Islington's World of Work Programme

Islington's World of Work Programme connects young people with businesses and communities in the Borough of Islington, via schools.

8x8 used the World of Work Programme to invite a group of school children to their London Office and were naturally delighted when the Central Foundation Boys School, Islington accepted.

Our willing team of volunteers from product management, development and engineering departments then organised the students into groups which rotated around various sessions to hear about the volunteer's role in the business, watch demonstrations and ask lots of questions.

Following the sessions, the children were treated to pizza and they enjoyed the pool table before rushing back to school for an afternoon of lessons.
