

In-Person Exams – Rules and Penalties

| Exam Rule | Breach Penalty |

| Examinees must leave all bags and electronic in the area assigned for personal belongings. | One-month suspension from attempting the exam again. |
| Examinees must remove their hats or hoods during the examination | One-month suspension from attempting the exam again. |
| Examinees must not access any unapproved reference material during their exam, The use of personal digital devices during the examination will be considered as an attempt to access unapproved reference material. | Six-month suspension from attempting the exam again. |
| Only non-programmable calculators are permitted during examinations. | Three-month suspension from attempting the exam again. |
| Examinees are not permitted to leave the examination room during the examination period unless they are accessing the approved washroom. | Three-month suspension from attempting the exam again. |
| Examinees must not communicate or attempt to communicate with anyone other than the Technical Safety BC invigilators during the examination. | Four-month suspension from attempting the exam again. |
| Examinees must return all materials and papers to the invigilator before leaving the examination room. | Four-month suspension from attempting the exam again. |
| Examinees must not copy, record, or share exam questions and diagrams through any means. | Six-month suspension from attempting the exam again. |
