If you reserved APU:

San Francisco International (SFO) Airport:

For Domestic flights, please proceed to the Baggage Claim area. For International flights, please proceed directly outside of the customs area. Here in these areas, you can expect to find your Western Eagle Shuttle driver holding an ELS Sign with your name on it. Your driver will take you directly to your homestay or the student residence.

What if my arrival time or flight changes?

Please call Western Eagle Shuttle and provide your new airline, flight number and arrival time into the San Francisco International Airport. The Western Eagle Shuttle number is answered 24 hours a day. If you do not receive an answer, please call the ELS San Rafael Help Line above to speak with the Center Director.



What if my luggage is lost?

If your luggage is lost, please go to your airline's counter at the airport. If you are staying in a homestay, we suggest that you telephone your homestay to inform them that you will be arriving later than expected. Luggage is usually found and returned to students within 24 hours.

Arrival to Homestay:

All students confirmed to live with a homestay are asked to contact their families at least one week prior to arrival. Check-in is between 8 am – 10 pm on arrival Sunday. Please report to the ELS Center at 8:15 am on First Monday for placement testing and orientation.

Arrival to Residence:

The owners of the student residence lives nearby and they, or one of their staff will be on-site when you arrive to show you the house, explain the rules, and introduce you to the other students residing in the student-only residence.
