In accordance with ASME Code, Section IV: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Steam boilers are to be hydrostatically tested to 45psi (310kPa) and hot water boilers to 1.5 times the maximum allowable working pressure, after assembly. 2) The hydrostatic test pressure shall be under such control that in no case shall the required test pressure be exceeded by more than 10psi (70kPa). 3) Cast Aluminum boilers can only be used in hot water service but not in steam service.
