Recognized electrical training relates to the electrical Field Safety Representative (FSR) certificate of qualification program. Only training that is officially recognized by the provincial safety manager through Technical Safety BC's Recognized Registered Training Providers – Electrical Technology will be accepted. Training providers may be recognized to deliver one or more of the courses below. For course availability, or to learn about and register for a course, contact the training provider directly.

Note: Courses offered by training providers in an online format are available for registration throughout the province of British Columbia.

FSR Certification Education

Is a recognized course on the application of electrical Codes, various Acts, Regulations, Directive and Standards that will help you meet the examination requirements for various FSR Classes.

FSR Renewal Continuing Education

Continuing Education courses are recognized courses that will help you meet the requirements to renew your FSR certificate of qualification.

FSR Renewal Continuing Education for Restricted Classes

FSR applicants for SA (security alarm) and LO (low energy) should inform the training provider that they wish to take a course specifically designed for their restricted FSR class, <u>not</u> the course for FSR Class A, B, or C.

Coming from Alberta?

Are you an Alberta Master Electrician? There are two considerations when applying to be a Master Electrician in BC.

- 1. The ARD exam must be successfully completed by any qualified electrical applicant. This exam is administered by Technical Safety BC.
- 2. Technical Safety BC accepts many continuing education courses approved by the Alberta Safety Codes Council. You should check to see if they meet the <u>hours requirements</u> in BC of 8 hours for unrestricted A, B and C classes and 4 hours for restricted B and C classes as well as SA and LO classes. If the total hour requirements are not met, additional training may be required. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the training is recognized by TSBC, through the institution they took the training.
