

Finished Chest About 44 in. (112 cm) Finished Length About 23 in. (58.5 cm)

#### **SHORTS**

Finished Waist About 32 in. (81.5 cm) Finished Length About 14 1/2 in. (37 cm), including 1 in. (2.5 cm) for waistband

#### **MATERIALS**

#173 Sage 4 balls (A)
#171 Flaming Amber 4 balls (B)
#146 Knit One Purple One 2 balls (C)
#157 Summer Sun Yellow 2 balls (D)

- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

# **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)

#### **GAUGES**

4 (3 dc, ch 1) repeats + 8 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Granny pattern.

Rnds 1-3 of Granny Square = about  $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 3 \frac{3}{4}$  in. (9.5 x 9.5 cm).

14 sc + 12 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

# PATTERN STITCH Granny Pattern

beg ch-sp.

**Row 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first ch-1 sp, \* (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* once more, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to end of row working last 3 dc in

**Row 2:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, \* (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) to next corner ch-2 sp, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp, ch 1; rep from \* once more, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) to end of row, dc in top of beg ch-3.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Granny pattern.

#### **NOTES**

- 1. Top is worked in 4 pieces: Left Top Panel, Right Top Panel, and 2 Sleeves. Each Top Panel forms one front and half of back.
- 2. Top Panels are worked in Granny pattern, beg at armhole edge and working towards center and lower edge of body. Panels are sewn together along back edges.
- 3. Sleeves beg with a Granny Square. Granny Squares are worked in joined rnds with RS always facing you. Do not turn at beg of rnds. Rows of Granny pattern are then worked along some sides of the Square to shape Sleeve.
- 4. Shorts are worked in 2 Panels. Panels are worked in a simple granny pattern from the lower edge upwards.
- 5. Yarn color is changed following Color Sequences. To change yarn color when working in rnds, fasten off old color at end of rnd and join new color in any corner chsp. To change yarn color when working in rows, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

# **TOP**

# **TOP COLOR SEQUENCE**

Work 2 rows with A, 3 rows with B, 3 rows with C, 3 rows with B, 3 rows with A, 3 rows with D, 3 rows with B, and 2 rows with A for a total of 22 rows in Top Color Sequence.

# **LEFT TOP PANEL**

With A, ch 92.

Row 1: Work 2 dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc), (ch 1, sk next 3 ch, 3 dc in next ch) 10 times, ch 1, sk next 3 ch, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch (2 corners made), (ch 1, sk next 3 ch, 3 dc in next ch) 10 times, ch 1, sk next 3 ch, 3 dc in last ch – you will have twenty-five 3-dc groups, 22 ch-1 sps, and 2 corner ch-2 sps (Twelve 3-dc groups along each of 2 long sides before and one 3-dc group between corner ch-2 sps).

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, \* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* to next corner ch-2 sp, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, \*\* ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \*\* across, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch-3 and change to B - Twenty-six 3-dc groups, 25 ch-1 sps, and 2 corner ch-2 sps (Twelve 3-dc groups along each of 2 long sides and two 3-dc groups between corner ch-2 sps). Rows 3-15: Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Granny pattern for 13 rows AND continue to change yarn color following Top Color Sequence - Fifty-three 3 -dc groups, 50 ch-1 sps, and 2 corner ch-2 sps (Nineteen 3-dc groups along each of 2 long sides and fifteen 3-dc groups between corner ch-2 sps) in Row 15. **Note:** Row 15 is the first D-colored row of

# **Shape Neck**

Top Color Sequence.

Continue to change yarn color following Top Color Sequence until piece is complete.

**Row 16:** Work Row 2 of Granny pattern to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in last ch-1 sp; leave rem sts unworked – Fifty-three 3-dc groups.

**Row 17:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, 3 dc in first ch-1 sp, continue as in Row 1 of Granny pattern to end of row – Fifty-five 3-dc groups.

**Row 18:** Work Row 2 of Granny pattern to beg ch-4, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 - Fifty-six 3-dc groups.

**Rows 19 and 20:** Rep Rows 17 and 18 - Fiftynine 3-dc groups in Row 20.

Row 21: Rep Row 17 - Sixty-one 3-dc groups.

**Row 22:** Work Row 2 of Granny pattern to beg ch-sp, ch 1, 3 dc in beg ch-sp - Sixty-three 3-dc groups.

Fasten off.

# **RIGHT TOP PANEL**

Work same as Left Panel for Front to Shape Neck.

# **Shape Neck**

Continue to change yarn color following Top Color Sequence until piece is complete.

**Row 16:** Turn, sl st in each st to first ch-1 sp, sl st in first ch-1 sp, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), continue as in Row 2 of Granny pattern to end of row – Fifty-three 3-dc groups.

**Row 17:** Work Row 1 of Granny pattern to last 3-dc group, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – Fifty-five 3-dc groups.

**Row 18:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk first ch-1 sp, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, continue as in Row 2 of Granny pattern to end of row – Fifty-six 3-dc groups.

**Rows 19 and 20:** Rep Rows 17 and 18 - Fiftynine 3-dc groups in Row 20.

**Row 21:** Rep Row 17 - Sixty-one 3-dc groups. **Row 22:** Work Row 1 of Granny pattern to last 3-dc group, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch-3 - Sixty-three 3-dc groups. Fasten off.

# SLEEVES (make 2)

# **Granny Square**

With D, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – you will have four 3-dc groups and 4 ch-2 sps in this rnd.

Rnd 2: SI st in each st to first ch-2 sp, sI st in ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp (first corner made), \* ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 1; join with sI st in top of beg ch-3 – Eight 3-dc groups, 4 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Two 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Rnd 3: SI st in each st to first ch-2 sp, sI st in ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, \* ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 1; join with sI st in top of beg ch-3 – Twelve 3-dc groups, 8 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Three 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off D.

Rnd 4: From RS, draw up a loop of A in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp, \* ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 - Sixteen 3-dc groups, 12 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 (Four 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Rnds 5 and 6: With A, sI st in each st to first ch-2 sp, sI st in ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp, \* ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 1; join with sI st in top of beg ch-3 - Twenty-four 3-dc groups, 20 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Six 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps) in Rnd 6.

Fasten off A.

Rnds 7 and 8: With B, rep Rnds 4 and 5 – Thirty-two 3-dc groups, 28 ch-1 sps and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Eight 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps) in Rnd 8.

# **Work Granny Pattern along Three Sides**

Granny pattern is now worked along only 3 sides of Granny Square.

**Row 1 (RS):** With B, sl st in each st to first ch-2 sp, sl st in ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, \* (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp; rep from \* once more, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp, 3 dc in ch-2

sp and change to C in last dc; leave rem sts unworked - Twenty-seven 3-dc groups, 24 ch-1 sps and 2 corner ch-2 sps.

**Rows 2-6:** Beg with Row 2 of pattern, work in Granny pattern for 5 rows, working next 3 rows with C and then 2 rows with B. Do not fasten off B.

# **Work Granny Pattern along One Side**

**Row 7 (RS):** With B, ch 3 (counts a dc), turn, 2 dc in first ch-1 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in ch-2 sp; leave rem sts unworked.

**Row 8:** With B, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) to end of row, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

Fasten off.

From RS, draw up a loop of B in unworked corner ch-2 sp of Row 6, and rep Rows 7 and 8 to work Granny pattern along opposite side edge.

Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING TOP**

Place Panels on a flat surface with RS facing you and with sts of long center back edges matching. With A, sew or sl st center back edges together.

Sew shoulder seams.

Place markers on front and back side edges, about 8 1/2 in. (21.5 cm) from shoulder. Sew Sleeves between markers.

Sew Sleeve and rem of side edges together (along first row of Panels).

#### **Bands**

**Rnd 1 (RS):** From RS, join A with sl st in top left corner of neck so that you are ready to work down left front edge.

Work 66 sc evenly spaced down left front edge, 3 sc in lower left corner, 155 sc along lower edge, 3 sc in lower right corner, 66 sc evenly spaced up right front edge, ch 1 and work 79 sc evenly spaced along neck edge; join with sl st in first sc.

**Row 2 (WS):** Ch 1, turn, sl st in each neck edge st to ch-1 sp, sc in ch-1 sp and in each sc along, working 3 sc in center sc of each 3-sc corner; do not join.

Work now proceeds in rows over front and lower edges only.

**Next 2 rows:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across, working 3 sc in center sc of each 3-sc corner; leave sl sts of neck edge unworked.

**Next row:** Ch 1, turn, sl st in each st across, working ch 1 at each corner. Fasten off.

# Collar

Place markers on neck edge, about 2 in. (5 cm) from front corners.

**Row 1 (RS):** From RS, join A with sc at first marker, sc in each st to 2nd marker.

**Rows 2-10:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Row 11: Ch 1, turn, sl st in each st across. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

#### **SHORTS**

# **SHORTS COLOR SEQUENCE**

Work 1 row with A, 3 rows with B, 3 rows with D, 3 rows with A, 3 rows with B, 3 rows with C, 3 rows with D, 3 rows with B, and 2 rows with C for a total of 24 rows in Shorts Color Sequence.

#### **SHORTS PANELS (make 2)**

With A, ch 84.

**Row 1 (RS):** With A, work 2 dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc), \* ch 1, sk next 3 ch, 3 dc in next ch; rep from \* across and change to B in last dc – Twenty-one 3-dc groups and 20 ch-1 sps.

**Row 2:** With B, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, \* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across, dc in top of beg ch-3 - Twenty 3-dc groups and 21 ch-1 sps.

Row 3 (Increase Row - RS): With B, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, 3 dc in first ch-1 sp, ch 1, \* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch; rep from \* to beg ch-sp, (3 dc, ch 1, dc) in beg ch-sp - Twenty-

one 3-dc groups and 22 ch-1 sps.

**Row 4:** With B, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first ch-1 sp, ch 1, \* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, 3 dc in last ch-1 sp and change to D in last dc - Twenty-two 3-dc groups and 21 ch-1 sps.

**Row 5:** With D, rep Row 2 - Twenty-one 3-dc groups and 22 ch-1 sps.

**Row 6:** With D, rep Row 4 – Twenty-two 3-dc groups and 21 ch-1 sps.

#### **Shape Gusset**

Row 7 (Decrease Row): With D, ch 1, turn, sl st in each st to first ch-1 sp, sl st in ch-1 sp, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), \* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* to last two 3-dc groups, dc in last ch-1 sp and change to A; leave rem sts unworked - Nineteen 3-dc groups and 20 ch-1 sps.

Continue to change yarn color following Shorts Color Sequence until piece is complete.

Rows 8 and 9: Rep Rows 4 and 5 - Nineteen 3-dc groups and 20 ch-1 sps in Row 9.

**Row 10 (Decrease Row):** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk first ch-1 sp, \* 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* to beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 - Eighteen 3-dc groups and 19 ch-1 sps.

Rows 11-14: Rep Rows 4 and 5 twice.

**Row 15:** Rep Row 10 - Seventeen 3-dc groups and 18 ch-1 sps.

**Rows 16-21:** Rep Rows 4 and 5 for 3 more times.

**Row 22:** Rep Row 10 - Sixteen 3-dc groups and 17 ch-1 sps.

**Rows 23 and 24:** Rep Rows 4 and 5. Fasten off.

# **Lower Edging**

**Row 1 (RS):** From RS, working along opposite side of foundation ch, join A with sl st at beg of foundation ch, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), \* 3 dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across, dc in end of foundation ch - Twenty 3-dc groups and 21 ch-1 sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, work sc evenly spaced across. **Rows 3 and 4:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, sl st in each st across. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING SHORTS**

Fold each Panel in half lengthwise and sew side edges together from lower edge to beg of gusset shaping.

Sew Panels together from top edge down to end of gusset shaping (at center of crotch).

#### Waistband

**Row 1 (RS):** From RS, join C with sl st in top edge at front seam, work sc evenly spaced around waist edge; do not join, work back and forth in rows.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Row 5 (Turning Row): Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each st across.

**Rows 6-8:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Fasten off.

Fold waistband in half along Turning Row and sew top edge to inside of first row, leaving edges at center front open for cord.

#### Cord

With A, make a chain about 56 in. (76 cm) long. **Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across.

Fasten off.

Attach a safety pin to one end of the cord then use the safety pin to draw the cord through the waistband.

Weave in ends.
