Re-assessments are charged at the <i>equivalent of one hour at the standard Administration rate</i> . If as a consequence of this re-assessment, the Safety Officer determines a re-inspection is required, the re-inspection fee is applied as below	\$ 68	per permit	Yes
Compliance verification for Operating Permits This fee is applied when an assessment of a previous non-compliance results in the Safety Officer requiring a further inspection to be performed for an operating permit.
