

Chlamydia Screening (CHL)

Description of Measure

The percentage of members 16–24 years of age who were recommended for routine chlamydia screening, were identified as sexually active and had at least one test for chlamydia during the measurement year (MY).¹

Members are identified as sexually active by the following:

- Pregnancy
- Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) screening
- Contraceptive prescribed
- Pregnancy test completed

- Members who use hospice services or elect to use - Members who die - Persons with a sex assigned at birth of male.	Anytime in the MY

Strategies for Success

- Perform chlamydia screening every year on every 16 to 24-year-old female identified as sexually active (use any visit opportunity).
- Add chlamydia screening as a standard lab for women 16 to 24 years old. Use adolescent well-care exams and well woman exams for this purpose
- Remember that chlamydia screening can be performed through a urine test. Offer this option for your patients.
- Incorporate sexual history into the History and Physical documentation in EMR.
- For any visit where oral contraceptive, sexually transmitted diseases (STD) or urinary symptoms are discussed, a Chlamydia screening should occur.
- ARHOME members due for a chlamydia screening, urine test kits are available to test with ease at home. Call **501-500-2184** to receive a kit delivered by the mail at no charge.
