

CCPA Litigation Overview

The IAPP developed this overview to illustrate the differences among the California Consumer Privacy Act cases being filed. It includes the alleged conduct the plaintiff(s) claim violated the CCPA, whether a CCPA count is specifically included in the complaint and other California statutes raised by the plaintiffs. It also has case status information from free legal research websites (not from PACER).

NOTE: The overview is not a comprehensive list of all cases alleging violations of the CCPA and does not include the most recent docket information.

CALIFORNIA STATUTORY COUNTS INFORMATION

California Consumer Privacy Act	Cal. Civ. Code Sections 1798.100-1798.199	Protects California residents related to the processing of personal information, including the right to notice of data collection, deletion of data, and the right to opt out of the sale of data. Note: Section 1798.150, the private right of action provision, uses the definition of “personal information” from the California Customer Records Act, Section 1798.81.5(d)(1)(A).
California Unfair Competition Law	Cal. Bus. & Prof. Code Sections 17200-17210	Prohibits false advertising and unlawful, unfair or fraudulent business acts or practices.
California Consumers Legal Remedies Act	Cal. Civ. Code Sections 1750-1784	Prohibits unfair methods of competition and deceptive acts or practices related to the sale or lease of goods or services to any consumer.
California Customer Records Act	Cal. Civ. Code. Section 1798.80-1798.84	Requires businesses that own, license or maintain personal information about California residents to implement and maintain reasonable security procedures and practices to protect such information from unauthorized access or disclosure.
California Confidentiality of Medical Information Act	Cal. Civ. Code Sections 56-56.37	Protects the confidentiality of patient medical information.
