Lockerbie: A Search for Truth

On 21st December 1988, 259 passengers and crew were killed when Pan Am Flight 103 exploded over Lockerbie 38 minutes after take-off, with a further 11 residents losing their life as the plane came down over the quiet, Scottish town.

In the wake of the disaster and his daughter's death, Dr Jim Swire (**Colin Firth**), is nominated spokesperson for the UK victims' families, who have united to demand truth and justice. Travelling across continents and political divides, Jim embarks on a relentless journey that not only jeopardises his stability, family and life, but completely overturns his trust in the justice system. As the truth shifts under Jim's feet, his view of the world is left forever changed.

Exploring events from the disaster and its aftermath, <u>Lockerbie: A Search for Truth</u> provides an intimate account of a man, a husband, and a father who risks everything in memory of his daughter and the unflinching pursuit of truth and justice.



Atomic

<u>Atomic</u> is a dynamic and entertaining action-fuelled adventure. When Max (**Alfie Allen**) and Mohammed (**Shazad Latif**), two unlikely friends – and even less likely heroes – become swept up in a cartel's plot to transport uranium across North Africa, they face a monumental decision: save themselves or risk everything to prevent a nuclear bomb getting into the wrong hands.

Max, a free-spirited drug trafficker, is making runs through the Middle East. Meanwhile Mohammed, a man haunted by his past and on the run from those determined to kill him, is hiding out in the deserts of North Africa, unable to return home to the UK. Desperate for redemption, their paths converge in the Libyan desert as they are swept up in a nefarious Venezuelan cartel's plot to transport uranium capable of fueling a nuclear bomb.

With the fate of humanity in their backpacks, they grapple with a desperate choice: save themselves or save humanity? Pursued by Cassie Elliott (**Samira Wiley**) - a highly skilled CIA agent whose life mission is to prevent terrorists from acquiring a nuclear bomb - along with MI6 and a network of traffickers, Max and Mohammed find themselves in the absurd situation of, for once, having to be the good guys.

Atomic is an adrenaline-charged, cinematic five-episode odyssey through the labyrinthine medinas and bustling metropolises of North Africa, across inhospitable deserts and hostile borders, where Max and Mohammed - with their lively, funny and unexpected camaraderie - wonder whether some kind of atonement is possible amidst the madness.

7/7: The London Bombings

Produced by Blast Films, a Sky Studios company, this incisive and layered series will unpick the events of one of the worst terrorist attacks suffered on British soil. With unprecedented access to those closest to the story - many of whom have never spoken before - this series will reveal a gripping and alternative account of the 7/7 bombings. Three perspectives will be told in parallel: that of the investigators desperately hunting for answers; the ordinary civilians embroiled in the attacks; and the unheard voices from those closely connected to the perpetrators. New revelations about the bombers' personal histories and motivations will provide a deeper, historical insight into what led to their radicalisation as well as the complex social, moral and political backdrop that underpinned the tragedy. Understanding why and how 7/7 happened will form a crucial part of the series' narrative.

First-person testimony combined with raw, unseen archive builds a compelling narrative that follows the Police and Counter Terror investigation - from the first blast and frantic hunt for intel on the bombers to the failed second attack that followed 2 weeks later. This ignited Britain's biggest ever manhunt and, as police came under pressure to capture the suicide bombers amongst rising panic and racial tension, resulted in the police shooting of Jean Charles De Menezes after he was wrongly identified as a suspect. Weaving together the story of radicalisation in Britain and the geopolitical context - told, for the first time, by those with close and intimate connections - will provide the most definitive account of 7/7.

Mussolini: Son of the Century (w/t)

Directed by BAFTA-winning **Joe Wright** (*Darkest Hour, Atonement, Cyrano*), the series is based on the Premio Strega-winning and international bestselling book by Antonio Scurati, which chronicles the birth of fascism in Italy and the Duce Benito Mussolini's rise to power. The soundtrack is composed by **Tom Rowlands**, also known for being part of the British electronic music duo The Chemical Brothers, pioneers who brought big beat to the forefront of pop culture, topping charts worldwide. They are multi-award winners, with 6 Grammy Awards, 1 Brit Award, 1 MTV Europe Music Award, and 1 NME Award.




