BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- The last week of action saw the Big Ten Conference pick up a pair of non-conference Top 25 victories. Indiana took down No. 19/21 Tennessee, 71-57, and lowa took its revenge as it outlasted No. 16/22 Kansas State, 77-70. The Hawkeyes also earned a top-10 win against No. 8/5 Virginia Tech, 80-76, during the opening week of play.
- The third Sunday of the 2023-24 season on Nov. 26 was a fun one for the Big Ten Conference, which went a perfect 6-0 against its non-conference slate.
- This week's schedule is highlighted by a Top 25 showdown between No. 16/13 Ohio State and No. 20/22 Tennessee on Sunday at 5 p.m. ET live on ESPN. Additionally, nine of the 14 Big Ten schools will be playing in their home arenas on Wednesday.
- The Big Ten continues to have a steadfast presence with three Top 25 teams in the Associated Press and Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today polls. Iowa paces the Big Ten in the AP poll at No. 4, followed by No. 16 Ohio State and No. 17 Indiana with Penn State and Maryland receiving votes. The coaches' poll features the same trio - Iowa (4th), Ohio State (13th) and Indiana (17th) - with Michigan and Maryland garnering votes.
- After being named the Big Ten Player of the Week on Monday, Iowa senior Caitlin Clark was selected as one of five Ann Meyers Drysdale National Players of the Week by the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) on Tuesday. She added 27.3 points, 6.6 assists, 4.6 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game during lowa's 3-0 performance to claim the Gulf Coast Showcase title. Clark was tabbed as the tournament's most valuable player.
- As a team, Michigan State ranks in the top five nationally in multiple categories 46.1 three-point percentage (1st), 52.4 field goal percentage (2nd) and 23.3 assists per game (4th). Illinois (52.2) and Iowa (51.0) check in at third and eighth, respectively, in field goal percentage while Indiana stands ninth behind 20.5 assists per game.
- Individually, Caitlin Clark (IOWA) leads the country in assists (60), points (237) and points per game (29.6). DeeDee Hagemann (MSU) is shooting 63.2 percent from beyond the arc to claim the top spot. Natalie Potts (NEB) is second in field goal percentage (.738), followed by Hannah Stuelke (IOWA) in fifth (.717). Caroline Lau (NU) stands fifth in both assists (48) and assists per game (8.0) while Julia Ayrault (MSU) is second in blocks per game (3.0) and Ronnie Porter (WIS) is seventh in steals per game (3.83).
- Head coach Lisa Bluder recorded her 500th win at the helm for Iowa when the Hawkeyes handled Florida Gulf Coast, 100-62, on Nov. 25. Bluder is 501-250 (.667) in 24 seasons at lowa and has a 40-year coaching record of 857-392 (.686). She currently ranks third in career wins among active Division I women's college basketball coaches.
- lowa's game against FGCU was a record-setting outing. With 20 three-pointers, the Hawkeyes set the second-best mark in Big Ten history and broke the school record for most made three-pointers in one game. The matchup at Hertz Arena in Estero, Fla. drew 4,287 fans, an all-time attendance record for the Gulf Coast Showcase.

BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Offensive production continues to be the story for the Big Ten Conference as seven different schools (Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan State, Minnesota, Ohio State and Penn State) have scored 100 points in at least one game this season. Six Big Ten teams are averaging more than 80 points per game and four of the national top 20 scoring offenses reside in the Big Ten, led by Michigan State (8th 93.3), Iowa (10th 90.2), Penn State (18th 84.7) and Ohio State (20th 84.5).
- No. 21/19 Indiana secured an impressive non-conference 71-57 victory over No. 19/21 Tennessee on Nov. 23. It was the second time in as many years that the Hoosiers have bested the Lady Vols and the largest margin of victory (14) in the four-game all-time series. Last year's landmark Hoosier win was the first time a Big Ten Conference school defeated Tennessee in Knoxville. As a conference, the Big Ten has won four of its last five matchups with the Lady Vols, including Ohio State's triumph to open the 2022-23 season and Michigan's victory in the second round of the 2021 NCAA Tournament.

AROUND THE LEAGUE

- Ohio State held Cornell to just two points in the second quarter of its Nov. 26 matchup, the lowest total of a Buckeye opponent in the second quarter in program history.
- Purdue's 36-point margin of victory over Southern Indiana on Nov.
 26 was the second largest of head coach Katie Geralds' tenure.
- Mackenzie Holmes became the second player in Indiana history to score 2,000 career points after dropping 20 points against Princeton on Nov. 25.
- Gabbie Marshall became the first Iowa women's basketball player to record 200 three-pointers and 200 steals in a career on Nov. 24 versus Purdue Fort Wayne.
- Iowa's Caitlin Clark scored 35 points against Drake on Nov. 19 for her 39th career game with 30-plus points, surpassing Kelsey Plum to become the NCAA leader. She also recorded her 44th career game with at least 25 points, five assists and five rebounds, an NCAA-best.
- It was a record-setting night on Nov. 16 when Michigan State defeated Detroit Mercy, 105-44. The Spartans shot 70.9 percent from the field (39-for-55) to break the school record for field goal percentage in a game, dating back to 1986 against Bowling Green.

- It is the fifth-best single-game field goal percentage in Big Ten Conference history. The squad also tied the program record for assists with 34 helpers.
- The Thursday, Nov. 16 Kansas State at Iowa game tallied 415,000 viewers, up 267% from last November's Ione Wednesday Big Ten women's basketball game. The game ranks as the second most watched women's college basketball game ever on FS1.
- Makenna Marisa had a 34-point outing versus Kansas on Nov. 13 to tie for second all-time in career 30-point games (8) at Penn State.
- Caitlin Clark became the Hawkeyes' all-time leading scorer on Nov.
 12 and currently ranks third among the Big Ten Conference's all-time scorers with 2,954 points.
- Mara Braun became the third fastest player in Minnesota history to reach 500 career points (31 games) when she had 25 points against Chicago State on Nov. 12.
- ESPN2 drew 548,000 viewers during its Nov. 9 broadcast of No. 3/3 lowa defeating No. 8/5 Virginia Tech, a 208% increase compared to last November's weekday women's college basketball average.
- Indiana head coach Teri Moren secured her 400th career win in the 96-43 season-opening triumph over Eastern Illinois on Nov. 9. The Hoosiers have won 11 straight season openers, including all 10 under Moren.
- Michigan State head coach Robyn Fralick and Minnesota head coach Dawn Plitzuweit both started their Big Ten tenures with a victory. Fralick coached the Spartans to an 87-62 win against Oakland, the most points scored in a MSU head coach's first game. Plitzuweit led the Golden Gophers past LIU, 92-57. The 35-point margin of victory is the most in a coaching debut at Minnesota.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2023 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 51 honorees during the 2022-23 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 25 of the last 29 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 114 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 675,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's new media agreements with BTN, CBS, FOX and NBC/Peacock, more than 2,300 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis. The Big Ten is the only conference to distribute games on three over-the-air broadcast networks.

BTN reaches more than 50 million homes and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams more than 1,700 additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
