Big Ten Champions: Indiana won the program's 14th Big Ten Championship finishing the season 7-1-0. The Hoosiers are the first team to win back-to-back Big Ten Championships since the 2012 and 2013 Penn State squads. For more information, click here.

Big Ten Tournament Title: The top-seeded Indiana men's soccer team earned the Big Ten Tournament Championship Sunday, defeating No. 3 seed Michigan on penalty kicks at Ludwig Field in College Park, Md. Postseason Awards: The Big Ten Conference announced the 2019 men's soccer All-Big Ten teams and individual honors Nov. 8. Indiana claimed three honors as Jack Maher was as selected Defender of the Year, Aidan Morris collected Freshman of the Year honors and Todd Yeagley was voted Coach of the Year. Michigan's Nebojsa Popovic was chosen as Offensive Player of the Year and teammate Andrew Verdi earned Goalkeeper of the Year accolades.
