# **ELS LEVELS**

# **ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES (EAP)**

The English for Academic Purposes (EAP) program is designed for students who want to attend a college or university outside of their home countries. This includes any student wishing to apply for conditional admission to any of ELS's 650+ partner institutions globally.

Through the EAP Program, you will learn listening, speaking, reading, writing, pronunciation, and grammar skills. You will also get the skills you need to be successful in a university setting, including:

- Critical Thinking
- Presentations/Public Speaking
- Note Taking
- Academic Research

Our morning classes consist of:

- Structure and Speaking Practice or Language Studies
- Vocabulary Enrichment (Levels 101 109) OR Skills Enhancement Classes (Masters Only)
- One lesson in our Language Technology Center (LTC)

Afternoon classes consist of reading and writing.

Successfully completing Level 112 of the ELS English for Academic Purposes Program earns a Certificate of Completion accepted as proof of English proficiency at more than 650 colleges and universities worldwide. Many two-year schools will accept Level 109.

Taking a Pre-Arrival Test (PAT) will help you plan the amount of time you will need to devote to studying by assessing your initial proficiency level. Choose from ELS/Chennai's 12 convenient annual start dates\*, always at the beginning of each month. You can explore India, meet with teachers, or relax between sessions on administrative days throughout the year, during which the ELS office is open but classes are not held.

\*SRM University has only one intake – in July – every year. If you wish to matriculate into SRM, you must plan your English study around the university's calendar.
