## What is auditing consent?

- Assessing consent mechanisms
- Reviewing data processing
- Documentation and record-keeping
- Identifying risks and gaps

Auditing consent ensures organizations respect user privacy rights and meet legal obligations regarding data protection.



# Importance of consent management

- Clear and transparent consent mechanisms build trust with consumers.
- Ensuring their rights are respected both on the web and in other use cases.
- Crucial for compliance with privacy regulations such as GDPR, CCPA, and CPRA.
- Failing to obtain valid consent can result in hefty fines, as it did Google and British Airways.



# Going beyond basic consent management

- Real-time visibility: Understand what is firing across every page of every property
- Reduce reliance on third-party tag managers: Eliminate potential breakage points that can lead to compliance gaps
- Granular data control: Allow users to specify preferences for each data usage category.
- Full stack consent: Don't forget about other places data is being used where consent has to be honored



### Real-world case studies

#### Social media giant's missteps (Facebook)

- Example: A leading social platform faced backlash due to unclear data practices.
- Lesson: Unclear consent processes can erode trust and incur hefty fines.

#### E-commerce oversight (Amazon)

- Example: An e-commerce giant neglected consent updates, leading to data misuse.
- Lesson: Regular consent updates are crucial for compliance and reputation.

#### Mobile app legal action (TikTok)

- Example: Legal action against a mobile app for unauthorized data collection.
- Lesson: Explicit consent for all data activities is essential to avoid legal consequences.

#### Retail CCPA enforcement (Sephora)

- Example: Sephora fined \$1.2 million for CCPA violations, including failure to disclose data sales and honor GPC signals.
- Lesson: Honoring GPC signals and obtaining explicit consent are vital to compliance and avoiding legal penalties.



# Strategies for auditing consent management

- Regular audits: Ensure frequent assessments of consent mechanisms catch gaps fast.
- **Technology utilization:** Employ software for enhanced visibility into AdTech ecosystems.
- Team collaboration: Foster cooperation among legal, IT, and marketing departments.
- Cultivate compliance culture: Instill a commitment to compliance throughout the organization.



# Benefits of effective consent auditing

- Enhanced compliance: Improve adherence to regulations.
- Trust and transparency: Build consumer confidence.
- Risk mitigation: Minimize legal and reputational risks.
- Regulatory alignment: Stay up-to-date on evolving privacy laws.
