









# **US Privacy Laws**

| California  | Opt-in for Sale/Share of<br>Minors Data          | Required | Required | Regulated                    |
| Connecticut | Opt-in for Processing<br>Sensitive Personal Data | Required | Required | Opt-out of Profiling         |
| Virginia    | Opt-in for Processing<br>Sensitive Personal Data |          | Required | Opt-out of Profiling         |
| Colorado    | Opt-in for Processing<br>Sensitive Personal Data | Required | Required | Opt-out of Profiling         |


