<u>ADMISSIBILITÉ</u>

Competitors from all Biathlon Canada and Biathlon USA member divisions will be eligible to participate. Competitors must be prepared to show a membership card or otherwise prove proof of membership for the current year as part of the event registration process.

Teams and individual competitors from outside Canada must declare their rifles at the Canadian border, complete the necessary documentation and pay the required fees when bringing rifles and ammunition into Canada. Please refer to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police website and the RCMP Form 5589e (rcmp-grc.gc.ca) to access the Non-Resident Firearms Declaration.

For Canadian citizens who are in the firearms (.22) categories, it is mandatory that all athletes have in their possession and be able to show proof of successful completion of the firearms course upon request. For the categories carrying the rifle, you must also have a firearms possession and carry licence or a minor's licence, issued by the Government of Canada. All competitors must be members in good standing of Biathlon Canada and their Provincial Federation.

The Quebec Cup is offered to all athletes who are members in good standing of a Biathlon club that is a member of the FQB. Non-members will be able to participate in the races if they are members of another federation and will be entitled to medals but not Quebec Cup points.

On the sidelines of the event, an Eastern Townships Cup will be held. People who wish to try it out without being a member of the FQB will be able to register for this introductory activity. They will be entitled to the medals of the Eastern Townships Cup only. A trial license will have to be taken online but this permit does not give access to the Quebec Cup races <u>https://www.biathloncanada.ca/membership</u>. Some air rifles may be available on site; however, arrangements must be made in advance with the organizing committee.

INSCRIPTIONS

The online registration period on Zone4 begins December 7, 2024 and ends Wednesday, January 8, 2025 at 11:59 p.m. Please note that from January 6 at 11.59 p.m. additional fees will be added. Payment must be made by credit card (Visa or Master) and a processing fee is applicable.

REMARKS

Minimum registration of 4 athletes for the opening of a category.

Air rifles Categories: The athlete does not carry the rifle during the event. Shots will be made in a prone position only. The penalty ring is 100 meters. Weights are not provided. A heated area will be available near the shooting range to warm up rifles as needed. For Boys and Girls initiation, a 20-second penalty per missed target will be added to the race time as there will be no penalty magnifying glass for these categories.

Cancelled or postponed event: the Organizing Committee reserves the right to withhold all or part of the registration fee to cover the expenses incurred.

Participants in the open category will not have medals and no points will be accumulated in the Quebec Cup standings.

The races are recognized by the Quebec Biathlon Federation and points will be awarded for the 2024-2025 Quebec Cup ranking in accordance with the organizational policy.

During competitions, Boys and Girls Juveniles will have to shoot at targets with a diameter of 15 mm. Those 10 Year and under will be able to benefit from support and will use 35mm diameter targets.
