


SOLSTICE HAT

Skill Level: **EASY**

Pattern: M24061 TDC



LION BRAND® MADE WITH LOVE THE COTTONY ONE® SOLSTICE HAT

EASY

SIZE

Finished Circumference About 19 1/2 in. (49.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® MADE WITH LOVE THE COTTONY ONE (Art. #3040)
 #098 Lychee White 1 ball (A)
 #171 Flaming Amber 1 ball (B)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)

GAUGE

1 Granny Square = about 3 1/4 in. x 3 1/4 in. (8.5 x 8.5 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

NOTES

- 1. 6 Granny Squares (3 in each of 2 different color sequences) are worked separately then joined together to form a ring.
- 2. Yarn color is changed on every rnd of Granny Squares. To change yarn color, fasten off old color and join new color as instructed.
- 3. Brim is worked directly onto one edge of the ring and top of Hat is worked directly onto opposite edge of ring.
- 4. Brim and top of Hat are worked in continuous rnds (spiral).

GRANNY SQUARE I (make 3)

With A, ch 4; sl st in first ch to form a ring. **Rnd 1 (RS):** With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – you will have four 3-dc groups and 4 ch-2 sps in this rnd.

Fasten off A.

Rnd 2: From RS, join B with sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp (first corner made), (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in each of next 3 ch-2 sps; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – Eight 3-dc groups and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Two 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off B.

Rnd 3: From RS, join A with sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, * 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from * 2 more times, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 - Twelve 3-dc groups and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Three 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps). Fasten off A.

GRANNY SQUARE II (make 3)

Make same as Granny Square I, reversing yarn colors (working Rnds 1 and 3 with B and Rnd 2 with A).

Join Squares to make a ring

Hold one edge of a Granny Square I and a Granny Square II together, matching sts and corners. From RS, working in back loops only of both Granny Squares, join B with sl st in corner at beg of edge, sl st in each st across edge to join the Granny Squares together.

Fasten off.

Rep to join all 6 Granny Squares into a strip, alternating Granny Square I and Granny Square II around. Then join ends of strip to form a ring. **Note:** If you prefer, you can sew the Granny

Squares into a ring.

Top of Hat

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS, join B with sl st in any st along one edge of ring, work 66 sc evenly spaced along edge of ring (working 11 sc evenly spaced along edge of each Granny Square); do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral) – 66 sc.

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 and 12: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 3: * Sc2tog, sc in next 9 sts; rep from * around - 60 sts.

Rnd 5: * Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around - 50 sts.

Rnd 7: * Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around - 40 sts.

Rnd 9: * Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts: rep from * around - 30 sts.

Rnd 11: * Sc2tog, sc in next st; rep from * around - 20 sts.

Rnds 13 and 14: * Sc2tog; rep from * around - 5 sts remain in Rnd 14.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through top of sts of last rnd and pull to close opening at top of Hat.

Knot securely.

Brim

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS, join A with sl st in any st along unworked edge of ring, work 72 sc evenly spaced along edge of ring (working 12 sc evenly spaced along edge of each Granny Square); do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2 and 3: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * around - 84 sts.

Rnd 5: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts; rep

from * around - 96 sts.

Rnd 6: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 7: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts; rep from * around - 108 sts.

Rnd 8: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts; rep from * around - 120 sts.

Rnds 9 and 10: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 11: SI st in each st around.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

rnd(s) = round(s)

RS = right side

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)
