WHAT TYPES OF ORGANIZATIONS ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

- Law firms
- Educational facilities

- Connection with the local privacy community.
- Visibility: the organization name will appear on invitations and registration pages.
- The host organization may participate on the speaker panel.

WHAT PART DOES THE IAPP HAVE IN PLANNING?

- Chapter volunteers organize agenda and speakers.
- The IAPP creates invitations and attendee registrations.

IAPP Policy

- No collection of participant data permitted.
- Only IAPP branding may be used.
- All registration must be held through the IAPP.
- No sponsoring.
- KnowledgeNet meetings must not be recorded.
