

Free Knitting Pattern LION BRAND® VANNA'S CHOICE® BRIGHTON AFGHAN

Pattern Number: M20222 VC



SKILL LEVEL – INTERMEDIATE

SIZES

About 48 x 62 in. (122 x 157.5 cm)

MATERIALS

LION BRAND® VANNA'S CHOICE® (Art. #860)

#158 Mustard 2 balls (A)

#123 Beige 2 balls (B)

#101 Pink 3 balls (C)

#100 White 2 balls (D)

#138 Dusty Cedar 2 balls (E)

- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 9 (5.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long or longer

GAUGE

15 sts + 23 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS). **BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

NOTES

- 1. Afghan is worked in one piece on a circular needle.
- 2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.
- 3. Colorwork is done in intarsia and following a chart for each intarsia section. When following chart, do not carry unused color across WS. Use a separate ball of yarn for each color section and twist yarns at each color change to prevent holes from forming.
- 4. When working from charts, read RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right.

<u>AFGHAN</u>

With A, cast on 180 sts.

Beginning Border

Work in Garter st (knit every st on every row) for 12 rows.

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First Section of Afghan

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: K6 for Garter st side border, purl to last 6 sts, knit last 6 sts for side border.

Rows 3-44: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Intarsia A and B Chart

Continue as established, working first and last 6 sts in Garter st for side borders, remaining sts in St st (k on RS, p on WS) and following chart for yarn colors.

Continue working until you have completed Row 22 of the chart.

With B, rep Rows 1-44 of First Section of Afghan.

Intarsia B and C Chart

Continue as established, working first and last 6 sts in Garter st for side borders, remaining sts in St st and following chart for yarn colors.

Continue working until you have completed Row 14 of the chart.

With C, rep Rows 1-40 of First Section of Afghan.

Intarsia C and D Chart

Continue as established, working first and last 6 sts in Garter st for side borders, remaining sts in St st and following chart for yarn colors.

Continue working until you have completed Row 66 of the chart.

With D, rep Rows 1-16 of First Section of Afghan.

Intarsia D and E Chart

Continue as established, working first and last 6 sts in Garter st for side borders, remaining sts in St st and following chart for yarn colors.

Continue working until you have completed Row 34 of the chart.

With E, rep Rows 1-36 of First Section of Afghan.

Ending Border

With E, work in Garter st for 12 rows.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

p = purl


rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side
