### BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- The Big Ten is coming off one of its most successful weeks of play after going 21-3 (.875) during Week 4 of the 2023-24 season. Conference schools were perfect during three of the five days they played last week.
- Early December ushers in a mix of non-conference and conference games to the Big Ten schedule. All 14 Big Ten programs will open their conference slate this weekend, while eight schools will face non-conference opponents on Tuesday and Wednesday, including Michigan at Toledo (5 p.m. ET Wednesday on CBSSN) and No. 4/3 Iowa at Iowa State (7 p.m. ET Wednesday on ESPN2).
- The Big Ten Network will feature three conference matchups this weekend, starting with a doubleheader on Saturday. Nebraska visits Michigan State at 2 p.m. ET, followed by Rutgers hosting No. 16/15 Indiana at 4 p.m. ET. No. 4/3 Iowa hits the road to take on Wisconsin at 2:30 p.m. ET Sunday.
- The first Top 25 showdown between Big Ten programs is slated for Sunday at 1 p.m. ET when No. 25/ RV Penn State challenges No. 12/11 Ohio State.
- The NCAA issued its initial NET rankings of the 2023-24 season this week and the Big Ten has three teams in the top 20 and an impressive 10 schools among the top 50 – No. 6 Iowa, No. 7 Michigan State, No. 15 Ohio State, No. 25 Michigan, No. 26 Illinois, No. 28 Indiana, No. 33 Penn State, No. 37 Nebraska, No. 42 Minnesota and No. 43 Maryland. The NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) is the primary sorting tool used by the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee for determining NCAA Tournament teams.
- The Big Ten is back up to four teams in this week's Associated Press (AP) Top 25 poll. In the latest media survey, Iowa remains at No. 4, with Ohio State (12th) and Indiana (16th) both moving up. Penn State is making its debut in the poll at No. 25 as Michigan State receives votes. This is the first time the Nittany Lions have been ranked in the AP poll since the final rankings of the 2013-14 season (14th).
- Similarly, the Big Ten has four programs in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today poll, all having moved up in the rankings. Iowa checks in at No. 3, Ohio State is 11th, Indiana climbed to No. 15 and Michigan sits 25th. Maryland and Penn State are both receiving votes.
- Ohio State's Cotie McMahon was named one of five Ann Meyers Drysdale National Players of the Week by the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) on Tuesday. She scored 19 points and went a perfect 6-for-6 from the charity stripe in the Buckeyes' 78-58 victory over Tennessee.
- As of Tuesday, the Big Ten features some of the best shooting teams in the country with six teams among the top 25, including three in the top five, in field goal percentage, according to the latest NCAA statistical report. Iowa paces the conference (2nd - .527), followed by Michigan State (3rd - .523), Illinois (5th - .517), Penn State (11th - .499), Indiana (18th - .488) and Ohio State (24th - .480). Michigan State (.435) and Penn State (.408) are also proficient from beyond the arc, ranking third and seventh, respectively, in three-point percentage.
- Big Ten teams have been passing the rock quite well this season as five programs rank in the top 30 in the country in assists, led by Michigan State (3rd - 22.9), Iowa (10th - 20.7), Indiana (13th - 20.4), Northwestern (21st - 18.6) and Penn State (26th - 18.1). A pair of Big Ten players rank among the top 10 nationally in assists – Iowa's Caitlin Clark (3rd - 7.9 apg) and Northwestern's Caroline Lau (8th - 7.1 apg).
- Individually, Caitlin Clark (IOWA) leads the country in points (261) and points per game (29.0) while coming in second in assists (71). Serah Williams (WIS) and Julia Ayrault (MSU) are sixth (3.12) and seventh (3.00), respectively, in blocks per game. DeeDee Hagemann (MSU) is shooting 55.2 percent from beyond the arc to rank fifth in three-point percentage.
- The Big Ten has consistently ranked among the top three conferences in women's basketball attendance for the past three decades and that trend appears to be continuing this season. Currently, 11 Big Ten schools rank among the top 50 in the nation in average attendance, including seven in the top 25, with both figures leading all Division I conferences. Iowa is second nationally in attendance (14,998 fans per game), followed by Indiana (6th - 8,543), Maryland (12th - 5,737), Nebraska (15th - 5,212), Ohio State (18th - 5,050), Illinois (20th - 4,987) and Purdue (24th - 4,803).

### BIG LIFE. BIG STAGE. BIG TEN.

## BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- No. 16/13 Ohio State secured a landmark non-conference victory on Sunday with a 78-58 win at No. 20/22 Tennessee. It was just the second time in Tennessee's history that the Lady Vols have lost in Thompson-Boling Arena by at least 20 points. Ohio State is only the second Big Ten Conference program to defeat Tennessee in Knoxville, joining Indiana. It was the first time in conference history that the Big Ten has posted multiple wins over Tennessee in back-to-back years – Ohio State and Indiana both claimed victories over the Lady Vols during the 2022-23 season – and has won five of its last six matchups with Tennessee.
- Michigan connected on 14 three-pointers during its 103-59 win over SIUE, tying its school record.
- Illinois outrebounded Central Connecticut State, 48-21, in an 89-50 victory. The +27 rebounding margin is the highest since the 2018 season.
- Maryland's Brinae Alexander knocked down a school-record 11 consecutive field goals on her way to a career-high 29 points against Niagara. Maryland's 114-44 win was the largest margin of victory (70) in four years.
- Mara Braun is the third player in Minnesota history to play 50 minutes in a game and the first to commit zero turnovers while doing so in a 94-88 comeback win over Drake. She also made history after making her 34th consecutive free throw in the victory to set a new program record. She has started the season 27-for-27 from the charity stripe with her streak dating back to last year. Braun is one of five players in the country who hasn't missed a free throw this season with her ongoing streak being eighth in Big Ten history and the longest streak in the conference since 2018.
- Nebraska dropped 58 second-half points on Georgia Tech, which tied for the 10th most in a second half in school history.
- Rebeka Mikulášiková became the 37th player in Ohio State history to score 1,000 career points after finishing with a season-high 18 points at Tennessee.
- Offensive production continues to be the story for the Big Ten Conference as nine different schools (Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Maryland, Michigan, Michigan State, Minnesota, Ohio State and Penn State) have scored 100 points in at least one game this season. Six Big Ten teams are averaging more than 80 points per game and four of the national top 20 scoring offenses reside in the Big Ten, led by Michigan State (3rd – 93.9), Iowa (7th – 91.2), Penn State (15th – 83.9) and Ohio State (16th – 83.6).
- No. 21/19 Indiana secured an impressive non-conference 71-57 victory over No. 19/21 Tennessee on Nov. 23. It was the second time in as many years that the Hoosiers have bested the Lady Vols and the largest margin of victory (14) in the four-game all-time series. Last year's Hoosier win was the first time a Big Ten Conference school defeated Tennessee in Thompson-Boling Arena. The matchup scored 1,118,000 viewers to rank as FOX's most-watched women's college basketball game ever and the most watched regular season women's college basketball game on any network since last season's 1,466,000 viewers for LSU vs. South Carolina on ESPN.
- Mackenzie Holmes became the second player in Indiana history to score 2,000 career points after dropping 20 points against Princeton on Nov. 25.
- Head coach Lisa Bluder recorded her 500th win at the helm for Iowa when the Hawkeyes handled Florida Gulf Coast, 100-62, on Nov. 25. She currently ranks third in career wins among active Division I women's college basketball coaches.
- Iowa's game against FGCU was a record-setting outing. With 20 three-pointers, the Hawkeyes set the second-best mark in Big Ten history and broke the school record for most made three-pointers in one game. The matchup at Hertz Arena in Estero, Fla. drew 4,287 fans, an all-time attendance record for the Gulf Coast Showcase.
- Gabbie Marshall became the first Iowa women's basketball player to record 200 three-pointers and 200 steals in a career on Nov. 24 versus Purdue Fort Wayne.
- Iowa's Caitlin Clark scored 35 points against Drake on Nov. 19 for her 39th career game with 30-plus points, surpassing Kelsey Plum to become the NCAA leader. She also recorded her 44th career game with at least 25 points, five assists and five rebounds, an NCAA-best.
- It was a record-setting night on Nov. 16 when Michigan State defeated Detroit Mercy, 105-44. The Spartans shot 70.9 percent from the field (39-for-55) to break the school record for field goal percentage in a game, dating back to 1986 against Bowling Green. It is the fifth-best single-game field goal percentage in Big Ten Conference history. The squad also tied the program record for assists with 34 helpers.
- The Thursday, Nov. 16 Kansas State at Iowa game tallied 415,000 viewers, up 267% from last November's lone Wednesday Big Ten women's basketball game. The game ranks as the second most watched women's college basketball game ever on FS1.
- Makenna Marisa had a 34-point outing versus Kansas on Nov. 13 to tie for second all-time in career 30-point games (8) at Penn State.
- Caitlin Clark became the Hawkeyes' all-time leading scorer on Nov. 12 and currently ranks third among the Big Ten Conference's all-time scorers with 2,954 points.
- Mara Braun became the third fastest player in Minnesota history to reach 500 career points (31 games) when she had 25 points against Chicago State on Nov. 12.
- ESPN2 drew 548,000 viewers during its Nov. 9 broadcast of No. 3/3 Iowa defeating No. 8/5 Virginia Tech, a 208% increase compared to last November's weekday women's college basketball average.
- Indiana head coach Teri Moren secured her 400th career win in the 96-43 season-opening triumph over Eastern Illinois on Nov. 9. The Hoosiers have won 11 straight season openers, including all 10 under Moren.
- Michigan State head coach Robyn Fralick and Minnesota head coach Dawn Plitzuweit both started their Big Ten tenures with a victory. Fralick coached the Spartans to an 87-62 win against Oakland, the most points scored in a MSU head coach's first game. Plitzuweit led the Golden Gophers past LIU, 92-57. The 35-point margin of victory is the most in a coaching debut at Minnesota.

## AROUND THE LEAGUE

- Ohio State held Cornell to just two points in the second quarter of its Nov. 26 matchup, the lowest total of a Buckeye opponent in the second quarter in program history.
- Purdue's 36-point margin of victory over Southern Indiana on Nov. 26 was the second largest of head coach Katie Gerald's tenure.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

### **PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS**

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2023 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 51 honorees during the 2022-23 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

### **A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS**

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 25 of the last 29 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 114 team national championships in 26 different sports.

### **BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING**

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

### **PASSIONATE FOLLOWING**

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 675,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

### **LEADERS IN INNOVATION**

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

### **EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE**

Through the Big Ten's new media agreements with BTN, CBS, FOX and NBC/Peacock, more than 2,300 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis. The Big Ten is the only conference to distribute games on three over-the-air broadcast networks.

BTN reaches more than 50 million homes and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams more than 1,700 additional events each season.

### **COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT**

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
