If you reserved APU:

For both Domestic *and* International Flights, please proceed to the Information Desk in the baggage claim area. Your driver will be waiting here, holding a sign reading “ELS Language Centers” with your name on it.



What if my arrival time or flight changes?

Please call **First Impression Limousine** at **1-615-714-9990**. Give them your new airline, flight number and arrival time into Nashville. First Impression Limousine’s number is answered 24 hours a day. If you encounter issues, contact the ELS/Nashville Center Help Line above.



What if my luggage is lost?

If your luggage is lost, please go to your airline’s counter at the airport. If you are staying in a homestay, we suggest that you telephone your homestay to inform them that you will be arriving later than expected. Luggage is usually found and returned to students within 24 hours.

Arrival to Homestay:

If your flight plans change, we recommend that you contact your host family to tell them when to expect you. Check-in is between 10 am – 7 pm on arrival Sunday. If you have a problem and your homestay host cannot help you, please call the ELS Nashville Center Help Line at the above number.

Arrival to Residence:

Students with confirmed housing at **College Center Apartments** should report directly to the Main Desk. Here you will be assisted with check-in and keys to your room. Please note there is a separate orientation later in the week to complete paperwork and payment. If you need further assistance or have issues at check-in, please contact the ELS/Nashville Center Help Line.
