BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Purdue, Illinois, and Wisconsin continue to represent the Big Ten in this week's top-25 polls. The Boilermakers remain at No. 1 for the fourth consecutive week, while Illinois falls to No. 10 in both polls and the Badgers move up to 15. Michigan State and Northwestern also garnered attention in both the AP and USA Today Coaches Polls, while the media also recognized Ohio State.
- Illinois' Marcus Domask was named Big Ten Player of the Week, presented by Air National Guard, for the week of Jan. 1-7. Domask averaged 29.0 points, 5.5 assists and 4.0 rebounds while shooting 59.4% from the field, 66.7% from 3-point range, and 90% from the free-throw line, as the Illini split a pair of games. Overall, Domask accounted for 49% of Illinois' offense during the week, combining for 58 points while assisting on an additional 27. The graduate student shot 11-15 from the floor and 9-10 from the free throw line for 32 points in a victory over Northwestern, then scored a game-high 26 points while playing all 40 minutes in a loss at No. 1 Purdue.
- Iowa's Owen Freeman was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week for the same period, collecting his fifth honor of the season. Freeman averaged 14.5 points, 8.5 rebounds, and 2.5 blocks as the Hawkeyes went 1-1 on the week. The freshman shot 7-9 and paired 14 points, a game-high 13 rebounds, and three blocks in a loss at No. 21 Wisconsin before posting 15 points on 5-7 shooting en route to 15 points, four rebounds and two blocks in a win over Rutgers. For the week Freeman shot 75 percent (12-16) from the floor and 83.3 percent (5-6) from the free throw line.
- On Wednesday, Jan. 10, the Los Angeles Athletic Club announced the John R. Wooden Award® presented by Principal® Midseason Top 25 Watch List. Purdue's Zach Edey and Michigan State's Tyson Walker were listed among those considered strong candidates for the honor which will be announced following the NCAA Tournament in April.
- MILESTONE WATCH... Congratulations to Iowa head coach Fran McCaffery who recently earned his 127th Big Ten win, breaking a tie with Tom Davis for most in program history. McCaffery remains one win from tying Davis on the program's all-time wins list... Michigan State head coach Tom Izzo enters Sunday's game with 696 wins. Izzo is on the verge of becoming the 10th active coach in Div. I to record 700 career victories. Thursday's home contest against Minnesota will also mark Izzo's 500th career Big Ten game, making him just the second coach in conference history to reach the mark, joining the late Bobby Knight (504)... Ohio State head coach Chris Holtmann will carry 249 career wins into Monday's game at Michigan. His 135 victories in Columbus are fifth most in program history.
- Eight Big Ten teams rank in the top-70 in Friday's NET rankings, including four in the top 30. Purdue's No. 3 ranking is tops in the league, while Illinois and Wisconsin sit at Nos. 11 and 12 respectively, followed by No. 26 Michigan State, No. 42 Nebraska, No. 46 Ohio State, No. 68 Iowa, and No. 69 Northwestern. The Big 12 leads the nation with 10 top-70 entrants, one more than the SEC while the Big Ten, Big East and ACC have eight each, two more than the Pac 12.
- The Big Ten's 22 Quad 1 wins are tied with the Big East for the most in the country, three north of the ACC and five clear of the Big 12. The Big Ten's 40 combined Quad 1 and 2 victories rank third behind the SEC's 45 (14 Q1, 31 Q2) and the ACC's 41 (19 Q1, 22 Q2). The Big East's 38 combined wins (22 Q1, 16 Q2) sit third.
- The Big Ten ranks among the nation's best conferences on both sides of the hardwood. Offensively, 10 teams average north of 75.0 points per game, led by Iowa's Big Ten-best 86.7 points, which ranks ninth in the country, 10 spots north of Purdue (84.4 points). Eight teams also rank in the top-65 in the country in field goal percentage, led by Purdue and Minnesota at 48.9 percent. Indiana (48.3 percent), Michigan State (48.0) also rank in the nation's top 50. Much of that offensive efficiency stems from taking care of the ball, as five team list in the top-25 in assists/turnover ratio. Iowa ranks fourth in the country with a 1.86 ratio, fourth in the country, while Northwestern's 1.78 is good for eighth. Michigan State checks in at 12th (1.66), followed by Minnesota (1.61) and Purdue (1.54) in 16th and 24th.
- Defensively, the Big Ten boasts 10 teams that hold their opponents to below 69.0 points per game, led by Maryland, who surrenders just 63.3 points per outing, good for 19th nationally, followed by Rutgers, who ranks 25th, allowing just 63.7 points. Four Big Ten teams also rank in the nation's top 30 in field goal percentage defense. Illinois tops the conference, holding its opponents to 38.5 percent shooting, 11th in the country. Rutgers ranks 16th at 38.8 percent, while Michigan State and Nebraska hold opponents to 39.2 percent. The Scarlet Knights also rank 10th in the country with 6.0 blocked shots per contest, while Penn State forces a league-best 16.75 turnovers per game, 14th in the country.
- Big Ten players also rank in the top-10 in several individual statistical categories. Purdue's Zach Edey ranks seventh in the country with 21.8 points per game and sixth in double-doubles (9), while his 154 free throw attempts and 115 free throw makes rank first and sixth in the NCAA. Minnesota's Elijah Hawkins ranks second in the nation with 7.8 assists per

contest, while Purdue's Braden Smith (6.7) stands seventh. Ohio State's Jamison Battle's 46.8 three-point percentage ranks 10th, while two Big Ten players, Michigan State's Tre Holloman and Ohio State's Bruce Thornton sit third and fourth in the nation with 5.10 and 4.73 assist/turnover ratios. Defensively, Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi's 3.47 blocked shots per game are good for third, while Penn State's Ace Baldwin Jr.'s 2.88 steals per game rank fifth.

- Eight Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-60 in today's Kenpom rankings, including six in the top-40. Purdue leads the way at No. 3, followed by Illinois (#10), Wisconsin (#11), Michigan State (#17), Nebraska (#39), Ohio State (#40), Iowa (#53), and Northwestern (#55). The Big 12 leads the nation with 11 teams in the top-60, three more than the Big Ten and Big East, while the SEC has seven and ACC six.
- Eight Big Ten teams currently rank in the top-55 of the ESPN Basketball Power Index (BPI) listing. Purdue leads the way at No. 3, followed by No. 10 Illinois, No. 14 Wisconsin, No. 17 Michigan State, No. 44 Ohio State, No. 50 Iowa, No. 51 Northwestern, and No. 55 Nebraska. Eleven Big Ten teams also rank in the outlet's top-50 Remaining Strength of Schedule listing.
- More than 2.3 million fans have watched Big Ten basketball this season, including more than 1.5 million fans in our 14 home venues. Seven Big Ten teams rank in the top-20 in total attendance, including four in the top 10. Nebraska leads the Big Ten and ranks third nationally with 169,282 fans through 12 games, one spot ahead of Indiana's 159,569 fans in 10 contests. Michigan State (147,970) and Illinois (145,475) rank list sixth and seventh, respectively. In total, 13 Big Ten schools rank in the top 55 in total home attendance.
- The Big Ten closed its nonconference slate with a combined 117-37 record. The Big 12 (144-34), SEC (132-47), Atlantic 10 (131-60), and ACC (119-46) collected more wins, but the Big Ten's .760-win percentage falls behind only the Big 12 (.809). Among the B1G's 117 victories are 9 wins over AP Top 25 opponents.
- For the sixth consecutive year, each Big Ten Conference member institution will compete in a 20-game conference schedule. The Big Ten Conference season begins Friday, Dec. 1, when Maryland visits Indiana and Northwestern hosts Purdue, the first of 12 conference games played between Dec. 1-10. Following a break in conference play, Big Ten action will resume on Jan. 2. During the conference season, schools will play seven teams twice -- once at home and once on the road and six teams once, with three of those games being at home and the other three away.
- The 27th annual Big Ten Tournament will be played at Target Center in Minneapolis between March 13-17, 2024, marking the first time the tournament has been played in Minneapolis. All 14 teams will advance to the tournament, with two 1st round games slated for Wednesday, March 13th. The top four teams will receive 1st and 2nd round byes and advance to the quarterfinals on Friday, March 15th.
- A Big Ten media panel has chosen 2023 Consensus National Player of the Year Zach Edey as 2023-24 Big Ten Men's Basketball Player of the Year. The league's reigning Player of the Year, Edey became the first Boilermaker since Glenn Robinson in 1994 to win National Player of the Year accolades and the fifth Big Ten Player in the last 14 years to be named National Player of the Year joining Evan Turner (2010), Trey Burke (2013), Frank Kaminsky (2015) and Luka Garza (2021) as National Players of the Year.
- The media panel also selected the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team. Edey joined Illinois' Terrence Shannon Jr., Maryland's Jahmir Young, and Northwestern's Boo Buie as unanimous selections. Also named to the team were Maryland's Julian Reese, Minnesota's Dawson Garcia, Michigan State's A.J. Hoggard and Tyson Walker, Nebraska's Keisei Tominaga, and Rutgers' Clifford Omoruyi. All ten members of the 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team received All-Big Ten honors following the 2022-23 campaign. Buie and Shannon joined Edey with First Team accolades, while Omoruyi, Walker, and Young were named to the Second Team. Hoggard earned a spot on the Third Team, with Garcia, Reese, and Tominaga receiving Honorable Mention.

Illinois: KenPom also rates the Illini among the top-25 programs nationally in adjusted efficiency on both offense (6th, 119.9) and defense (17th, 94.5). Illinois is one of only eight programs to rank inside the top 20 in both metrics. The site also lists Illinois among the top three nationally in two defensive categories, ranking second in the nation in two-point field goal percentage defense (.409) and third effective field goal percentage defense (.431).

Indiana: Indiana has outscored its opponent in the paint in 13 of 16 games this season. The Hoosiers average 38.2 points per game in the paint and shoot 54.0% (349-of-646) from inside the arc, while holding their opposition to 26.6 points per night in the key. Much of their post scoring comes from sophomore forwards Kel'el Ware and Malik Reneau, who combine for 31.0 points per contest.

Iowa: For the second consecutive season, the Hawkeyes opened Big Ten play with three consecutive losses. After last week's opening victory over Rutgers, Iowa hopes to repeat last season's feat, responding with four consecutive wins and victories in seven of nine games during a one month span to finish the 2022-23 season with an 11-9 Big Ten record.

Maryland: After trailing Michigan by 12 points at the halftime break in Thursday's game, the Terps outscored the Wolverines 43-24 in the second half on their way to a 64-57 home win. It was the first time Maryland rallied from a double-digit halftime deficit to win a game since Feb. 26, 2020 at Minnesota. The Terps trailed that game 47-31 at intermission before rallying for a 74-73 win in the "Minneapolis Miracle" game.

Michigan: In Thursday's game at Maryland, a pair of Wolverines hit career milestones. With 18 points, Olivier Nkamhoua surpassed the 1,000-career point plateau. The grad transfer collected 733 points in four seasons at Tennessee before scoring 270 this season in the Maize and Blue. Senior Terrence Williams II became the 75th Wolverine to appear in 100 career games, tying Michigan head coach Juwan Howard.

Michigan State: The Spartans have handed out at least 20 six times and at least 15 on 11 occasions, while averaging 18.6 per game (4th in the Big Ten, No. 11 nationally). Individually, four Spartans rank in the top-20 in the Big Ten in assists per game: A.J. Hoggard (4th-5.1), Jeremy Fears Jr. (12th-3.3), Tre Holloman (14th-3.2), and Tyson Walker (19th-2.9).

Minnesota: Of Minnesota's 15 games, the Gophers have had at least four players score in double figures 10 times. On six occasions, five Gophers have reached the 10-point plateau, while four have reached the mark in four other games, including last weekend's victory over Maryland,

a game that also saw two Minnesota players with eight points.

Nebraska: Nebraska enters the Iowa game averaging 78.4 points per game. It is NU's highest points per game average since averaging 80.2 points per game in the 1995-96 season and on pace to finish in the top 10 in single-season scoring average. It is also more than 10 points per game higher than NU's average at the 16-game mark in 2002-23. NU has climbed from 149th to 32nd nationally in offensive efficiency in KenPom as of Jan. 10.

Northwestern: Boo Buie has posted 18 assists over his last two games (10 vs. Michigan State, 8 vs. Penn State). The graduate student is the only high-major player averaging 18 points and five assists per game this season. Buie ranks sixth in the Big Ten in scoring at 18.1 points, while his 5.1 assists are good for third.

Ohio State: Jamison Battle leads the Big Ten with 47 made three-pointers and a 46.8 three-point shooting percentage. The fifth-year forward has connected on at least four three-pointers in each of his last five games and is shooting better than 58.1 percent from deep during the stretch.

Penn State: Senior Ace Baldwin Jr. set the Bryce Jordan Center facility record and tied Penn State's program record with a career-best eight steals in Wednesday's loss to Northwestern. The eight steals are the most a Penn State player has recorded in a game since Monroe Brown posted eight swipes at Rhode Island on Jan. 3, 1991.

Purdue: Senior Zach Edey ranks in the top 20 nationally in points (21.8 PPG), rebounds (10.4 RPG), blocks (2.25 BPG) and field goal percentage (.632). He is the only player in America averaging at least 20 points, 10 rebounds and two blocked shots per game and owns seven 20-10 games this season, ranking first among high-major players, while his 26 career 20-10 games are the most nationally among active players.

Rutgers: The Scarlet Knights, who average 39.1 rebounds per game, fifth in the Big Ten, secured a season-high 52 in Tuesday's victory over Indiana. The 52 boards are the most in program history for a Big Ten regulation game and are tied for third most in a Big Ten game this season.

Wisconsin: Wisconsin off to a 4-0 start in Big Ten play for the first time since 2012-13. The Badgers are looking for their first 5-0 start since opening the 2007-08 season with five straight conference wins en route to a 16-2 mark and a Big Ten championship. UW has won all four Big Ten games by double figures and led wire-to-wire in two of them. During Big Ten play, UW has trailed for a total of just 2:55 in the second half of games.

TIE BREAKER PROCEDURES FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDING

1. Teams shall be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the tournament bracket based on the final regular-season Conference standings.
2. A team's seed shall correspond to its regular-season finish (i.e., the champion shall be the No. 1 seed, the runner-up the No. 2 seed, etc.).
3. Teams that finished Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the regular season shall receive a "bye" through the first two rounds.
4. In case of a tie for any place finish in the regular-season standings, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed in order to seed teams in the tournament bracket:

Ties Involving Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
2. Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular-season standings), continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of all Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Ties Involving more than Two Teams

1. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
 - a. When comparing records against the tied teams, teams will be seeded based on winning percentage among the group, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0). If all teams among the group are separated based on winning percentage, all ties are broken. If winning percentage among the group for any tied teams is equal, move to step b with those specific tied teams only (e.g. if there is a four-team tie, one team is 4-0, another is 3-1 and the last two are 2-2 among the group, the two teams that are 2-2 move to step b and the teams that are 4-0 and 3-1 assume the next two available highest seeds).

Note: Teams can be separated from the top, middle or bottom.
 - b. If a team or teams are separated from the group based on step a, seeding for remaining teams among the group is not determined by head-to-head record vs. the remaining teams, but rather by taking all remaining teams to next tiebreaker.
2. If the remaining teams are still tied, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
 - a. When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tiebreaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
 - b. When comparing records against a single team or group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0 or 0-0).
3. Won-loss percentage of Division I opponents.
4. Highest NET ranking of the teams. NET ranking of the previous week to be utilized.

Postseason Awards

All-Big Ten awards, as determined by the coaches and media, will be announced on March 12, 2024. Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
