GAME NOTES

PURDUE NOTES

- Purdue advanced to today's second round with a six-point win over Northwestern yesterday.
- Bench scoring accounted for 31 of the team's 56 points.
- Sophie Swanson hit on 7-of-9 three-point attempts, setting Purdue's freshman single-game record. She recorded a career-high 25 points and tied Brittany Rayburn (2012) for the most three-pointers by a Boilermaker in a Big Ten Tournament game.
- Swanson's seven three-pointers tied for fourth-most in a tournament contest.

NEBRASKA NOTES

- Nebraska hit the 20-win mark today for the third time under Head Coach Amy Williams and for the second time in three years.
- Graduate student Jaz Shelley appeared in her 150th collegiate game. She paced the Cornhuskers with 19 points, seven rebounds (sharing the lead) and seven assists in 38 minutes of action.
- Alexis Markowski surpassed 900 rebounds, becoming the sixth Husker to accomplish that feat. She is now tied for sixth place on the school's career list.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Nebraska swept Purdue during the regular season, recording a 68-54 victory Jan. 31 in Lincoln and a 77-65 triumph Feb. 17 in West Lafayette.
- Nebraska took over the all-time lead (11-10) in the series, having now won five straight.
- Today's contest featured eight lead changes.
- All four games of the 2024 Big Ten Tournament have been decided by 10-points or less.
