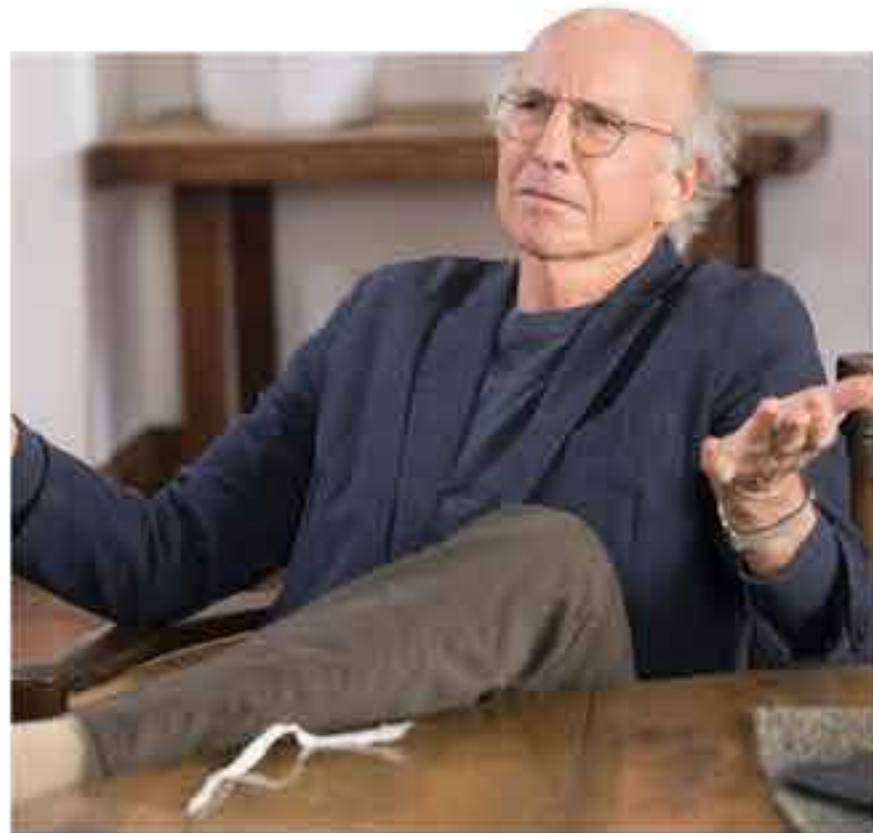

Sky Original drama Landscapers tells a unique love story involving a seemingly ordinary couple who become the focus of an extraordinary investigation when dead bodies are discovered in the back garden of a house in Nottingham.

Mild-mannered husband and wife Susan (Olivia Colman) and Christopher Edwards (David Thewlis) have been on the run from reality for over 15 years. When Christopher makes a startling call home to his step-mother, their role in a terrible crime that remained undiscovered for over a decade begins to emerge into the light. As their relationship is subjected to the glare of a full police investigation, the devoted couple are separated for the first time in their marriage.

As the investigation moves forward, inspired by Susan's obsession with old Westerns and classic cinema the fantasists cast themselves as Hollywood heroes in narratives of their own invention.

Powered by Susan's extraordinary imagination, Susan and Chris's fantasy world provides a much needed sanctuary from real-world horrors and their own clawing guilt, but also threatens to undo them completely. In its visually bold and unique style, Landscapers, pivots through various perspectives from Susan and Chris, to the police officers and lawyers involved in the investigation. Exploring the idea of multiple truths, Landscapers asks just how far are you prepared to go for the one you love?

He's propped up by a diverse team, whose lives are as complicated as their mentor's. There's child prodigy Maggy (Naomi Yang), middle-aged single mum Dot (Amanda Abbington), keen on keeping trim and obsessed with bugs Steve (Adam Long) and new recruit Dominique (Shaniqua Okwok) - Dominique is as bright as a button but carrying the baggage of a very dark past.

Each week Wolfe is propelled to a myriad of compelling locations, to piece together the parts (literally in most cases) of another outlandish and unconventional investigation. One thing is for sure though, they won't be doing it in a way anybody expected.

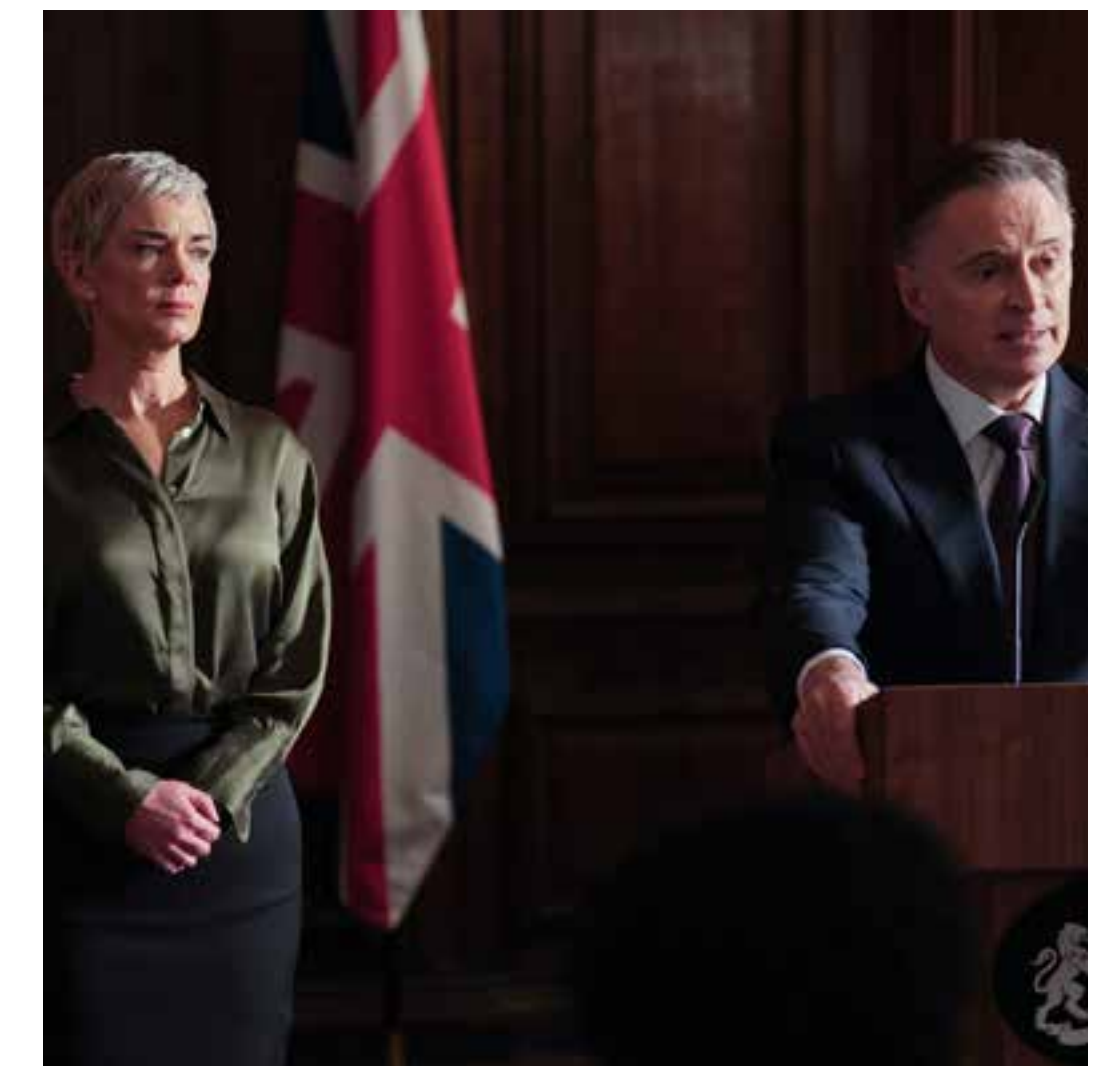
COBRA: Cyberwar

Action-packed and suspenseful returning Sky Original drama COBRA: Cyberwar stars Robert Carlyle as Prime Minister Robert Sutherland and Victoria Hamilton as his Chief of Staff Anna Marshall. Created by the multi-award-winning writers Jez Butterworth, his brother Tom Butterworth, and James Richardson, Sky Original drama Britannia is back for a third season.

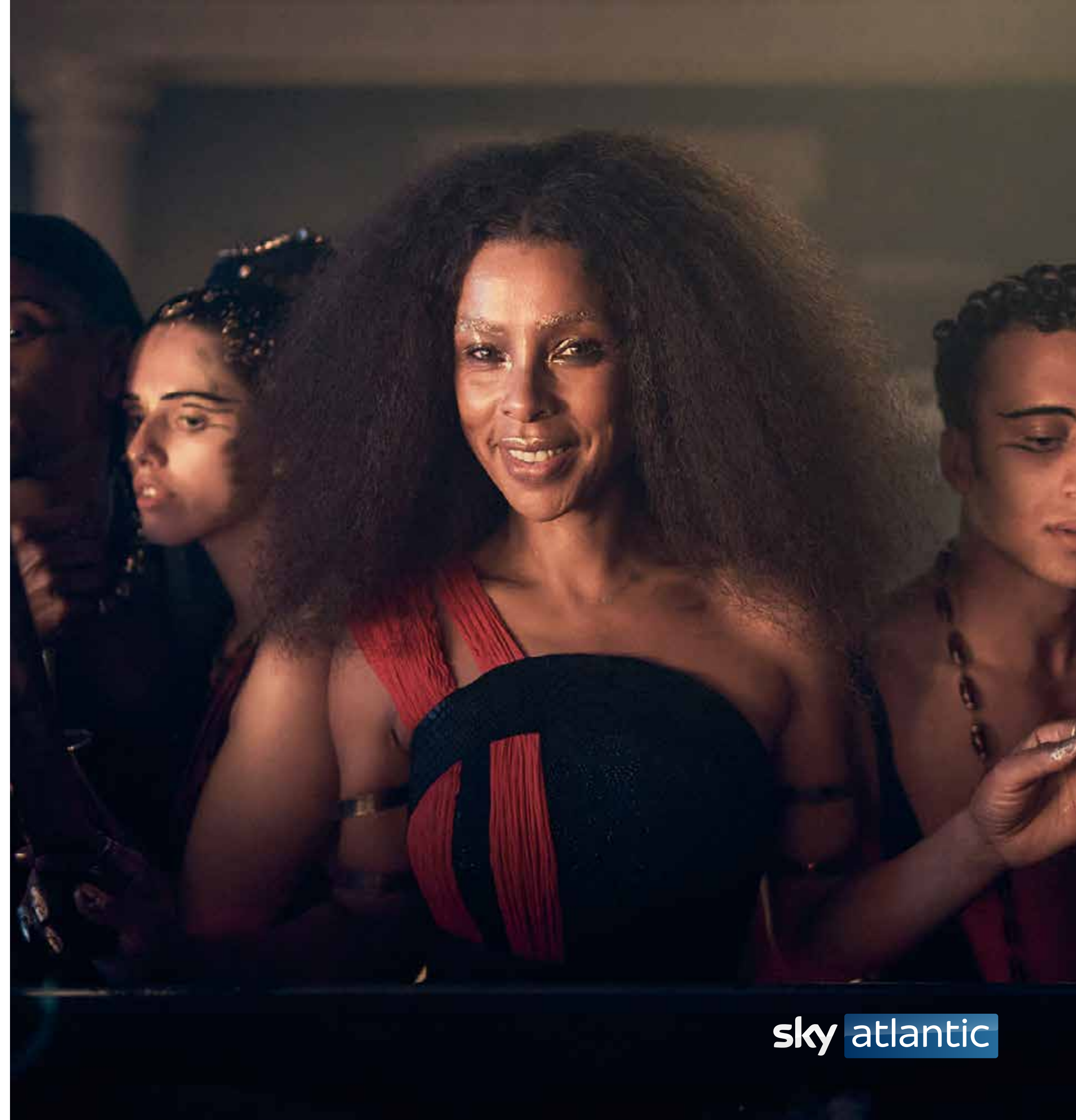

Reflecting all sides of the story - with insider testimony from those who knew him, unseen archive and dramatic reconstruction - the audience will be taken from Michael's childhood in Trinidad, to the genesis of the British Black Power Movement and the intoxicating days of counterculture and Notting Hill Carnival, before returning to the Caribbean where Michael was tried and convicted of murder.

The Wimbledon Kidnapping

Britain's first kidnap and ransom case galvanised the nation in 1969. On 29th December, Muriel McKay disappeared from her suburban home in Wimbledon. Such was the strangeness of the case that everyone from the police, family, Fleet Street, and hundreds of clairvoyants all struggled to decipher the vanishing of the respectable 55-year-old housewife. Now, one of the men convicted for this extraordinary crime, and the families of both the kidnapped woman and the convicted murderers speak for the first time.

Wimbledon Kidnapping reveals the jaw-dropping story behind a case which would rewrite the rulebook. Kidnapping was an unheard of crime in the UK. The wife of a News of the World executive, Mrs McKay had been mistaken for Rupert Murdoch's wife and was being held for a huge ransom by the mafia – so the headlines claimed. But the following negotiation, investigation and trial of two Indo-Trinidadian brothers presented a very different version of events. Fifty years on, the search for the truth continues.

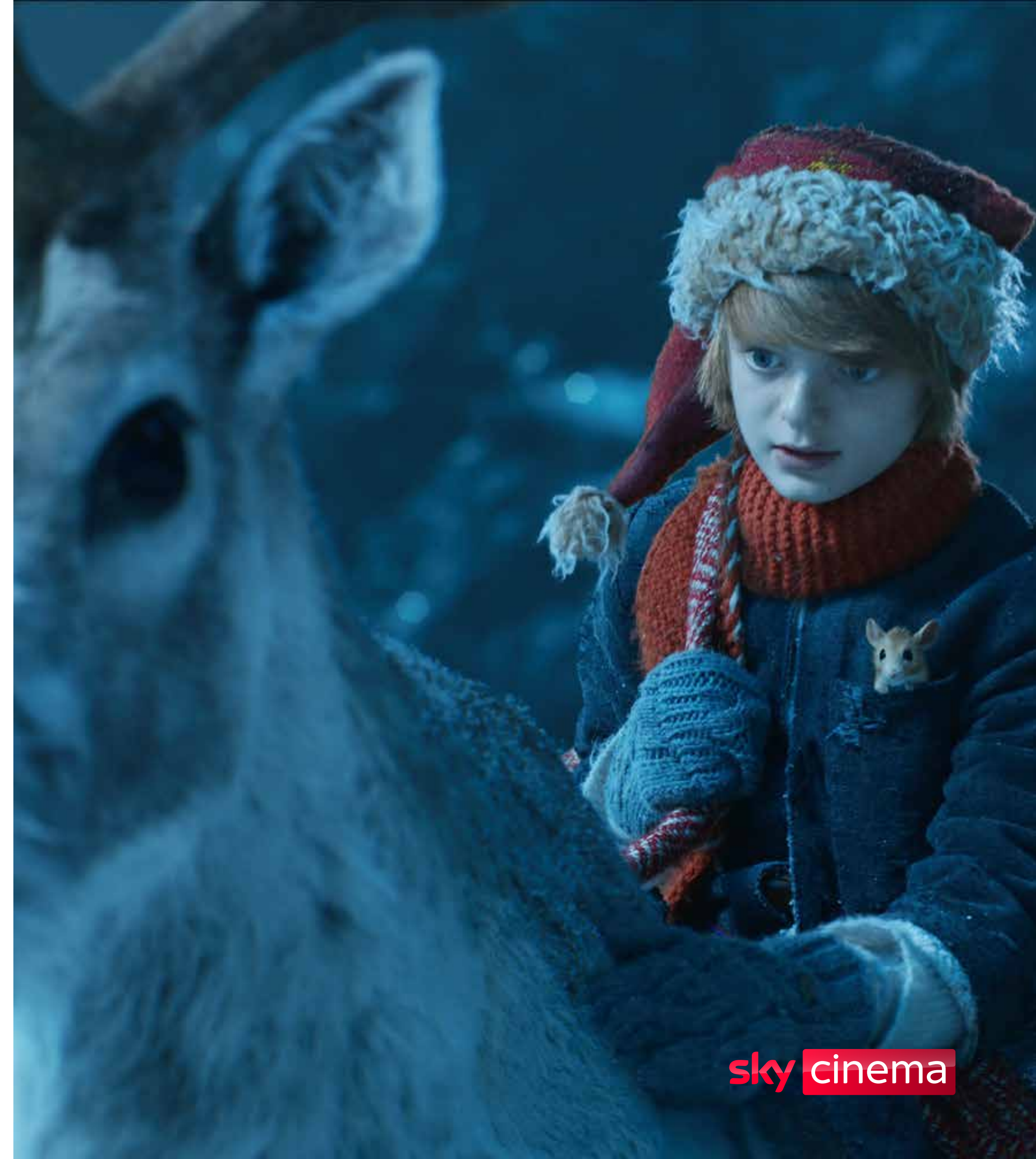
