# Caron® Cinnamon Swirl Cake Prints™ Striped Crochet Tunic



# Skill Level: Beginner Time Required: Over An Hour

Time to complete: 16 hours

**Project tip:** Try experimenting with the placement of the waist drawstring for a customised fit!

#### QUANTITIES NEEDED

Contrast A Sour Lime (33054) 2 3 3 4 4 5 balls Contrast B Tangerine Twist (33054) 2 2 2 3 3 4 balls

#### Sizes

To fit chest measurement XS/S 28-34" [71-86.5 cm] M 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm] L 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm] XL 44-46" [112-117 cm] 2/3XL 48-54" [122-137 cm] 4/5XL 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished chest XS/S 40" [101.5 cm] M 44" [112 cm] L 48" [122 cm] XL 52" [132 cm] 2/3XL 58" [147.5 cm] 4/5XL 64" [162.5 cm]

#### Materials

Caron® Cinnamon Swirl Cakes  $^{\text{M}}$  (8 oz/227 g; 407 yds/372 m) Sizes XS/S M L XL 2/3XL 4/5XL Contrast A Sour Lime (33054) 2 3 3 4 4 5 balls Contrast B Tangerine Twist (33054) 2 2 2 3 3 4 balls

Size U.S. G/8 [5 mm] Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook (10634753) or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle (10397033). Safety pin (10340479).

### GAUGE

13 single crochet (sc) and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm]. Save time and check your gauge

#### Instructions

Note: Chain (ch) 2 at beginning (beg) of round (rnd) does not count as stitch (st).

#### Stripe Pattern (Pat)

With A, work 2 rnds. With B, work 2 rnds. These 4 rnds form Stripe Pat.

#### Squares (make 4)

With A, ch 4. Join with slip stitch (sl st) to first ch to form ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2. [3 double crochet (dc) in ring. Ch 2] 3 times. 3 dc in ring. Ch 1. Join to first dc with a sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 2. 2 dc in same space (sp) as join. [1 dc in each dc to next ch-2 sp. (2 dc. Ch 2. 2 dc) in ch-2 sp] 3 times. 1 dc in each st to next (ch 1. 1 sc) sp. 2 dc in sp. Ch 1. Join to first dc with a sc.

First 2 rnds of Stripe Pat are now in place. Keeping continuity (cont) of Stripe Pat, repeat (rep) 2nd row until work measures approximately (approx) 19½ (21½-23½-25½-28½-31½)" [49.5 (54.5-59.5-65-72.5-80) cm] square, ending after a 2nd or 4th row of Stripe Pat. Fasten off B.

**Next rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as join. (1 sc in each dc to next ch-2 sp. 3 sc in ch-2 sp) 3 times. 1 sc in each st to next (ch 1. 1 sc) sp. 2 sc in sp. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

# Assembly and Finishing Side Seams

Using a flat seam, sew 2 squares together (tog) along side seams to form Bottom of Tunic, leaving 8 (8-9-10-11-12)" [20.5 (20.5-23-25.5-28-30.5) cm] open along bottom of seam at each side for side slit.

Using a flat seam sew and working vertically, sew first 4 (4-5-6-7-8)" [10 (10-12.5-15-18-20.5) cm] of remaining (rem) 2 squares tog for Top of Tunic. Leave open to last 8 (9-10-11-12-15)" [20.5 (23-25.5-28-30.5-38) cm]. Seam rem 8 (9-10-11-12-15)" [20.5 (23-25.5-28-30.5-38) cm] tog using a flat seam.

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Fold Top of Tunic in half horizontally. Leave 4" [10 cm] open at each end. Sew next 6 (7-8-9-10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>-12)" [15 (18-20.5-23-26.5-30.5) cm] closed for Sleeve using a flat seam. Leave rem 20 (22-24-26-29-32)" [51 (56-61-66-73.5-81) cm] in centre open.

With Top of Tunic centred along Bottom, seam Top to Bottom around circumference of Tunic using a flat seam.

## Waist Drawstring

Ch 175 (188-208-221-248-274). **Row 1:** 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Fasten off.

Place end of Drawstring on Safety Pin. Starting to side of center front, beg threading drawstring around waist approx.  $3 (3\frac{1}{2}-4-4\frac{1}{2}-5-6)"$  [7.5 (9-10-11.5-12.5-15) cm] below

seam by weaving safety pin over and under double crochets in groups of 2 sts around to opposite side of center front.
