined by the coaches and media, will be announced on March 12, 2024. The awards list includes First, Second, and Third All-Big Ten Teams and Honorable Mention, All-Freshman and All-Defensive Team, Coach of the Year, Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year, Sixth Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year, and the Howard Moore Assistant Coach of the Year.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
